

Miracles of Jesus In John's Gospel

Jesus Christ

John 1:1-3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was **with** God, and the Word **was** God. The same was in the beginning **with** God. **All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.**

John 1:14 And **the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us,** (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of **the only begotten of the Father,**) full of grace and truth.

John 21:25 And there are also many other things which Jesus did, the which, if they should be written every one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written. Amen.

WATER2WINE

John 2:1-4 And the third day there was **a marriage in Cana of Galilee;** and the mother of Jesus was there: And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage. And when **they wanted wine,** the mother of Jesus saith unto him, **They have no wine.** Jesus saith unto her, **Woman, what have I to do with thee? mine hour is not yet come.**

WATER2WINE

John 2:5-8 His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do *it*. And there were set there **six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews,** containing two or three firkins apiece.

Jesus saith unto them, **Fill the waterpots with water.** And they filled them up to the brim. And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare *it*.

WATER2WINE

John 2:9-10 When the ruler of the feast had tasted **the water that was made wine**, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom, And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth **set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: *but* thou hast kept the good wine until now.**

WATER2WINE

John 2:11 This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; **and his disciples believed on him.**

John 4:1-6 When therefore the Lord knew how the Pharisees had heard that Jesus made and baptized more disciples than John, (Though Jesus himself baptized not, but his disciples,) He left Judaea, and departed again into Galilee. And he must needs go through Samaria. Then cometh he to a city of Samaria, which is called Sychar, near to the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph. Now Jacob's well was there. **Jesus therefore, being wearied with *his* journey, sat thus on the well:** *and* it was about the sixth hour.

WOMAN @ WELL

John 4:7-10 There cometh a woman of **Samaria** to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, **Give me to drink.** (For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.) Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans. Jesus answered and said unto her, **If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee **living water.****

WOMAN @ WELL

John 4:11-14 The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water? Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle? Jesus answered and said unto her, **Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again: But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.**

WOMAN @ WELL

John 4:15-20 The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not, neither come hither to draw. Jesus saith unto her, **Go, call thy husband, and come hither.** The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, **Thou hast well said, I have no husband: For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly.** The woman saith unto him, **Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet.** Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.

WOMAN @ WELL

John 4:21-25 Jesus saith unto her, **Woman,** believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth. The woman saith unto him, **I know that** **Messias cometh, which is called Christ:** **when he is come, he will tell us all things.**

WOMAN@WELL

John 4:26-30 Jesus saith unto her, **I that speak unto thee am he.** And upon this came his disciples, and marvelled that he talked with the woman: yet no man said, What seekest thou? or, Why talkest thou with her? The woman then left her waterpot, and went her way into the city, and saith to the men, **Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ?** Then they went out of the city, and came unto him.

WOMAN @ WELL

John 4:39-42 And many of the Samaritans of that city **believed on him for the saying of the woman, which testified, He told me all that ever I did.** So when the Samaritans were come unto him, they besought him that he would tarry with them: and he abode there two days. **And many more believed because of his own word;** And said unto the woman, Now we believe, not because of thy saying: **for we have heard *him* ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Saviour of the world.**

ROYAL'S SON

John 4:43-46 Now after two days he departed thence, and went into Galilee. For Jesus himself testified, that a prophet hath no honour in his own country. Then when he was come into Galilee, **the Galilaeans received him**, having seen all the things that he did at Jerusalem at the feast: for they also went unto the feast. So Jesus came again into Cana of Galilee, where he made the water wine. **And there was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum.**

ROYAL'S SON

John 4:47-50 When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, **he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death.** Then said Jesus unto him, **Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.** The nobleman saith unto him, **Sir, come down ere my child die.** Jesus saith unto him, **Go thy way; thy son liveth.** And **the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way.**



ROYAL'S SON

John 4:51-54 And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told *him*, saying, **Thy son liveth**. Then inquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, **Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him. So the father knew that *it was* at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, **Thy son liveth**: and himself believed, and his whole house.** This *is* again the second miracle that Jesus did, when he was come out of Judaea into Galilee.

RECLAIM *THE LAME*

Isaiah 35:5-6 Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. **Then shall the lame *man* leap as an hart,** and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.

RECLAIM *THE LAME*

John 5:1-3 After this there was a feast of the Jews; and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep *market* a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches. In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water.

