# The Temple of God

**Exodus 22:6–11 [6]** If **fire break out**, and catch in thorns, so that the stacks of corn, or the standing corn, or the field, be consumed therewith; **he that kindled the fire** shall surely make **restitution**.

**Exodus 22:6–11 [7–8]** If a man shall **deliver unto his neighbour** money or stuff to keep, and it be **stolen** out of the man's house; **if the thief be found, let him pay double**. If the **thief be not found**, then the **master** of the house shall be brought unto the **judges**, to see whether **he have put his hand unto his neighbour's goods**.



# The Temple of God

## Exodus 22:6–11 [9]

**For all manner of trespass**, whether it be for ox, for ass, for sheep, for raiment, or for any manner of lost thing, which another challengeth to be his, the cause of both parties shall come before the judges; and **whom the judges shall condemn**, he shall pay double unto his neighbour.



# The Temple of God

## Exodus 22:6–11 [10–11]

If a man **deliver unto his neighbour** an ass, or an ox, or a sheep, or any beast, to keep; and it die, or be hurt, or driven away, **no man seeing it:** Then shall an **oath of the LORD** be between them both, that he hath **not put his hand unto his neighbour's goods;** and the owner of it **shall accept thereof,** and he shall not make it good.





# The Temple of God

## 1 Chronicles 17:1–2

Now it came to pass, as David sat in his house, that **David said to Nathan the prophet**, Lo, I dwell in an house of cedars, but the ark of the covenant of the LORD remaineth under curtains. Then Nathan said unto David, Do **all that is in thine heart**; for God is with thee.

## 2 Chronicles 6:7

Now it was in the **heart of David** my father to build an house for the name of the LORD God of Israel.

# The Temple of God

## 2 Chronicles 5:1

Thus all the work that Solomon made for the house of the LORD **was finished**: and Solomon brought in all the things that David his father had dedicated; and the silver, and the gold, and all the instruments, put he among the treasures of the **house of God**.

## 2 Chronicles 5:13b–14

...and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that then the **house was filled with a cloud**, even the house of the LORD; So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: **for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God**.

# The Temple of God

## Mark 11:15–17

And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the **temple**, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves; And would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple. And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, **My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer?** but ye have made it a den of thieves.



# The Temple of God

## Psalm 103:8–12

The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. He will not always chide: neither will he keep his anger for ever. **He hath not dealt with us after our sins;** nor rewarded us according to our **iniquities**. For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him. As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.





# The Temple of God

## Romans 9:22–23

What if God, willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the **vessels of wrath** fitted to destruction: And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory,

## Ezekiel 18:23

Have I **any pleasure** at all that the **wicked should die?** saith the Lord GOD: and not that he should return from his ways, and live?



# The Temple of God

## Deuteronomy 17:14

When thou art come unto the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, and shalt possess it, and shalt dwell therein, and shalt **say, I will set a king over me**, like as all the nations that are about me;

## 1 Samuel 8:5

And said unto him, Behold, thou art old, and thy sons walk not in thy ways: now **make us a king to judge us like all the nations.**



# The Temple of God

**1 Samuel 8:6–7** But the thing **displeased Samuel**, when they said, Give us a king to **judge** us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD. And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but **they have rejected me**, that I should not **reign** over them.

**Luke 19:14** But **his citizens hated him**, and sent a message after him, saying, We will not have this man to **reign** over us.



# The Temple of God

**Deuteronomy 24:1–4** When a man hath taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, because he hath found some uncleanness in her: then let him write her a **bill of divorcement**, and give it in her hand, and send her out of his house. And when she is departed out of his house, **she may go and be another man's wife.**

**Matthew 19:8** He saith unto them, Moses **because of the hardness of your hearts** suffered you to put away your wives: but **from the beginning it was not so.**



# The Temple of God

## Lamentations 3:22–23

It is of the LORD'S mercies that **we are not consumed**, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.





# The Temple of God

## Philippians 2:8

And being found in fashion as a man, he **humbled** himself, and became obedient unto death, even the **death of the cross**.

## Hebrews 12:2

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, **despising the shame**, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.



# The Temple of God

## Acts 7:47–51

But **Solomon built him an house**. Howbeit the most High dwelleth **not in temples** made with hands; as saith the prophet, Heaven is my throne, and earth is my footstool: **what house will ye build me?** saith the Lord: or what is the place of my rest? Hath not my hand **made all these things?** Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers did, so do ye.



