Proverbs1: 1 **The proverbs** of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel; ² **To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding; ³ To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity; ⁴ To give subtilty to the simple, to the young man knowledge and discretion.** ⁵ A wise *man* will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels: ⁶ To understand a proverb, and the interpretation; the words of the wise, and their dark sayings. ⁷ The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge: *but* fools despise wisdom and instruction.

- Proverbs 6:6 Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: (الاللام)

Proverbs 6:9-11 How long wilt thou sleep, O sluggard? when wilt thou arise out of thy sleep? Yet a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep: So shall thy poverty come as one that travelleth, and thy want as an armed man.

Proverbs 26:16 The sluggard is wiser in his own conceit than seven men that can render a





- > A slothful person does not value the advance of seasons.
- Proverbs 20:4 The sluggard will not plow by reason of the cold; therefore shall he beg in harvest, and have nothing.
- Proverbs 19:24 A slothful man hideth his hand in his bosom, and will not so much as bring it to his mouth again.
- Proverbs 10:5 He that gathereth in summer is a wise son: but he that sleepeth in harvest is a son that causeth shame.
- Proverbs 30:25 The ants are a people not strong, yet they prepare their meat in the summer;



Proverbs 24:30-34 I went by the field of the slothful, and by the vineyard of the man void of understanding; And, Io, it was all grown over with thorns, and nettles had covered the face thereof, and the stone wall thereof was broken down. Then I saw, and considered it well: I looked upon it, and received instruction. Yet a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep: So shall thy poverty come as one that travelleth; and thy want as an armed man.

- > A slothful man is a dreamer.
- Proverbs 21:25-26 The desire of the slothful killeth him; for his hands refuse to labour. He coveteth greedily all the day long: but the righteous giveth and spareth not.
- Proverbs 26:14 As the door turneth upon his hinges, so doth the slothful upon his bed.

> A slothful man will not finish the task.

- Proverbs 12:27 The slothful man roasteth not that which he took in hunting: but the substance of a diligent man is precious.
- > A slothful man brings damage to their family, their employer, etc.
- Proverbs 18:9 He also that is slothful in his work is brother to him that is a great waster.
- Proverbs 10:26 As vinegar to the teeth, and as smoke to the eyes, so is the sluggard to them that send him.

- People who are slothful have many fears and/or excuses and will have difficulty.
- Proverbs 22:13 The slothful man saith, There is a lion without, I shall be slain in the streets.
- Proverbs 26:13 The slothful man saith, There is a lion in the way; a lion is in the streets.
- Proverbs 15:19 The way of the slothful man is as an hedge of thorns: but the way of the righteous is made plain.

- Matthew 25:26 His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:
- Romans 12:10-13 Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord; Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer; Distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality.
- Hebrews 6:10-12 For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister. And we desire that <u>every one of you</u> do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.



> How do we become diligent?

- A. Treasure God's wisdom and be faithful to teach your children.
- Deuteronomy 6:6-7 And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.





Be diligent to remember Gods truths.

> **Deuteronomy 4:8-9** And what nation is there so great, that hath statutes and judgments so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day? Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: but teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons;



Be diligent to keep all of Gods commandments.

Deuteronomy 6:17-18 Ye shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and his testimonies, and his statutes, which he hath commanded thee. And thou shalt do that which is right and good in the sight of the LORD: that it may be well with thee, and that thou mayest go in and possess the good land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers,



> Be diligent to guard your affections.

Deuteronomy 4:23-24 Take heed unto yourselves, lest ye forget the covenant of the LORD your God, which he made with you, and make you a graven image, or the likeness of any thing, which the LORD thy God hath forbidden thee. For the LORD thy God is a consuming fire, even a jealous God.



> Be diligent to add to your faith...

> 2 Peter 1:5-8 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity. For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.



> Be diligent to remove roots of bitternessseek peace and holiness.

Hebrews 12:14-15 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled;





- > Be diligent to avoid tempters, swindlers and frauds.
- Proverbs 23:1-3 When thou sittest to eat with a ruler, consider diligently what is before thee: And put a knife to thy throat, if thou be a man given to appetite. Be not desirous of his dainties: for they are deceitful meat.



- Makes you "rich".
- Proverbs 10:4 He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich.
- > Be given authority.
- Proverbs 12:24 The hand of the diligent shall bear rule: but the slothful shall be under tribute.



- > Be fulfilled.
- Proverbs 13:4 The soul of the sluggard desireth, and *hath* nothing: but the soul of the diligent shall be made fat.
- > Be creative and resourceful.
- Proverbs 21:5 The thoughts of the diligent tend only to plenteousness; but of every one that is hasty only to want.



- > Receive favor.
- Proverbs 11:27 He that diligently seeketh good procureth favour: but he that seeketh mischief, it shall come unto him.
- > Given Honor.
- Proverbs 22:29 Seest thou a man diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean men.

2 Thessalonians 3:6-10 Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us. For yourselves know how ye ought to follow us: for we behaved not ourselves disorderly among you; Neither did we eat any man's bread for nought; but wrought with labour and travail night and day, that we might not be chargeable to any of you: Not because we have not power, but to make ourselves an ensample unto you to follow us. For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.

CONSIDER THE ANT 2 Thessalonians 3:11-15 For we hear that there are some which walk among you disorderly, working not at all, but are busybodies. Now them that are such we command and exhort by our Lord Jesus Christ, that with quietness they work, and eat their own bread. But ye, brethren, be not weary in well doing. And if any man obey not our word by this epistle, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed. Yet count him not as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.

- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- >Colossians 3:23-25 And whatsoever ye do, do *it* heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ. But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done: and there is no respect of persons.





- The Ants Work Is A Partnership
- They Work In Love No infighting, Brethren should love - Heb. 13:1; 1 John 4:7; John 13:35.
- They Are Helpful Help carry burdens; injured neighbors; rescue those buried or those who fall into a pit. (Gal. 6:2; Rom.15:1)
- They Operate In Harmony 1 weak, many strong. -each has a job, but none are more important. (We are all members of one body - 1 Cor. 12:12-27.Phil. 1:27; 1 Cor. 1:10; Eph 4:3)





- **The Ants Work as a Productive Team**
- They Work Toward A Common Goal Provide for the colony and the queen. 1 Cor. 10:31; 1 Thes. 4:1; Heb. 13:16
- Ants Have An All Volunteer Service No guide, yet each ant works. James 2:17-18; 4:17.
- Ants Labor According To Their Own Ability (Storekeepers, engineers, nurses, farmers, laborers --He will use you according to your ability, as you grow, your responsibility will grow, 2 Pet. 3:18. God has especially gifted and equipped you for some type of work in the body of Christ, 1 Cor. 12:12-27) All God asks is that we use our abilities. (Talents Mt. 25) (Ecc. 9:10, "Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest.")



The Ant's Work is Persistent

- Ants Work Continually All Day! No pay, promotion, thanks, pats on back, reward yet they work! Ants never get mad and quit and they never go on strike! They just work! Philippians 3:13-14 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.
- Impossible to stop when food is found –(<u>Note</u>: What a lesson! We who have tasted and found that the Lord is good need to go back into the colony of the world and tell the others about Him.)
- Keep going in times of danger (III. average Christian says -"We can't"; that attitude cost Israel 40 years in the wilderness. What could it cost you? We must move from "I can't" to "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me!", Phil. 4:13)





- > The Ant's Make Provisions For This Life
- Ants collect food consistently- Do you prepare for food shortages/lack of work? Are you storing up your daily bread in the cupboard of your heart?
- Ants maintain their shelter/home- Do you maintain your premises or allow things to fall to disrepair? Are you maintaining the Lord as your shelter? Psalms 61:3 For thou hast been a shelter for me, and a strong tower from the enemy.
- Their colonies are built up with all the things needed to provide for each one and for all. (storage rooms, barracks, hatcheries, etc. Forager, builders, soldiers, egglayers/queens, nursemaids, etc.) – Do you plan for the seasons in your life today? Are you covering the bases wisely? Education, good credit, savings, insurance, retirement, legacy. Spiritually are you reading the word, constant in prayer, abiding in Christ, not quenching the spirit, helping the Body, having good works?





- Ants store all they can while they can. (Grasshoppers They make no preparations and when winter comes, they all die!) Ants, on the other hand, believe in winter and by instinct they prepare for it.
- Men believe in resurrection/life after death, but do nothing about it. They are heading toward the Second Death. People need to be ready and God has made The Way! The Way is Jesus. - John 3:16-19 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.





- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.
- > 1 Peter 4:18 And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear?
- John 3:36 He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

The Ant's Make Provisions For The Future

- Ezek 33:11 Say unto them, As I live, saith the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked ; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; for why will ye die, O house of Israel?
- > 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- Heb 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:





James 5:1-5 Go to now, ye rich men, weep and howl for your miseries that shall come upon you. Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are motheaten. Your gold and silver is cankered; and the rust of them shall be a witness against you, and shall eat your flesh as it were fire. Ye have heaped treasure together for the last days. Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth. Ye have lived in pleasure on the earth, and been wanton; ye have nourished your hearts, as in a day of slaughter.





> James 5:6-9 Ye have condemned and killed the just; and he doth not resist you. Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh. Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, the judge standeth before the door.





> John 5:25-29 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live. For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself; And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man. Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.





Rev 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were **opened**: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. 14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.



- There are two types of people in the world
 - > SLOTHFUL AND DILIGENT/GRASSHOPPERS AND ANTS
- The slothful/grasshopper is living a life which has no regard for the future.
- I Cor 15:32 If after the manner of men I have fought with beasts at Ephesus, what advantageth it me, if the dead rise not? let us eat and drink; for to morrow we die.
- Then you have the diligent ants that plan for what they know is coming
- Gen 8:22 While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.
- Matthew 16:2-3 He answered and said unto them, When it is evening, ye say, It will be fair weather: for the sky is red. And in the morning, It will be foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowring. O ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not discern the signs of the times?





ANTS NEVER QUIT

- If they're headed somewhere and you try to stop them, they'll look for another way.
- They'll climb over, they'll climb under, they'll climb around.
- They keep looking for another way.

LESSON:

To never quit looking for a way to get where you're supposed to go.





ANTS THINK WINTER ALL SUMMER

- You can't be so naïve as to think summer will last forever.
- So ants are gathering their winter food in the middle of summer.

LESSON: It is important to be realistic. Think

ahead.







ANTS THINK SUMMER ALL WINTER

- During the winter, ants remind themselves, "This won't last long; we'll soon be out of here."
- > At the first warm day, the ants are out.
- If it turns cold again, they'll dive back down, but then they come out the first warm day.

LESSON: Stay positive at all times. Keep hope before your eyes. To every thing turn, turn, turn.
