Imagine all of the obstacles a person might have to overcome if he were to walk from New York City to San Francisco. One man who accomplished this rare achievement mentioned a rather surprising difficulty when asked to tell of his biggest hurdle. He said that the toughest part of the trip wasn't traversing the steep slopes of the mountains or crossing hot, dry, barren stretches of desert. Instead, he said, "The thing that came the closest to defeating me was the sand in my shoes."

Consider the lowly oyster! They spend their lives in their beds, with mouths wide open, and sucking in whatever plankton happens to be drifting by. Adults may filter up to 50 gallons of water per day. Just about the only bad thing that might happen to them in the course of their life—is for a grain of sand, or maybe even a parasite, to get into their shell and begin to "irritate" them.

At this point, the oyster can do one of two things: ignore the source of the irritation, which probably means eventual death, or protect itself by covering the source of the irritation with the same material which lines the inner surface of the oyster shell— a material called nacre (mother of pearl). In other words, the oyster can respond to the irritant by making a pearl.

And that pearl, that byproduct of an encounter between the oyster and that grain of sand, turns out to be a thing of beauty and value.

"When life gives you lemons, make lemonade."

Remember, we are not in the oyster bed alone ... as we contend with the world, and try to convert all those bits of sand into pearls, maybe ... just maybe we'll discover that, by our example, we've enabled others to grow a few pearls as well.


Colossians 3:15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.

James 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.






1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

DOESN'T IT IRRITATE YOU WHEN? Galatians 5:16-18 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

Galatians 5:19-21 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness (lustful pleasures), Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred (hostility), variance (quarreling), emulations (jealousy), wrath(outbursts of anger), strife (selfish ambition), seditions (dissension), heresies (divisions), Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings (wild parties), and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

Galatians 5:22-24 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering (patience), gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance (self-control): against such there is no law. And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.

Galatians 5:25-26 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.

1 Peter 3:8-12 Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous: Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing. For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile: Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it. For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil.