RECLAIM *THE LAME*

John 5:4-6 For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: **whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had.** And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years. When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time *in that case*, he saith unto him, **Wilt thou be made whole?**

RECLAIM *THE LAME*

John 5:7-9 The impotent man answered him, Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me. Jesus saith unto him, **Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.** And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath.

FISHES & LOAVES



Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish. - John 6:11

FISHES & LOAVES



John 6:1-5 After these things Jesus went over the sea of Galilee, which is *the sea* of Tiberias. And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased. And Jesus went up into a mountain, and there he sat with his disciples. And the passover, a feast of the Jews, was nigh. When Jesus then lifted up *his* eyes, and saw a great company come unto him, he saith unto Philip, Whence shall we **buy bread**, that these may eat?

FISHES & LOAVES



John 6:6-10 And this he said to prove him: for he himself knew what he would do. Philip answered him, Two hundred pennyworth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may take a little. One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him, There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many? And Jesus said, **Make the men sit down.** Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

FISHES & LOAVES



John 6:11-15 And **Jesus** took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would. When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, **Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost.** Therefore they gathered them together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten. Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, **This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.** When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

WATER WALKER

John 6:16-20 And when even was *now* come, his disciples went down unto the sea, And entered into a ship, and went over the sea toward Capernaum. And it was now dark, and Jesus was not come to them. And the sea arose by reason of a great wind that blew. So when they had rowed about five and twenty or thirty furlongs, they see **Jesus walking on the sea**, and drawing nigh unto the ship: and they were afraid. But he saith unto them,
It is I; be not afraid.

WATER WALKER

John 6:21-23 Then **they willingly received him** into the ship: **and immediately the ship was at the land whither they went.**

The day following, when the people which stood on the other side of the sea saw that there was none other boat there, save that one whereinto his disciples were entered, **and that Jesus went not with his disciples into the boat, but *that* his disciples were gone away alone;** (Howbeit there came other boats from Tiberias nigh unto the place where they did eat bread, after that the Lord had given thanks:)

WATER WALKER

John 6:23-26 (Howbeit there came other boats from Tiberias nigh unto the place where they did eat bread, after that the Lord had given thanks:)

When the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, neither his disciples, they also took shipping, and came to Capernaum, **seeking for**

Jesus. And when they had found him on the other side of the sea, they said unto him,

Rabbi, when camest thou hither? Jesus answered them and said, **Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled.**

WATER WALKER

John 6:27-30 Labour not for the meat which perisheth, **but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you:** for him hath God the Father sealed. Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? Jesus answered and said unto them, **This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.** They said therefore unto him, **What sign shewest thou then, that we may see, and believe thee? what dost thou work?**

WATER WALKER

John 6:31-35 Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, **He gave them bread from heaven to eat.** Then Jesus said unto them, **Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world. Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread.** And Jesus said unto them, **I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.**

WATER WALKER

John 6:36-41 But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not. **All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.** For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me. **And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.** The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, **I am the bread which came down from heaven.**

HERE'S MUD IN YOUR EYE!

John 9:1-5 And as *Jesus* passed by, he saw a man which was blind from *his birth*. And his disciples asked him, saying, **Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?** Jesus answered, **Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him. I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work. As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.**

HERE'S MUD IN YOUR EYE!

John 9:6-9 When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and **he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay**, And said unto him, **Go, wash in the pool of Siloam**, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing. The neighbours therefore, and **they which before had seen him that he was blind**, said, Is not this he that sat and begged? **Some said, This is he: others said, He is like him: but he said, I am he.**



HERE'S MUD IN YOUR EYE!

John 9:10-14 Therefore said they unto him, How were thine eyes opened? He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight. Then said they unto him, Where is he? He said, I know not. They brought to the Pharisees him that aforetime was blind. And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.



HERE'S MUD IN YOUR EYE!

John 9:15-18 Then again the Pharisees also asked him how he had received his sight. He said unto them, **He put clay upon mine eyes, and I washed, and do see.** Therefore said some of the Pharisees, **This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day.** Others said, **How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles?** And there was a division among them. They say unto the blind man again, What sayest thou of him, that he hath opened thine eyes? He said, **He is a prophet.** But the Jews did not believe concerning him, that he had been blind, and received his sight, until they called the parents of him that had received his sight.

HERE'S MUD IN YOUR EYE!