# The Temple of God

## 2 Samuel 7:4–7

And it came to pass that night, that the word of the LORD came unto Nathan, saying, **Go and tell my servant David**, Thus saith the LORD, Shalt thou build me an house for me to dwell in? Whereas I have not dwelt in any house since the time that I brought up the children of Israel out of Egypt, even to this day, but have walked in a tent and in a tabernacle. In all the places wherein I have walked with all the children of Israel spake I a word with any of the tribes of Israel, whom I commanded to feed my people Israel, saying, **Why build ye not me an house of cedar?**



# The Temple of God

## Revelation 21:1–2

And I saw a **new** heaven and a **new** earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the **holy city, new Jerusalem**, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

## Revelation 21:22

**And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.**



# The Temple of God

**Deuteronomy 32:9a** For the LORD'S portion is his **people**...

**Revelation 7:9** After this I beheld, and, lo, a **great multitude**, which no man could number, of **all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues**, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

**Revelation 7:15** Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and **he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.**





# The Temple of God

## Romans 9:31–33

But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness. Wherefore? Because they sought it **not by faith**, but as it were **by the works of the law**. For they stumbled at that **stumblingstone**; As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.



# The Temple of God

## 1 Corinthians 3:11–17 [11-14]

For other **foundation** can no man lay than that is laid, which is **Jesus Christ**. Now if any man build upon this foundation **gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble**; Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath **built thereupon**, he shall receive a reward.



# The Temple of God

## 1 Corinthians 3:11–17 [15-17]

If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire. Know ye not that **ye are the temple of God**, and that the **Spirit of God dwelleth in you**? If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy,

**which temple ye are.**



# The Temple of God

## 2 Samuel 7:12–16

And when thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall proceed out of thy bowels, **and I will establish his kingdom.** He shall build **an house for my name,** and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom **for ever.** I will be his **father,** and he shall be my **son.** If he **commit iniquity,** I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men: But my **mercy shall not depart away from him,** as I took it from Saul, whom I put away before thee. And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: **thy throne shall be established for ever.**



# The Temple of God

## 1 Chronicles 17:16–18

And **David the king** came and sat before the LORD, and said, **Who am I**, O LORD God, and **what is mine house**, that thou hast brought me hitherto? And yet this was a small thing in thine eyes, O God; for thou hast also spoken of thy servant's house for a **great while to come**, and hast **regarded me according to the estate of a man of high degree**, O LORD God. **What can David speak more** to thee for the honour of thy servant? for thou knowest thy servant.





# The Temple of God

**Romans 5:6–8** For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, **while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.**

**Jeremiah 1:5** Before I formed thee in the **belly I knew thee**; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.



# The Temple of God

## Psalm 139:16

Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and **in thy book all my members were written**, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them.

## Ephesians 2:10

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus **unto good works**, which God hath **before ordained that we should walk in them.**

# The Temple of God

## 2 Chronicles 6:14–21 [14-16]

And *[Solomon]* said, O LORD God of Israel, there is no God like thee in the heaven, nor in the earth; which keepest covenant, and shewest mercy unto thy servants, that walk before thee with all their hearts: Thou which hast kept with thy servant David my father that which thou hast promised him; and spakest with thy mouth, and hast fulfilled it with thine hand, as it is this day. Now therefore, O LORD God of Israel, keep with thy servant David my father that which thou hast promised him, saying, There shall not fail thee a man in my sight to sit upon the throne of Israel; yet so that thy children take heed to their way to walk in my law, as thou hast walked before me.

# The Temple of God

## 2 Chronicles 6:14–21 [17-19]

Now then, O LORD God of Israel, let thy word be verified, which thou hast spoken unto thy servant David. **But will God in very deed dwell with men on the earth?** behold, heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain thee; how much less this house which I have built! **Have respect therefore to the prayer of thy servant,** and to his supplication, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the cry and the prayer which thy servant prayeth before thee:



# The Temple of God

## 2 Chronicles 6:14–21 [20-21]

That thine eyes may be open upon this house day and night, upon the place whereof thou hast said that thou wouldest put thy name there; to hearken unto the prayer which thy servant prayeth toward this place. **Hearken therefore unto the supplications of thy servant**, and of thy people Israel, which they shall make **toward this place**: hear thou from thy dwelling place, even from heaven; **and when thou hearest, forgive.**



# The Temple of God

**John 16:22–24** And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you. And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall **ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.** Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

**Psalms 34:15** The **eyes of the LORD are upon** the righteous, and **his ears are open unto their cry.**





# The Temple of God

## James 4:5

Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The **spirit that dwelleth in us** lusteth to envy?

## 1 Corinthians 2:11–12

For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the **things of God knoweth no man**, but the Spirit of God. Now **we have received**, not the spirit of the world, **but the spirit which is of God**; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.



# The Temple of God

## Colossians 1:27–29

To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is **Christ in you**, the hope of glory: Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in **Christ Jesus**: Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, **which worketh in me mightily**.



