

## RUSH HASHANA??

"ROSH HA-SHANAH, the Jewish New Year, the autumn festival celebrated on the first and second days of Tishri. In the Bible. The name Rosh Ha-Shanah as it is used in the Bible (Ezek. 40:1) simply means the beginning of the year, and does not designate the festival. The months of the year were counted from the spring month (Ex. 12:2), later called by the Babylonian name Nisan. The month known by the Babylonian name Tishri is, therefore, called the "seventh month" in the Pentateuch. When the festival on the first of this month is recorded, it is referred to as the festival of the seventh month and a day of "memorial proclaimed with the blast of horns," or "a day of blowing the horn" (Lev. 23:23-25; Num. 29:1-6). In the Bible, the festival lasts one day only; the two-day festival arose out of the difficulty of determining when the new moon actually appeared."

#### TRUMPETS

Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 2689. חֵצֹאָרָה chatsots@rah *khats-o-tser-aw'* by reduplication from 2690; a trumpet (from its sundered or quavering note):—trumpet(-er). **Blow/Sounded Trumpets** Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 2690. חַצָר chatsar khaw*tsar'* a primitive root; properly, to surround with a stockade, and thus separate from the open country; but used only in the reduplicated form chatsotser (khast-o-tsare'); or (2 Chronicles 5:12) chatsorer (khats-o-rare'); as dem. from 2689; to trumpet, i.e. blow on that instrument:—blow, sound, trumpeter.

Leviticus 23:23-25 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first *day* of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial [zikrown]of blowing [teruah] of trumpets, an holy convocation. Ye shall do no servile work *therein*: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

Numbers 29:1 And in the seventh month, on the first *day* of the month, ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work: it is a day of **blowing** [teruah] the trumpets unto you.

Ezra 3:13 So that the people could not discern the noise of the shout of [teruah] joy from the noise of the weeping of the people: for the people shouted with a loud shout, and the noise was heard afar off.

Numbers 10:1-4 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Make thee **two trumpets of silver**[chatsotserah]; of a whole piece shalt thou make them: that thou mayest use them for the calling of the assembly, and for the journeying of the camps. And when they shall blow [taga] with them, all the assembly shall assemble themselves to thee at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. And if they blow [taqa] but with one trumpet, then the princes, which are heads of the thousands of Israel, shall gather themselves unto thee.

FEAST OF TRUMPETS & Numbers 10:5-8 When ye blow [taqa] an alarm[teruah], then the camps that lie on the east parts shall go forward. When ye blow [taqa] an alarm [teruah] the second time, then the camps that lie on the south side shall take their journey: they shall blow [taqa] an alarm [teruah] for their journeys. But when the congregation is to be gathered together, ye shall blow [taqa], but ye shall **not** sound an alarm [ruah]. And the sons of Aaron, the priests, shall blow [taqa] with the trumpets [chatsotserah]; and they shall be to you for an ordinance for ever throughout your generations.

FEAST OF TRU Numbers 10:9-10 And if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresseth you, then ye shall **blow an alarm** [ruah] with the trumpets [chatsotserah]; and ye shall be remembered before the LORD your God, and ye shall be saved from your enemies. Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, ye shall blow with the trumpets [chatsotserah]; over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; that they may be to you for a memorial [zikrown] before your God: I am the LORD your God.

Matthew Henry's Concise Commentary has this to say about the feast: **"The blowing of trumpets** represented the preaching of the gospel, by which men are called to repent of sin, and to accept the salvation of Christ, which was signified by the Day of Atonement.

Also it invited to rejoice in God, and become strangers and pilgrims on earth, which was denoted by the feast of Tabernacles, observed in the same month. At the beginning of the year, they were called by this sound of trumpet to shake off spiritual drowsiness, to search and try their ways, and to amend them.

The day of atonement was the ninth day after this; thus they were awakened to prepare for that day, by sincere and serious repentance, that it might indeed be to them a day of atonement. The humbling of our souls for sin, and the making our peace with God, is work that requires the whole man, and the closest application of mind. On that day God spake peace to his people, and to his saints; therefore they must lay aside all their wordly business, that they might the more clearly hear that voice of joy and gladness. –Matthew Henry

•2 Samuel 18:24 And David sat between the two gates: and the watchman went up to the roof over the gate unto the wall, and lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold a man running alone.

•Assess & Warn WATCHMEN IN THE OT •2 Samuel 18:25-26 And the watchman cried, and told the king. And the king said, If he be alone, there is tidings in his mouth. And he came apace, and drew near. And the watchman saw another man running: and the watchman called unto the porter, and said, Behold another man running alone. And the king said, He also bringeth tidings.

#### •Assess & Warn

 2 Samuel 18:27 And the watchman said, Me thinketh the running of the foremost is like the running of Ahimaaz the son of Zadok. And the king said, He is a good man, and cometh with good tidings.

  - "Watchdogs, legalists, harsh, unforgiving, unloving



- "It is wrong to publicly name men as false teachers"
  - -Was it wrong for Paul? 1 Tim. 1: 18-20; 2 Tim. 2:16-18
    - Divisive & ungodly men: 2 Tim. 1:15; 4:10, 14-15; 3 John. 9-10
    - Godly, sound men: 3 John. 11-12; 2 Tim. 1:16-18; Phil. 2:19-22, 25


