





- 1. Admit your weakness
- 2. Accept your weakness
- 3. Believe that God is with you (even in your weakness)
- 4. Let go of the control over your life and yield to the will of Christ
- 5. Seek to draw upon His strength:
 - a) Through prayer
 - b) In the Word of God
 - c) By quiet meditation
- 6. Apply what He reveals to you
- 7. Trust that He loves you and that He can and will help you GRACE
