CONSIDER THE SOURCE

Psalm 116:1-3 I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice and my supplications. Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live. The sorrows of death compassed me, and the pains of hell gat hold upon me: I found trouble and sorrow.

CONSIDER THE SOURCE

Psalm 116:4-6 Then called I upon the name of the LORD; O LORD, I beseech thee, deliver my soul. Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; yea, our God is merciful. The LORD preserveth the simple: I was brought low, and he helped me.

CONSIDER THE SOURCE

Psalm 116:7-10 Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the LORD hath dealt bountifully with thee. For thou hast delivered my soul from death, mine eyes from tears, and my feet from falling. I will walk before the LORD in the land of the living. I believed, therefore have I spoken: I was greatly afflicted: .

CONSIDER THE SOURCE


2 Corinthians 4:13-14 We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak; Knowing that he which raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise up us also by Jesus, and shall present us with you.

2 Timothy 1:12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

CONSIDER THE SOURCE

1 John 5:13 These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.





Horatius Bonar (1808-1889)wrote:

"In the early Church there was nothing of the uncertainty which we find among Christians now. They knew what they were, and it was on the authenticated facts concerning Christ that they rested this certainty. No one then thought of saying, I believe, but I am not sure whether I am born of God; for they took for granted that whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God. They did not analyze their own faith to ascertain how far it was of the right quantity and quality. They never thought of themselves at all, but only of Him who, though rich, for their sakes had become poor. All the epistles take for granted that they KNEW that they were Christians; nor is anything written there to encourage them to suspect themselves, or to teach them the art of doubting. Nothing is there addressed to them to lead them to make much of their doubts, or to believe in their own faith as the true way of deliverance from doubting. We know was the apostle's language; We know was the response which that language met with from all to whom he wrote."

He HAS saved us (regeneration)

– Eph. 2:8 For by grace you have
been saved through faith; and that
not of yourselves, it is the gift of God;

A Threefold Salvation

We ARE saved from the PENALTY of sin (JUSTIFICATION).

We are BEING saved from the POWER of sin (SANCTIFICATION).

We SHALL be saved from the PRESENCE of sin (GIORIFICATION).

He IS saving us (sanctification) – 2 Corinthians 4:16 For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day.

He WILL save us (glorification) – 1 Peter 1:5 Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

He HAS cleansed us – 1 Corinthians 6:11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

A Threefold Salvation

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He IS cleansing us – 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

He WILL utterly cleanse us — Ephesians 5:25-27 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.







Given the check = have been saved (by the blood of Christ)

- * Deposited the check = are being saved (maintaining good works through the work of the holy spirit within)
- * When the money transfers to your full ownership = will be saved (This is the final full birth into the Kingdom of God when this mortal puts on immortality- Yes! Eternal Life!)

2 Timothy 1:8-10 Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; Who HATH SAVED us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began, But is **NOW MADE MANIFEST** by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who HATH abolished death, and HATH brought life and immortality TO LIGHT THROUGH THE GOSPEL:

2 Corinthians 2:14-16 Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place. For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, IN THEM THAT ARE SAVED, and in them that perish: To the one we are the savour of death unto DEATH; and to the other the savour of life UNTO LIFE. And who is sufficient for these things?

Colossians 1:12-13 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the INHEIRITANCE of the saints in light: Who HATH DELIVERED US from the power of darkness, and HATH TRANSLATED US into the kingdom of his dear Son:

John 5:24 Verily, Verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, <u>HATH</u> EVERLASTING LIFE, and shall not come into condemnation; but <u>IS PASSED</u> FROM DEATH UNTO LIFE.

1 Corinthians 1:18 For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which <u>ARE</u>

<u>SAVED</u> it is the power of God.

1 John 3:14 We KNOW THAT WE HAVE PASSED FROM DEATH UNTO LIFE, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.

Romans 5:8-11 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being NOW JUSTIFIED BY HIS BLOOD, we SHALL BE SAVED from wrath through him. For if, when we were enemies, we were RECONCILED to God by the DEATH of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we SHALL BE SAVED by his LIFE. And not only so, but we also JOY in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have **NOW** RECEIVED THE ATONEMENT.

