## GOT FRUIT?

JESUS said in Matthew 7:16 that you will know a person by their "fruit." A person isn't a Christian just because they say they are, prays a little prayer, gets baptized or "asks Jesus into their heart." For someone to become a Christian, the Bible says that they must Repent of their sins and put their Faith/Trust in Jesus alone! Heed the sobering words of Jesus: "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven. Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' And then I will declare to them, <u>I never knew you</u>; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness." [Matt 7:21-23] Will YOU be one to whom Jesus says, "Depart from me"?

Yes, a person is saved by **GRACE**, but do **YOU** truly have the Grace of God? Here is the Biblical description of someone who has the Grace of God: "For the Grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and Godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works." [Titus 2:11-14]. Also read Galatians 5:19-21.

Do <u>YOU</u> have the Grace of God according to the <u>BIBLE</u>? Here is the <u>GOOD FRUIT</u> of the True Christian: the fruit of repentance [1 John 3:4, Matt 3:8]; the fruit of obedience [John 14:15]; the fruit of fellowship with God [John 17:3, 1 Jn 1:3-4]; the fruit of the spirit [Gal 5:22-23] and the fruit of evangelism [Mark 16:15, 1 Cor 9:16]. Read 2 Corinthians 13:5 and all of 1 John. Do YOU have the fruit of a Christian? Are YOU A CHRISTIAN ACCORDING TO THE BIBLE?
