

Prov 6:13b... he speaketh with his feet...





Proverbs 1:15–16

My son, walk not thou in the way with them [sinners]; refrain thy foot from their path: For their feet run to evil, and make haste to shed blood.

Ecclesiastes 5:1

Keep thy foot when thou goest to the house of God, and be more ready to hear, than to give the sacrifice of fools: for they consider not that they do evil.





Isaiah 59:7-9

Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood: their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction are in their paths. The way of peace they know not; and there is no judgment in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goeth therein shall not know peace. Therefore is judgment far from us, neither doth justice overtake us: we wait for light, but behold obscurity; for brightness, but we walk in darkness.





Romans 3:10-18 As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one. Their throat is an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps is under their lips: Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness: Their feet are swift to shed blood: Destruction and misery are in their ways: And the way of peace have they not known: There is no fear of God before their eyes.





Psalm 36:11

Let not the **foot of pride** come against me, and let not the hand of the wicked remove me.







Psalm 94:3-4

LORD, how long shall the wicked, how long shall the wicked triumph? How long shall they utter and speak hard things? and all the workers of iniquity boast themselves?

Psalm 94:16-18

Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? or who will stand up for me against the workers of iniquity? Unless the LORD had been my help, my soul had almost dwelt in silence. When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O LORD, held me up.





Psalm 38:1-4

O LORD, rebuke me not in thy wrath: neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure. For thine arrows stick fast in me, and thy hand presseth me sore. There is no soundness in my flesh because of thine anger; neither is there any rest in my bones because of my sin. For mine iniquities are gone over mine head: as an heavy burden they are too heavy for me.

Psalm 38:11-16

My lovers and my friends stand aloof from my sore; and my kinsmen stand afar off. They also that seek after my life lay snares for me: and they that seek my hurt speak mischievous things, and imagine deceits all the day long. But I, as a deaf man, heard not; and I was as a dumb man that openeth not his mouth. Thus I was as a man that heareth not, and in whose mouth are no reproofs. For in thee, O LORD, do I hope: thou wilt hear, O Lord my God. For I said, Hear me, lest otherwise they should rejoice over me: when my foot slippeth, they magnify themselves against me.





2 Corinthians 2:6-9

Sufficient to such a man is this punishment, which was inflicted of many. So that contrariwise ye ought rather to forgive him, and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow. Wherefore I beseech you that ye would confirm your love toward him. For to this end also did I write, that I might know the proof of you, whether ye be obedient in all things.





Job 12:1-5 [1-4]

And Job answered and said, No doubt but ye are the people, and wisdom shall die with you. But I have understanding as well as you; I am not inferior to you: yea, who knoweth not such things as these? I am as one mocked of his neighbour, who calleth upon God, and he answereth him: the just upright man is laughed to scorn.





Job 12:5 He that is ready to slip with his feet is as a lamp despised in the thought of him that is at ease. [KJV]

- -[CEV] It's easy to condemn those who are suffering, when you have no troubles.
- -[ERV] Those who have no troubles make fun of those who do. They hit a man when he is down.
- -[ISV] The carefree are thinking, 'I have contempt for misfortune,' Those who are about to stumble deserve it.

Matthew Henry's Concise Commentary

Job upbraids his friends with the good opinion they had of their own wisdom compared with his. We are apt to call reproofs reproaches, and to think ourselves mocked when advised and admonished; this is our folly; yet here was colour for this charge. He suspected the true cause of their conduct to be, that they despised him who was fallen into poverty. It is the way of the world. Even the just, upright man, if he comes under a cloud, is looked upon with contempt.





- DON'T be hasty to do evil (or slow either)
- DON'T be rash with your steps wait
- DON'T walk in crooked or dark paths
- DON'T be the 'Foot of Pride'
- DON'T mock those who's feet slip
- DON'T confuse 'poverty' with a slipping foot, in yourself or others





Luke 9:1-2, 5

Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases. And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick. ... And whatsoever house ye enter into, there abide, and thence depart. And whosoever will not receive you, when ye go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a testimony against them.





Proverbs 4:26

Ponder the path of thy feet, and let all thy ways be established.

Proverbs 19:1-2

Better is the poor that walketh in his integrity, than he that is perverse in his lips, and is a fool. Also, that the soul be without knowledge, it is not good; and he that hasteth with his feet sinneth.





Psalm 119:105

Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

Proverbs 6:23

For the **commandment is a lamp**; and the law is light; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life:

2 Samuel 22:37

Thou hast enlarged my steps under me; so that my feet did not slip.





Psalm 40:1-2

I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry. He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings.

Deuteronomy 8:4

Thy raiment waxed not old upon thee, neither did thy foot swell, these forty years.





Deuteronomy 11:24-25

Every place whereon the soles of your feet shall tread shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even unto the uttermost sea shall your coast be. There shall no man be able to stand before you: for the LORD your God shall lay the fear of you and the dread of you upon all the land that ye shall tread upon, as he hath said unto you.





Romans 8:37-39

Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 10:15

And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the **feet** of them that **preach the gospel of peace**, and **bring glad tidings of good things!**

Ephesians 6:15

And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

- DO ponder/think on the path they take

- DO establish their footing on The Rock, Jesus
- DO trust that they will always prosper in His path
- DO let them be healed and strengthened
- DO have them shod with the Gospel of Peace





Philippians 4:4-7

Rejoice in the Lord alway: and again I say, Rejoice. Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand. Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.