Titus 3:5-8 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he SAVED us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the HOLY GHOST; Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; That being JUSTIFIED by his grace, we should be made HEIRS according to THE HOPE of eternal life. This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou AFFIRM constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to MAINTAIN good works. These things are good and profitable unto men.

1 John 5:13-15 These things have I written unto you that BELIEVE on the name of the Son of God; that ye may KNOW that ye HAVE eternal life, and that ye may BELIEVE on the name of the Son of God. And this is the **CONFIDENCE** that we HAVE IN HIM, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we KNOW that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we KNOW that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

1 John 5:16-18 If any man see his brother sin a sin which is not unto death, he shall ask, and he shall give him life for them that sin not unto death. There is a sin unto death: I do not say that he shall pray for it. All unrighteousness is sin: and there is a sin not unto death. We KNOW that WHOSOEVER IS BORN OF GOD SINNETH NOT; but he that is begotten of God KEEPETH himself, and that wicked one TOUCHETH HIM NOT.

- 1 John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- 1 John 1:10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

• 1 John 3:6-9 Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him. Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous. He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil. Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

1 John 3: 1-2 New Living Translation (NLT)

¹ See how very much our Father loves us, for he calls us his children, and that is what we are! But the people who belong to this world don't recognize that we are God's children because they don't know him.² Dear friends, we are already God's children, but he has not yet shown us what we will be like when Christ appears. But we do KNOW that we will be like him, for we will see him as he really is.

1 John 3: 3-6 New Living Translation ³ And all who have this eager expectation will keep themselves pure, just as he is pure.4 Everyone who sins is breaking God's law, for all sin is contrary to the law of God. ⁵ And you know that Jesus came to take away our sins, and there is no sin in him. ⁶ Anyone who continues to live in him will not sin. But anyone who keeps on sinning does not know him or understand who he is.

Matthew 7:20-23 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them. Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

1 John 3: 7-8 New Living Translation ⁷ Dear children, don't let anyone deceive vou about this: When people do what is right, it shows that they are righteous, even as Christ is righteous. 8 But when people keep on sinning, it shows that they belong to the devil, who has been sinning since the beginning. But the Son of God came to destroy the works of the devil.

1 John 3: 9-10 New Living Translation ⁹ Those who have been born into God's family do not make a practice of sinning, because God's life is in them. So they can't keep on sinning, because they are children of God. 10 So now we can tell who are children of God and who are children of the devil. Anyone who does not live righteously and does not love other believers does not belong to God.

THE COMMANDMENT TEST

1 John 2:3-6 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.

THE COMPANION TEST AM I SAVED?

- 1 John 3:14 We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.
- 1 John 4:10-12 Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
- Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another. No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

THE COMMITMENT TEST

1 John 5:10a He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself:.... 1 John 5:13 These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.


1 John 5:19-21 And we KNOW that WE ARE OF GOD, and the whole world lieth in wickedness. And we KNOW that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may KNOW HIM that is TRUE, and we ARE IN HIM that is TRUE, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, AND ETERNAL LIFE. Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.

THE PAST - 1John_5:20, We know that the Son of God is come; 1John 3:14, We know that we have passed from death unto life.

These two things, one relating to the Son of God, and the other to the Christian, are spoken of as equally **past**, and as equally **certain** objects of sure knowledge.

THE PRESENT - 1John 2:18, We know that it is the last time; 1John_ 2:3, We know that we know Him; 1John_ 2:5, We know that we are in Him; 1John_ 3:14, We know that He abideth in us; 1John_ 5:19, We know that we are of God. All these things are represented as ascertained and conscious certainties, regarding which there could be no doubt whatever. This was the true state of the early Church universally. We do not read of anything short of this, -- anything corresponding to the state of doubt, and gloom, and uncertainty, in which we find so many Christians now.

THE FUTURE - 1John 3:2, We know that when He shall appear, we shall be like Him. The early Christian counted the one as sure as the other. Why don't we? Their future was not darkened with the clouds of uncertainty: clouds of tribulation might envelope them, but their future was known to be glorious



2 Timothy 1:12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

Romans 10:8-11 But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

1 John 5:9-10 If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son. He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.

1 John 5:11-13 And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.



John 6:47 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.
