Deuteronomy 7:22a says **“And the LORD thy God will put out those nations before thee by little and little ...**

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Exodus 23:20-22 Behold, I send an Angel before **thee**, to **keep thee in the way**, and **to bring thee into the place which I have prepared**. Beware of him, and **obey** his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: **for my name is in him**. But if **thou** shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Exodus 23:23-25 For **mine** Angel shall go before thee, and bring **thee** in unto the Amorites, and the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Canaanites, *and* the Hivites, and the Jebusites: and I will cut them off. **Thou shalt not** bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do after their works: but **thou shalt** utterly overthrow them, and quite break down their images. And **ye shall serve** the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Exodus 23:26-28 There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil. **I will send my fear before thee, and will destroy all the people to whom thou shalt come, and I will make all thine enemies turn their backs unto thee. And I will send hornets before thee, which shall drive out the Hivite, the Canaanite, and the Hittite, from before thee.**

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Exodus 23:29-30 I will not drive them out from before thee in one year; lest the land become desolate, and the beast of the field multiply against thee. **By little and little I will drive them out from before thee, until thou be increased, and inherit the land.**

1 Corinthians 10:1-4 Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; And did all eat the same spiritual meat; And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

1 Corinthians 10:5-8 But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in the wilderness. **Now these things were our examples**, to the intent we should not lust after evil things, as they also lusted. Neither be ye idolaters, as *were* some of them; as it is written, The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play. Neither let us commit fornication, as some of them committed, and fell in one day three and twenty thousand.

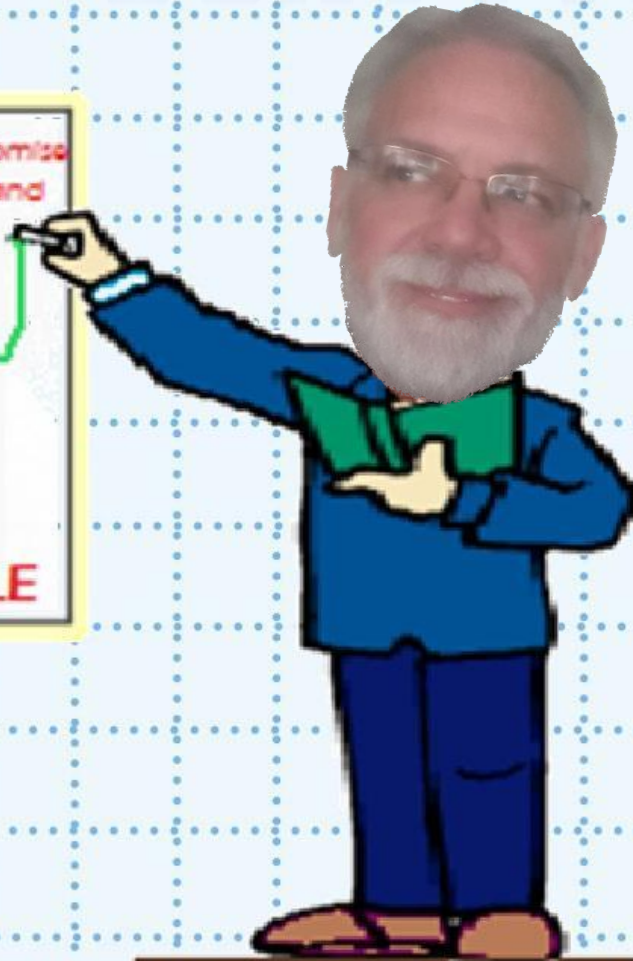
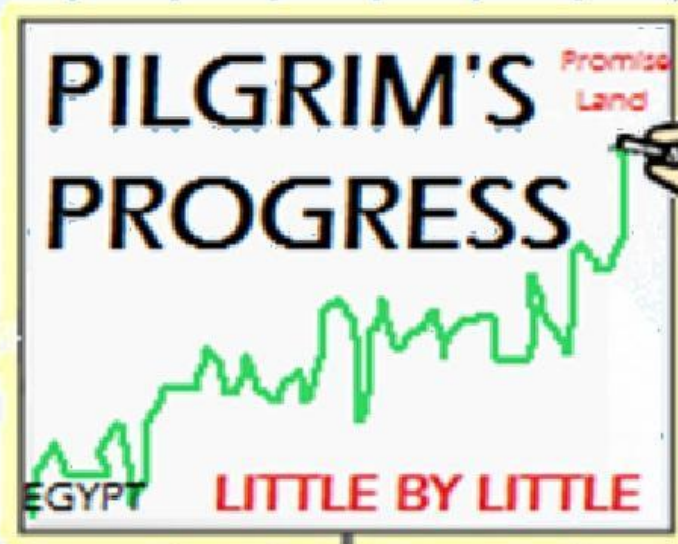
BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

1 Corinthians 10:9-11 Neither let us tempt Christ, as some of them also tempted, and were destroyed of serpents. Neither murmur ye, as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed of the destroyer. **Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples:** and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.

