Isaiah 2:1-4 The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem. **And it shall come to pass in the last days, *that* the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it.** And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and He will teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. And He shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

Daniel 2:44-45 In the days of those kings shall the God of heaven set up a Kingdom which shall never be destroyed, nor shall the sovereignty of it be left to another people; but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever. Because you saw that a stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it broke in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God has made known to the king what shall happen hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation of it sure.



What is the fulfillment of this vision?

What does the New Testament teach about Israel? If the Old Testament sees the future salvation of Israel, does the New Testament reinterpret these prophecies so radically that they are to be fulfilled spiritually in the church?

Is the church the new and true Israel?

Or does God still have a future for His people Israel?

Hebrews 10:14-18 For by one offering He hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified. *Whereof* the Holy Spirit also is a witness to us: for after that He had said before:

This *is* the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.

Now where remission of these *is*, *there is* no more offering for sin.

Isaiah 56:7 Even them will I bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices *shall be* accepted upon mine altar; for mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people.

1 Peter 2:5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.

Malachi 3:1 Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.

Malachi 4:5 Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:

Zechariah 6:9-13 And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Take of *them* of the captivity, *even* of Heldai, of Tobijah, and of Jedaiah, which are come from Babylon, and come thou the same day, and go into the house of Josiah the son of Zephaniah; Then take silver and gold, and make crowns, and set *them* upon the head of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest; And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, **Behold the man whose name is The BRANCH; and He shall grow up out of His place, and He shall build the temple of the LORD: Even He shall build the temple of the LORD; and He shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon His throne; and He shall be a priest upon His throne:** and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.

Isaiah 16:1-5 Send ye the lamb to the ruler of the land from Sela to the wilderness, unto the mount of the daughter of Zion. For it shall be, *that*, as a wandering bird cast out of the nest, so the daughters of Moab shall be at the fords of Arnon. Take counsel, execute judgment; make thy shadow as the night in the midst of the noonday; hide the outcasts; bewray not him that wandereth. Let mine outcasts dwell with thee, Moab; be thou a covert to them from the face of the spoiler: for the extortioner is at an end, the spoiler ceaseth, the oppressors are consumed out of the land. **And in mercy shall the throne be established: and he shall sit upon it in truth in the tabernacle of David, judging, and seeking judgment, and hasting righteousness.**

Acts 15:13-19 And after they had held their peace, James answered, saying, Men *and* brethren, hearken unto me: Simeon hath declared how **God at the first did visit the Gentiles, to take out of them a people for His name.** And to this agree the words of the prophets; as it is written, **After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up: That the residue of men might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom My name is called, saith the Lord, who doeth all these things.** Known unto God are all His works from the beginning of the world. Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God:

Will be accomplished in the seventy weeks:

**To finish the transgression,
To make an end of sins,
To make reconciliation for iniquity,
To bring in everlasting righteousness,
To seal up vision and prophecy,
And to anoint the Most Holy.**

Jeremiah 31:31-34 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make **a new covenant** with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day *that* I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which My covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD: But this *shall be* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put My law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be My people. And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know Me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

Romans 9:1-5 I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit, That I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart. For I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh: Who are Israelites; to whom *pertaineth* the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service *of God*, and the promises; Whose *are* the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ *came*, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen.

Acts 13:46 Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles.

John 1:11-12 He came unto His own, and His own received Him not. But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on His name:

Matthew 21:42 Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the Scriptures, **The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner**: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?

Acts 4:11 **This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders**, which is become the head of the corner.

1 Peter 2:7 Unto you therefore which believe *He is precious*: but **unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed**, the same is made the head of the corner

Psalms 118:22 The stone *which* the builders refused is become the head *stone* of the corner.

Romans 9:6-9 Not as though the word of God hath taken none effect. **For they are not all Israel, which are of Israel:**

Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, *are they* all children: but, **In Isaac shall thy seed be called.** That is, They which are the children of the flesh, these *are* not the children of God: but the children of the promise are counted for the seed. For this *is* the word of promise, **At this time will I come, and Sara shall have a son.**

“For they *are* not all Israel, which are of Israel:”

True Israel is not identical with the physical
offspring of Jacob

Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, *are they* all children:

Physical Israel's descent from Abraham does not qualify them as his children

...but, “In Isaac shall thy seed be called.”

