






Psalms 90:8-12

- 12) So teach *us* to number our days, that we may apply *our* hearts unto wisdom.




Luke 12:16-40

And Noah builded an altar unto the LORD; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.




Genesis 12:7

Genesis 22:9

And they came to the place which God had told him of; and Abraham built an altar there, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar upon the wood.



Genesis 26:24-25

24) And the LORD appeared unto him the same night, and said, I am the God of Abraham thy father: fear not, for I am with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for my servant Abraham's sake.

25) And he builded an altar there, and called upon the name of the LORD, and pitched his tent there: and there Isaac's servants digged a well.



Genesis 33:18-20

18) And Jacob came to Shalem, a city of Shechem, which *is* in the land of Canaan, when he came from Padanaram; and pitched his tent before the city.

19) And he bought a parcel of a field, where he had spread his tent, at the hand of the children of Hamor, Shechem's father, for an hundred pieces of money.

20) And he erected there an altar, and called it El Elohe-Israel


(Lit. God, the God of Israel)



Exodus 17:12-15

- 12) But Moses' hands were heavy; and they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon; and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.
- 13) And Joshua discomfited Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword.
- 14) And the LORD said unto Moses, Write this *for* a memorial in a book, and rehearse *it* in the ears of Joshua: for I will utterly put out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven.
- 15) And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it Jehovahnissi:

(YHVH is My Banner)



Exodus 24:3-5


- 3) And Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD, and all the judgments: and all the people answered with one voice, and said, All the words which the LORD hath said will we do.
- 4) And Moses wrote all the words of the LORD, and rose up early in the morning, and builded an altar under the hill, and twelve pillars, according to the twelve tribes of Israel.
- 5) And he sent young men of the children of Israel, which offered burnt offerings, and sacrificed peace offerings of oxen unto the LORD.

Exodus 27:1-8;

- Acacia wood plated with bronze. 3 ft high x 7.5 ft wide x 7.5 ft long.
- The place where God promised that sin could be atoned by the blood of the sacrifice.

Exodus 30:1


And thou shalt make an altar to burn incense upon: of shittim wood shalt thou make it.

Exodus 30:3

And thou shalt overlay it with pure gold, the top thereof, and the sides thereof round about, and the horns thereof; and thou shalt make unto it a crown of gold round about.

Exodus 30:6-8

- 6) And thou shalt put it before the vail that *is* by the ark of the testimony, before the mercy seat that *is* over the testimony, where I will meet with thee.
- 7) And Aaron shall burn thereon sweet incense every morning: when he dresseth the lamps, he shall burn incense upon it.
- 8) And when Aaron lighteth the lamps at even, he shall burn incense upon it, a perpetual incense before the LORD throughout your generations.



Luke 1:67-75

- 67) And his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Ghost, and prophesied, saying,
- 68) Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people,
- 69) And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;
- 70) As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began:
- 71) That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us;
- 72) To perform the mercy *promised* to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant;
- 73) The oath which he sware to our father Abraham,
- 74) That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear,
- 75) In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life.

2 Sameul 22:2-7

- 2) And he said, The LORD *is* my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer;
- 3) The God of my rock; in him will I trust: *he is* my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from violence.
- 4) I will call on the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.
- 5) When the waves of death compassed me, the floods of ungodly men made me afraid;
- 6) The sorrows of hell compassed me about; the snares of death prevented me;
- 7) In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried to my God: and he did hear my voice out of his temple, and my cry *did enter* into his ears.

Psalms 18:2-3

- 2) The Lord *is* my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, *and* my high tower.
- 3) I will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.

Genesis 2:18

Then the LORD God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him."

Exodus 19:5-6

- 5) Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth *is* mine:
- 6) And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These *are* the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.

The Purpose of the Burnt Offering

- Dedication meaning "that which ascends"
- First of 5 offerings (Meal, sin, trespassing, and peace offerings)

Whole offering burnt, not partially

The Process of Burnt Offering

- Bullock, sheep, or dove depending on Economic status Lev. 1:2, 14
 Without blemish Lev. 1:3
 Give the best
- At the door or gate near the brazen altar Lev. 1: 3
- His Voluntary will Lev. 1:3
- Putting his hand on the head of the burnt offering
- The offerer kills the offering himself, not the priest Lev. 1:5

He wants a Helper

Colosians 1:12-16

- 12) Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:
- 13) Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son:
- 14) In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:
- 15) Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:
- 16) For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

1Corinthians 15:45-49

- 45) Thus it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being"; the last Adam became a life-giving spirit.
- 46) But it is not the spiritual that is first but the natural, and then the spiritual.
- 47) The first man was from the earth, a man of dust; the second man is from heaven.
- 48) As was the man of dust, so also are those who are of the dust, and as is the man of heaven, so also are those who are of heaven.
- 49) Just as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the man of heaven.

1Corinthians 6:15-20

- 15) Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take the members of Christ and make them members of a prostitute? Never!
- 16) Or do you not know that he who is joined to a prostitute becomes one body with her? For, as it is written, "The two will become one flesh."
- 17) But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him.
- 18) Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body.
- 19) Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own,
- 20) for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

Romans 8:14-17

- 14) For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
- 15) For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
- 16) The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:
- 17) And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with *him*, that we may be also glorified together.

Genesis 1:26-28

- 26) And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.
- 27) So God created man in his *own* image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.
- 28) And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

Romans 12:1-2

- 1) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.
- 2) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

1 John 3:1-3

- 1) Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.
- 2) Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.
- 3) And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

- 1) Judge not, that ye be not judged.
- 2) For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.
- 3) And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?
- 4) Or how wilt thou say to thy brother, Let me pull out the mote out of thine eye; and, behold, a beam is in thine own eye?
- 5) Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

1Corinthians 5:9-13

- 9) I wrote unto you in an epistle not to company with fornicators:
- 10) Yet not altogether with the fornicators of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or with idolaters; for then must ye needs go out of the world.
- 11) But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.
- 12) For what have I to do to judge them also that are without? do not ye judge them that are within?
- 13) But them that are without God judgeth. Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person.