1 Corinthians 10:12-14 Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall. There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God *is* faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear *it*. Wherefore, my dearly beloved, **flee** from idolatry.

Exodus 23:31-33 And I will set thy bounds from the Red sea even unto the sea of the Philistines, and from the desert unto the river: for I will deliver the inhabitants of the land into your hand; and thou shalt drive them out before thee. Thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor with their gods. They shall not dwell in thy land, lest they make thee sin against me: for if thou serve their gods, it will surely be a snare unto thee.

Deuteronomy 6:1-2 Now these *are* the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, **which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do *them* in the land whither ye go to possess it:** That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all his statutes and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 6:3-5 Hear therefore, O Israel, and **observe to do *it***; that it may be well with thee, and that ye **may increase mightily**, as the LORD God of thy fathers hath **promised** thee, in the land that floweth with milk and honey. Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God *is* one LORD: **And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.**

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 6:6-9 And these words, which I command thee this day, **shall be in thine heart:**

And thou shalt **teach them diligently** unto thy children, and shalt **talk of them** when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. And thou shalt **bind them** for a sign **upon thine hand**, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes. And thou shalt **write them** upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 6:10-11 And it shall be, when the LORD thy God shall have brought thee into the land which he sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, **to give thee great and goodly cities, which thou buildedst not, And houses full of all good *things*, which thou filledst not, and wells digged, which thou diggedst not, vineyards and olive trees, which thou plantedst not; when thou shalt have eaten and be full;**

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 6:12-14 *Then* **beware** lest thou **forget** the LORD, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage. Thou shalt **fear** the LORD thy God, and **serve** him, and shalt swear by his name. **Ye shall not go after other gods, of the gods of the people which *are* round about you;**

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 6:15-17 (For the LORD thy God *is* a jealous God among you) lest the anger of the LORD thy God be kindled against thee, and **destroy thee** from off the face of the earth. Ye shall not tempt the LORD your God, as ye tempted *him* in Massah. **Ye shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and his testimonies, and his statutes, which he hath commanded thee.**

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 6:18-21 And thou shalt do *that which* **is right and good in the sight of the LORD:** that it may be well with thee, and that thou mayest go in and **possess the good land** which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, To **cast out all thine enemies from before thee**, as the LORD hath spoken. *And* when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What *mean* the testimonies, and the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD our God hath commanded you? Then thou shalt say unto thy son, We were Pharaoh's **bondmen** in Egypt; and **the LORD brought us out of** Egypt with a mighty hand:

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 6:22-25 And the LORD shewed signs and wonders, great and sore, upon Egypt, upon Pharaoh, and upon all his household, before our eyes: And he brought us out from thence, that he might bring us in, to give us the land which he sware unto our fathers. **And the LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as *it is* at this day. And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the LORD our God, as he hath commanded us.**

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 7:1-2 When the LORD thy God shall bring thee into the land whither thou goest to possess it, and hath cast out many nations before thee, the Hittites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than thou; And when the LORD thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, and utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor shew mercy unto them:

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 7:3-5 Neither shalt thou make marriages with them; thy daughter thou shalt not give unto his son, nor his daughter shalt thou take unto thy son. **For they will turn away thy son from following me**, that they may serve other gods: so will **the anger** of the LORD be kindled against you, and **destroy thee** suddenly.

But thus shall ye deal with them; **ye shall destroy their altars, and break down their images, and cut down their groves, and burn their graven images with fire.**

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 7:6-8 For thou *art* **an holy people** unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be **a special people** unto himself, above all people that *are* upon the face of the earth. The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye *were* the fewest of all people: **But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn** unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you **out of the house of bondmen**, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 7:9-11 Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he *is* God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations; And repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will **not** be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face. Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which I command thee this day, to do them.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 7:12-14 Wherefore it shall come to pass, if ye hearken to these judgments, and keep, and do them, that the LORD thy God shall keep unto thee **the covenant and the mercy** which he sware unto thy fathers: And **he will love thee, and bless thee**, and multiply thee: he will also bless the fruit of thy womb, and the fruit of thy land, thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep, in the land which he sware unto thy fathers to give thee. **Thou shalt be blessed above all people:** there shall not be male or female barren among you, or among your cattle.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 7:15-18 And the LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all *them* that hate thee. And **thou shalt consume** all the people which the LORD thy God shall deliver thee; thine eye shall have no pity upon them: neither shalt thou serve their gods; for that *will be* a snare unto thee. **If thou shalt say in thine heart, These nations *are* more than I; how can I dispossess them? Thou shalt not be afraid of them: *but* shalt well remember what the LORD thy God did unto Pharaoh, and unto all Egypt;**