John 9:19-23 And they asked them, saying, **Is this your son, who ye say was born blind?**

how then doth he now see? His parents answered them and said, **We know that this is our son, and that he was born blind: But by what means he now seeth, we know not; or who hath opened his eyes, we know not: he is of age; ask him: he shall speak for himself.** These *words* spake his parents, because they feared the Jews: for the Jews had agreed already, that if any man did confess that he was Christ, he should be put out of the synagogue. Therefore said his parents, **He is of age; ask him.**

HERE'S MUD IN YOUR EYE!

John 9:24-29 Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, **Give God the praise: we know that this man is a sinner.** He answered and said, **Whether he be a sinner or no, I know not: one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.** Then said they to him again, What did he to thee? how opened he thine eyes? He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear *it* again? will ye also be his disciples? Then they reviled him, and said, Thou art his disciple; but we are Moses' disciples. We know that God spake unto Moses: *as for this fellow, we know not from whence he is.*

HERE'S MUD IN YOUR EYE!

John 9:30-34 The man answered and said unto them, Why herein is a marvellous thing, that ye know not from whence he is, and yet he hath opened mine eyes. Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth. Since the world began was it not heard that any man opened the eyes of one that was born blind. If this man were not of God, he could do nothing. They answered and said unto him, **Thou wast altogether born in sins, and dost thou teach us? And they cast him out.**

HERE'S MUD IN YOUR EYE!

John 9:35-38 Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, **Dost thou believe on the Son of God?** He answered and said, **Who is he, Lord, that I might believe on him?** And Jesus said unto him, **Thou hast both seen him, and it is he that talketh with thee.** And he said, **Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.**

HERE'S MUD IN YOUR EYE!

John 9:39-41 And Jesus said, **For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.** And *some* of the Pharisees which were with him heard these words, and said unto him, **Are we blind also?** Jesus said unto them, **If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth.**

Psalm 146:8 The LORD openeth
the eyes of the blind: the LORD
raiseth them that are bowed down:
the LORD loveth the righteous:

Isaiah 29:18 And in that day shall
the deaf hear the words of the

out of darkness.**


Isaiah 35:5-6 Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then shall the lame *man* leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.

Isaiah 42:7 To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, *and* them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

WHERE'S JESUS?

John 10:40 And went away again **beyond Jordan into the place where John at first baptized; and there he abode.**
41 And many resorted unto him, and said, **John did no miracle: but all things that John spake of this man were true.** **42** And many **believed on him** there

Bethabara (Perea)

John 1:28 These things were done in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.



LEFT & DEAD THEN RESURRECTED!

John 11:1-4 Now a certain *man* was **sick, named Lazarus, of Bethany**, the town of Mary and her sister Martha. (It was *that* Mary which anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped his feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick.) **Therefore his sisters sent unto him, saying, Lord, behold, he whom thou lovest is sick.**

When Jesus heard *that*, he said, **This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby.**

LEFT A DEAD
THEN RESURRECTED!

John 11:5-8 Now Jesus loved Martha, and her sister, and Lazarus. **When he had heard therefore that he was sick, he abode two days still in the same place where he was.** Then after that saith he to *his* disciples, **Let us go into Judaea again.** *His* disciples say unto him, **Master, the Jews of late sought to stone thee; and goest thou thither again?**

LEFT A DEAD
THEN RESURRECTED!

John 11:9-12 Jesus answered, **Are there not twelve hours in the day? If any man walk in the day, he stumbleth not, because he seeth the light of this world. But if a man walk in the night, he stumbleth, because there is no light in him. These things said he: and after that he saith unto them, **Our friend Lazarus sleepeth; but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep.**** Then said his disciples, **Lord, if he sleep, he shall do well.**

Jesus: Hey guys, Lazarus is Dead...And I'm Glad!!!!

LEFT A DEAD
THEN RESURRECTED!

John 11:13-16 Howbeit Jesus spake of his death: but they thought that he had spoken of taking of rest in sleep. Then said Jesus unto them plainly, **Lazarus is dead. And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent ye may believe; nevertheless let us go unto him.** Then said Thomas, which is called Didymus, unto his fellow disciples, **Let us also go, that we may die with him.**

LEFT A DEAD THEN RESURRECTED!

John 11:17-20 Then when Jesus came, he found that he had *lain in the grave four days already*. Now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off: And many of the Jews came to Martha and Mary, to comfort them concerning their brother. Then Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met him: but Mary sat *still* in the house.

LEFT A DEAD

THEN RESURRECTED!