# The Temple of God

## Solomon's Prayer [2 Chron 6]

**(v22)** When someone is **accused of sinning against his neighbor** and the latter pronounces a curse on the alleged offender before your altar in this temple

**(v23)** listen from heaven and **make a just decision** about your servants' claims. Condemn the guilty party, declare the other innocent...

*NET version*



# The Temple of God

## Matthew 5:11

Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you **falsely**, for my sake.

## 1 Peter 3:16

Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that **falsely** accuse your good conversation in Christ.



# The Temple of God

## Psalm 94:21–22

They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous, and **condemn the innocent blood**. But the **LORD is my defence**; and my God is the rock of my **refuge**.

## Isaiah 53:7

He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, **yet he opened not his mouth**: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, **so he openeth not his mouth**.



# The Temple of God

## Solomon's Prayer [2 Chron 6]

**(v26)** When the heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against thee

**(v26)** yet if they pray toward this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou dost afflict them

**(v27)** Then hear thou from heaven, and forgive the sin of thy servants



# The Temple of God

**Hebrews 3:6** But Christ as a son over his own house; **whose house are we**, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end.

**Hebrews 4:16** Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help **in time of need**.

**1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, **he is faithful** and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.





# The Temple of God

## 1 Kings 8:41-43

Moreover concerning a **stranger**, that is not of thy people Israel, but cometh out of a far country for thy name's sake; (For they shall hear of thy great name, and of thy strong hand, and of thy stretched out arm;) when he shall come and **pray toward this house**; Hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calleth to thee for: that all people of the earth may know thy name, to fear thee, as do thy people Israel; and that they may know that this house, **which I have builded**, is called by thy name.



# The Temple of God

## 2 Chronicles 6:40–42

Now, my God, let, **I beseech thee, thine eyes be open, and let thine ears be attent** unto the prayer that is made in this place. Now therefore arise, O LORD God, into thy resting place, thou, and the ark of thy strength: let thy priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation, and let thy saints rejoice in goodness. O LORD God, turn not away the face of thine anointed: remember the mercies of David thy servant.



# The Temple of God

## Acts 15:13–18

And after they had held their peace, James answered, saying, Men and brethren, hearken unto me: Simeon hath declared how **God at the first did visit the Gentiles, to take out of them a people for his name.** And to this agree the **words of the prophets**; as it is written, After this I will return, and will **build again the tabernacle of David**, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up: That the residue of men might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, saith the Lord, who doeth all these things. **Known unto God are all his works from the beginning of the world.**



# The Temple of God

## Hebrews 9:1–2a

Then verily the first covenant had also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary. For **there was a tabernacle made;**

## Hebrews 9:6–12 [6-7]

Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of God. But into the **second went the high priest alone once every year**, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people:

# The Temple of God

## Hebrews 9:6–12 [8-10]

The **Holy Ghost this signifying**, that the way into the holiest of all was **not yet made manifest**, while as the **first tabernacle was yet standing**: Which was **a figure for the time then present**, in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience; Which stood only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed on them **until the time of reformation**.



# The Temple of God

## Hebrews 9:6–12 [11-12]

But **Christ** being come an high priest of good things to come, by **a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands**, that is to say, not of this building; Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.



# The Temple of God

## Hebrews 10:19–22

Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, By a **new and living way**, which **he hath consecrated for us**, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; And having an high priest over the house of God; **Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith**, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.





# The Temple of God

## Romans 8:8–16 [8-11]

So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God. But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the **Spirit of God dwell in you**. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. And if **Christ be in you**, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead **dwell in you**, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his **Spirit that dwelleth in you**.



# The Temple of God

## Romans 8:8–16 [12-16]

Therefore, brethren, **we are debtors**, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the **Spirit of adoption**, whereby we cry, **Abba, Father**. The **Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:**



# The Temple of God

## 1 John 3:24

And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and **he [God] in him**. And hereby we know that **he abideth in us**, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

## Galatians 2:20

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but **Christ liveth in me**: and the life which I now live in the flesh **I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.**



# The Temple of God

## John 17:20–23

Neither pray I for these alone, but **for them also** which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may **be one**; as thou, Father, **art in me, and I in thee**, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: **I in them, and thou in me**, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.



# The Temple of God

## Ezekiel 36:26

A **new heart** also will I give you, and a **new spirit** will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.

## 2 Corinthians 6:16

And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for **ye are the temple of the living God**; as God hath said, **I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.**



# The Temple of God

## Matthew 25:34

Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye **blessed of my Father**, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

## Philippians 1:6

Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it **until the day of Jesus Christ**:
