

Jesus Christ came into the world to save sinners

Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief. 1 Timothy 1:15

Hebrews 2:9-10 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that He by the grace of God should taste death for every man. For it became Him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the Captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

Hebrews 2:14-15 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, He also Himself likewise took part of the same; that through death He might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

FOR GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD that He gave His one and only Son, that wHOEVER BELIEVES IN HIM shall NOT perish but have ETERNAL LIFE OHN 3:16

Jesus Christ came into the world not to bring peace, but division and a sword

Matthew 10:34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. 35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.

Luke 12:49 I am come to send fire on the earth; and what will I, if it be already kindled? 50 But I have a baptism to be baptized with; and how am I straitened till it be accomplished! 51 Suppose ye that I am come to give peace on earth? I tell you, Nay; but rather division: 52 For from henceforth there shall be five in one house divided, three against two, and two against three. 53 The father shall be divided against the son, and the son against the father; the mother against the daughter, and the daughter against the mother; the mother in law against her daughter in law, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.

Jesus Christ came into the world to reconcile the world to God

Wherefore in all things it behoved Him to be made like unto His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

Hebrews 2:17

For if, while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we will be saved by His life.

Romans 5:10

But all things are of God, who reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and gave to us the ministry of reconciliation; namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not reckoning to them their trespasses, and having committed to us the word of reconciliation.

2 Corinthians 5:18-19

Jesus Christ came into the world to fulfill the law and make it honorable

"Don't think that I came to destroy the law or the prophets. I didn't come to destroy, but to fulfill."

Matthew 5:17

It pleased Yehovah, for His righteousness' sake, to magnify the law, and make it honorable.

Isaiah 42:21

Jesus Christ came into the world to redeem them that were under the Law

Galatians 4:4-5 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth His Son, made of a woman, made under the law, To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. Jesus Christ came into the world to confirm the promises to the fathers and to bring in the gentiles

Romans 15:8-12 Now I say that Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises *made* unto the fathers: And that the Gentiles might glorify God for *his* mercy; as it is written, For this cause I will confess to thee among the Gentiles, and sing unto thy name. And again he saith, Rejoice, ye Gentiles, with his people. And again, Praise the Lord, all ve Gentiles; and laud him, all ye people. And again, Esaias saith, There shall be a root of Jesse, and he that shall rise to reign over the Gentiles; in him shall the Gentiles trust.

Jesus Christ came into the world to be the new covenant

Isaiah 42:6-7 I the LORD have called Thee in righteousness, and will hold Thine hand, and will keep Thee, and give Thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles; To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, *and* them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

Jesus Christ came into the world to be a Light in the world

I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on Me should not abide in darkness.

John 12:46-48

Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

Matthew 5:14

Jesus Christ came into the world to be a King and bear witness to the truth

Pilate therefore said to him, "Are you a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. For this reason I have been born, and for this reason I have come into the world, that I should testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice."

John 18:37

The world can't hate you [Jesus' unbelieving brothers], but it hates Me, because I testify about it, that its works are evil.

John 7:7

If the world hates you, you know that it has hated Me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would love its own. But because you are not of the world, since I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

John 15:18-19

Jesus Christ came into the world to preach the Gospel

"The Spirit of the Lord is on Me, Because He has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim release to the captives, Recovering of sight to the blind, To deliver those who are crushed, And to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."

Luke 4:18-19

The Spirit of the Lord Yehovah is on me; because Yehovah has anointed Me to preach good news to the humble; He has sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;

Isaiah 61:1

And He said unto them, I must preach the kingdom of God to other cities also: for therefore am I sent.

Luke 4:43

He said to them, "Let's go elsewhere into the next towns, that I may preach there also, because for this reason I came forth." He went into their synagogues throughout all Galilee, preaching and casting out demons.

Mark 1:38-39

Now after John was taken into custody, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the Good News of the Kingdom of God, and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the Kingdom of God is at hand! Repent, and believe in the Good News."

Mark 1:14-15

Jesus Christ came into the world to seek and save the lost

For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.

Matthew 18:11

For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

Luke 19:10

Jesus Christ came into the world to call sinners to repentance

And as Jesus passed forth from thence, He saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and He saith unto him, Follow Me. And he arose, and followed Him. And it came to pass, as Jesus sat at meat in the house, behold, many publicans and sinners came and sat down with Him and His disciples. And when the Pharisees saw it, they said unto His disciples, Why eateth your Master with publicans and sinners? But when Jesus heard that, He said unto them, They that be whole need not a physician, but they that are sick. But you go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, and not sacrifice,' for I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."

Matthew 9:9-13 (also Mark 2:14-17 & Luke 5:29-32)

Jesus Christ came into the world that men might have abundant Life

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

John 10:10

In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him.

1 John 4:9

For God so loved the world, that He gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

John 3:16-19

Jesus Christ came into the world to do the Will of His Father

For I came down from heaven, not to do Mine own will, but the will of Him that sent Me. And this is the Father's will which hath sent Me, that of all which He hath given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. And this is the will of Him that sent Me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on Him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

John 6:38-40

He went forward a little, fell on his face, and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass away from me; nevertheless, not what I desire, but what you desire."

Matthew 26:39

Jesus Christ came into the world to destroy the devil and his works, and deliver us

Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, He also Himself likewise took part of the same; that through death He might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Hebrews 2:14-15

He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

1 John 3:8

Jesus Christ came into the world to serve

Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give His life a ransom for many.

Matthew 20:28

For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give His life a ransom for many.

Mark 10:45

Jesus came to serve!

John 9:39

And if any man hear My words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world. He that rejecteth Me, and receiveth not My words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

John 12:47,48

For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them...

Luke 9:56

Jesus Christ came into the world to bear His cross and be faithful unto death

Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save Me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour.

John 12:27

"If anyone comes to Me, and doesn't hate his own father, mother, wife, children, brothers, and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he can't be My disciple. Whoever doesn't bear his own cross, and come after Me, can't be My disciple."

Luke 14:26-27

He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me; and he who loves son or daughter more than Me isn't worthy of Me. He who doesn't take his cross and follow after Me, isn't worthy of Me. He who finds his life will lose it; and he who loses his life for My sake will find it.