Only the spiritual children of the promise are considered his seed.

Romans 2:28-29 For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither *is that* circumcision, which is outward in the flesh: But he *is* a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision *is that* of the heart, in the spirit, *and* not in the letter; whose praise *is* not of men, but of God.

Luke 3:8 Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to *our* father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.

...They which are the children of the flesh, these *are* not the children of God: but the children of the promise are counted for the seed.

For this *is* the word of promise, “At this time will I come, and Sara shall have a son.”

Romans 9:8-9

Galatians 4:21-26 Tell me, ye that desire to be under the law, do ye not hear the law? For it is written, that Abraham had two sons, the one by a bondmaid, the other by a freewoman. But he *who was* of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman *was* by promise. Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants; the one from the mount Sinai, which gendereth to bondage, which is Agar. For this Agar is mount Sinai in Arabia, and answereth to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children. But Jerusalem which is above is free, which is the mother of us all.

Galatians 4:27-31 For it is written, Rejoice, *thou* barren that bearest not; break forth and cry, thou that travailest not: for the desolate hath many more children than she which hath an husband. Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are the children of promise. But as then he that was born after the flesh persecuted him *that was born* after the Spirit, even so *it is* now. Nevertheless what saith the Scripture? **Cast out the bondwoman and her son: for the son of the bondwoman shall not be heir with the son of the freewoman.** So then, brethren, we are not children of the bondwoman, but of the free.

Romans 3:1-4 What advantage then hath the Jew? or what profit *is there* of circumcision? Much every way: chiefly, because that unto them were committed the oracles of God. For what if some did not believe? **shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect? God forbid: yea, let God be true**, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.

Galatians 3:26-29 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for **ye are all one** in Christ Jesus. And **if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.**

It is not necessary to be in Israel to be a recipient of the promises -- it is necessary to be in Christ.

Romans 9:9-13 For this *is* the word of promise, **“At this time will I come, and Sara shall have a son.”** And not only *this*; but when Rebecca also had conceived by one, *even* by our father Isaac; (For *the children* being not yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works, but of Him that calleth;) It was said unto her, **“The elder shall serve the younger.”** As it is written, **“Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated.”**

Romans 9:14-20 What shall we say then? *Is there* unrighteousness with God? God forbid. For He saith to Moses, **I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.** So then *it is* not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy. For the Scripture saith unto Pharaoh, **“Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew My power in thee, and that My name might be declared throughout all the earth.”**

Therefore hath He mercy on whom He will *have mercy*, and whom He will He hardeneth. Thou wilt say then unto me, Why doth He yet find fault? For who hath resisted His will? Nay but, O man, who art thou that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to Him that formed *it*, “Why hast Thou made me thus?”

Romans 9:21-24 Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour? *What* if God, willing to shew *His* wrath, and to make His power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: And that He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy, which He had afore prepared unto glory, Even us, whom He hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?

Romans 9:21-24 Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour? *What* if God, willing to shew *His* wrath, and to make His power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: **And that He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy, which He had afore prepared unto glory, Even us, whom He hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?**

**God had been patient with physical Israel's
unbelief that through it He might show
mercy to True Israel**

Romans 11:11 I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall [finally and irretrievably]? God forbid: but *rather* through their fall salvation *is come* unto the Gentiles, **for to provoke them** [physical Israel] **to jealousy.**

Romans 9:23-24 And **that He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy**, which He had afore prepared unto glory, Even us, whom He hath called, **not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?**

Romans 9:25-26 As He saith also in Osee, “I will call them My people, which were not My people; and her beloved, which was not beloved. And it shall come to pass, *that* in the place where it was said unto them, Ye *are* not My people; there shall they be called the children of the living God.”

Hosea 1:6-11 And she conceived again, and bare a daughter. And *God* said unto him, Call her name Loruhamah: for I will no more have mercy upon the house of Israel; but I will utterly take them away. But I will have mercy upon the house of Judah, and will save them by the LORD their God, and will not save them by bow, nor by sword, nor by battle, by horses, nor by horsemen. Now when she had weaned Loruhamah, she conceived, and bare a son. Then said *God*, Call his name Loammi: for ye *are* not My people, and I will not be your *God*. Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured nor numbered; and **it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not My people, there it shall be said unto them, Ye are the sons of the living God**. Then shall the children of Judah and the children of Israel be gathered together, and appoint themselves one head, and they shall come up out of the land: for great *shall be* the day of Jezreel.