John 11:21-24 Then said Martha unto Jesus, **Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died. But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give *it* thee.** Jesus saith unto her, **Thy brother shall rise again.** Martha saith unto him, **I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.**

LEFT A DEAD
THEN RESURRECTED!

John 11:25-28 Jesus said unto her, **I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?** She saith unto him, **Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.** And when she had so said, she went her way, and called Mary her sister secretly, saying, **The Master is come, and calleth for thee.**

LEFT A DEAD

THEN RESURRECTED!

John 11:29-32 As soon as she heard *that*, she arose quickly, and came unto him. Now Jesus was not yet come into the town, but was in that place where Martha met him. The Jews then which were with her in the house, and comforted her, when they saw Mary, that she rose up hastily and went out, followed her, saying, **She goeth unto the grave to weep there.** Then when Mary was come where Jesus was, and saw him, she fell down at his feet, saying unto him, **Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died.**

LEFT A DEAD THEN RESURRECTED!

John 11:33-37 When Jesus therefore saw her **weeping**, and the Jews also **weeping** which came with her, **he groaned in the spirit, and was troubled**, And said, **Where have ye laid him?** They said unto him, Lord, come and see. **Jesus wept**. Then said the Jews, **Behold how he loved him!** And some of them said, Could not this man, which opened the eyes of the blind, have caused that even this man should not have died?

LEFT A DEAD
THEN RESURRECTED!



John 11:38-41 Jesus therefore again **groaning in himself** cometh to the grave. It was a cave, and a stone lay upon it. Jesus said, **Take ye away the stone.** Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, **Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been *dead* four days.** Jesus saith unto her, **Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God?** Then they took away the stone *from the place* where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up *his* eyes, and said, **Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.**

LEFT A DEAD

THEN RESURRECTED!

John 11:42-46 **And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may believe that thou hast sent me.** And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, **Lazarus, come forth.** And **he that was dead came forth**, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, **Loose him, and let him go.** Then many of the Jews which came to Mary, and **had seen the things which Jesus did, believed on him.** But some of them went their ways to the Pharisees, and told them what things Jesus had done.



John 5:24-26 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and **believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.** Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear **shall live.** For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;

LEFT A DEAD
THEN RESURRECTED!

John 5:27-29 And hath given him authority to **execute judgment** also, because **he is the Son of man**. Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which **all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.**



1 Corinthians 15:51-55 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, **and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.** So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. **O death, where *is* thy sting? O grave, where *is* thy victory?**



WRAP UP



John 20:3-9 Peter therefore went forth, and that other disciple, and came to the sepulchre. So they ran both together: and the other disciple did outrun Peter, and came first to the sepulchre. And he stooping down, *and looking in*, saw the linen clothes lying; yet went he not in. Then cometh Simon Peter following him, and went into the sepulchre, and **seeth the linen clothes lie**, And the napkin, that was about his head, not lying with the linen clothes, but **wrapped together in a place by itself**. Then went in also that other disciple, which came first to the sepulchre, and he saw, and believed. For as yet they knew not the scripture, that he must rise again from the dead.






John 20:25-29 The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe. And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: ***then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you.*** Then saith he to Thomas, ***Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.*** And Thomas answered and said unto him, ***My Lord and my God.*** ***Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.***



153 FISH

John 21:1-6 After these things Jesus shewed himself again to the disciples at the sea of Tiberias; and on this wise shewed he *himself*. There were together Simon Peter, and Thomas called Didymus, and Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, and the *sons* of Zebedee, and two other of his disciples. Simon Peter saith unto them, **I go a fishing.** They say unto him, We also go with thee. They went forth, and entered into a ship immediately; and that night they caught nothing. But when the morning was now come, Jesus stood on the shore: but the disciples knew not that it was Jesus. Then Jesus saith unto them, **Children, have ye any meat?** They answered him, No. And he said unto them, **Cast the net on the right side of the ship, and ye shall find.** **They cast therefore, and now they were not able to draw it for the multitude of fishes.**




153 FISH

John 21:7-11 Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt *his* fisher's coat *unto him*, (for he was naked,) and did cast himself into the sea. And the other disciples came in a little ship; (for they were not far from land, but as it were two hundred cubits,) dragging the net with fishes. As soon then as they were come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid thereon, and bread. Jesus saith unto them, **Bring of the fish which ye have now caught.** **Simon Peter went up, and drew the net to land full of great fishes, an hundred and fifty and three: and for all there were so many, yet was not the net broken.**