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 7:19-22 The great temptations which thine eyes saw, and the signs, and the wonders, and the mighty hand, and the stretched out arm, whereby the LORD thy God brought thee out: **so shall the LORD thy God do unto all the people of whom thou art afraid.** Moreover the LORD thy God will **send the hornet** among them, until they that are left, and **hide themselves from thee, be destroyed.** Thou shalt not be affrighted at them: for the LORD thy God *is* among you, a mighty God and terrible. **And the LORD thy God will put out those nations before thee by little and little:** thou mayest not consume them at once, lest the beasts of the field increase upon thee.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 7:23-26 But the LORD thy God shall deliver them unto thee, and shall destroy them with a mighty destruction, until they be destroyed. And he shall deliver their kings into thine hand, and **thou shalt destroy** their name from under heaven: there shall no man be able to stand before thee, until thou have destroyed them. The graven images of their gods shall ye burn with fire: thou shalt not desire the silver or gold *that is* on them, nor take *it* unto thee, lest thou be snared therein: for *it is* an abomination to the LORD thy God. Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it: *but* thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for *it is* a cursed thing.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Judges 2:1-3 And an angel of the LORD came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said, I made you to go up out of Egypt, and have brought you unto the land which I swear unto your fathers; and I said, I will never break my covenant with you. **And ye shall make no league with the inhabitants of this land; ye shall throw down their altars: but ye have not obeyed my voice: why have ye done this?**

Wherefore I also said, I will not drive them out from before you; but they shall be *as thorns* in your sides, and their gods shall be a snare unto you.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Judges 2:11-14 And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and served Baalim: And they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, which brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other gods, of the gods of the people that *were* round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked the LORD to anger. And they forsook the LORD, and served Baal and Ashtaroth. And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them into the hands of their enemies round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Judges 2:16-19 Nevertheless the LORD raised up judges, which delivered them out of the hand of those that spoiled them. And yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, obeying the commandments of the LORD; *but* they did not so. And when the LORD raised them up judges, then the LORD was with the judge, and delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge: for it repented the LORD because of their groanings by reason of them that oppressed them and vexed them. And it came to pass, when the judge was dead, *that* they returned, and corrupted *themselves* more than their fathers, in following other gods to serve them, and to bow down unto them; they ceased not from their own doings, nor from their stubborn way.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Judges 2:20-23 And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel; and he said, Because that this people hath transgressed my covenant which I commanded their fathers, and have not hearkened unto my voice; **I also will not henceforth drive out any from before them of the nations** which Joshua left when he died: **That through them I may prove Israel, whether they will keep the way of the LORD to walk therein, as their fathers did keep *it*, or not.** Therefore the LORD left those nations, **without driving them out hastily;** neither delivered he them into the hand of Joshua.

Ephesians 4:11-13 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; **For the perfecting of the saints,** for the work of the ministry, for the **edifying** of the body of Christ: Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, **unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:**

Ephesians 4:14-16 That we *henceforth* be **no more children**, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, *and* cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the truth in love, may **grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ**: From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which **every joint supplieth**, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, **maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.**

Hebrews 12:1-4 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, **let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us**, and let us **run with patience the race that is set before us**, Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of *our* faith; who **for the joy that was set before him** endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, **lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds. Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin.**

And the people said unto Joshua, Nay; but we will serve the LORD. And Joshua said unto the people, Ye *are* witnesses against yourselves that **ye have chosen you the LORD**, to serve him. And they said, *We are* witnesses. Now therefore put away, *said he*, the strange gods which *are* among you, and incline your heart unto the LORD God of Israel. And the people said unto Joshua, **The LORD our God will we serve, and his voice will we obey.**

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 9:1-3 Hear, O Israel: Thou *art* to pass over Jordan this day, to go in to possess nations greater and mightier than thyself, cities great and fenced up to heaven, A people great and tall, the children of the Anakims, whom thou knowest, and *of whom* thou hast heard *say*, Who can stand before the children of Anak! Understand therefore this day, that the LORD thy God *is* he which goeth over before thee; *as* a consuming fire he shall destroy them, and he shall bring them down before thy face: so shalt thou drive them out, and destroy them quickly, as the LORD hath said unto thee.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Deuteronomy 9:4-6 Speak not thou in thine heart, after that the LORD thy God hath cast them out from before thee, saying, For my righteousness the LORD hath brought me in to possess this land: but for the wickedness of these nations the LORD doth drive them out from before thee. Not for thy righteousness, or for the uprightness of thine heart, dost thou go to possess their land: but for the wickedness of these nations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee, and that he may perform the word which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Understand therefore, that the LORD thy God giveth thee not this good land to possess it for thy righteousness; for thou *art* a stiffnecked people.

BY LITTLE AND LITTLE

Ephesians 6:11-13 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

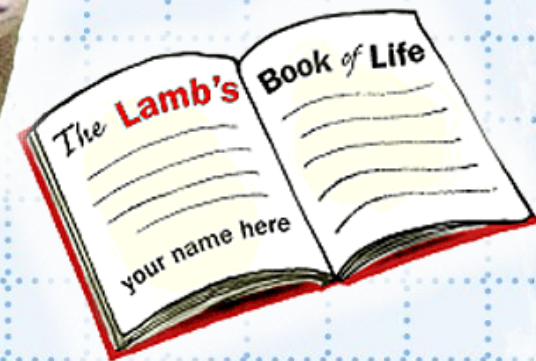
BY LITTLE AND LITTLE