Romans 4:11-13 And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which *he had yet* being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also: And the father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only, but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham, which *he had* being *yet* uncircumcised. For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, *was* not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.

Romans 4:16 Therefore *it is* of faith, that *it might be* by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

Galatians 3:7 Know ye therefore that they which are of faith,
the same are the children of Abraham.

Romans 9:27-28 Esaias also crieth concerning Israel, “Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved: For He will finish the work, and cut *it* short in righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth.”

Isaiah 10:20-23 And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them; but shall stay upon the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in truth. The remnant shall return, *even* the remnant of Jacob, unto the mighty God. **For though thy people Israel be as the sand of the sea, yet a remnant of them shall return: the consumption decreed shall overflow with righteousness. For the Lord GOD of hosts shall make a consumption, even determined, in the midst of all the land.**

Romans 9:29-33 And as Esaias said before,
**“Except the Lord of Sabaoth had left us a seed,
we had been as Sodom, and been made like
unto Gomorrha.”** What shall we say then? That
the Gentiles, which followed not after
righteousness, have attained to righteousness,
even the righteousness which is of faith. But Israel,
which followed after the law of righteousness, hath
not attained to the law of righteousness.
Wherefore? Because *they sought it* not by faith,
but as it were by the works of the law. For they
stumbled at that stumblingstone; As it is written,
**“Behold, I lay in Sion a Stumblingstone and
Rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on
Him shall not be ashamed.”**

Romans 10:16-21 But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, **“Lord, who hath believed our report?”** So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. But I say, Have they not heard? Yes verily, **“their sound went into all the earth, and their words unto the ends of the world.”** But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses saith, **“I will provoke you to jealousy by *them that are no people*, and by a foolish nation I will anger you.”** But Esaias is very bold, and saith, **“I was found of them that sought Me not; I was made manifest unto them that asked not after Me.”** But to Israel, He saith, **“All day long I have stretched forth My hands unto a disobedient and gainsaying people.”**

Romans 11:1-5 I say then, Hath God cast away His people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin. God hath not cast away His people which He foreknew. Wot ye not what the Scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying, **“Lord, they have killed Thy prophets, and digged down Thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life.”** But what saith the answer of God unto him? **“I have reserved to Myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to *the image of Baal*.”** Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace.

Romans 11:6-10 And if by grace, then *is it* no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if *it be* of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work. What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded (According as it is written, “**God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;**”) unto this day. And David saith, “**Let their table be made a snare, and a trap, and a stumblingblock, and a recompence unto them: Let their eyes be darkened, that they may not see, and bow down their back alway.**”

Romans 11:11-12 I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: but *rather* through their fall salvation *is come* unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy. Now if the fall of them *be* the riches of the world, and the diminishing of them the riches of the Gentiles; how much more their fulness?

Romans 11:13-15 For I speak to you Gentiles, inasmuch as I am the apostle of the Gentiles, I magnify mine office: If by any means I may provoke to emulation *them which are* my flesh, and might save some of them. For if the casting away of them *be* the reconciling of the world, what *shall* the receiving *of them be*, but life from the dead?

Romans 11:16-21 For if the firstfruit *be* holy, the lump *is* also *holy*: and if the root *be* holy, so *are* the branches. And if some of the branches be broken off, and thou, being a wild olive tree, wert grafted in among them, and with them partakest of the root and fatness of the olive tree; Boast not against the branches. But if thou boast, thou bearest not the root, but the root thee. Thou wilt say then, The branches were broken off, that I might be grafted in. Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear: For if God spared not the natural branches, *take heed* lest He also spare not thee.

Romans 11:22-27 Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in *His* goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off. And they also, if they abide not still in unbelief, shall be grafted in: for God is able to graff them in again. For if thou wert cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and wert grafted contrary to nature into a good olive tree: how much more shall these, which be the natural *branches*, be grafted into their own olive tree? For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, **“There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this *is* My covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.”**
