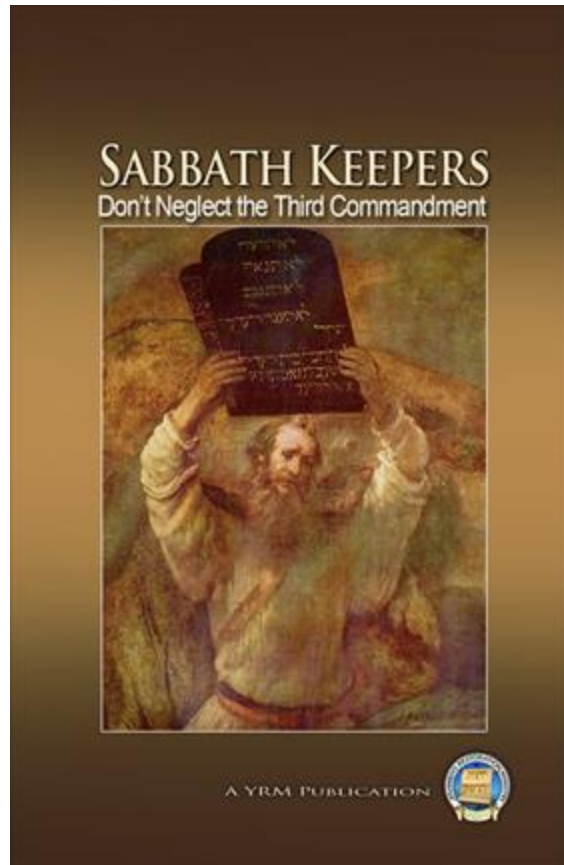
Sacred Name Doctrine:

What Does the Scripture Teach?



PART 3

- The “Sacred Name” movement is a recent creation
- “Sacred Namism” is the teaching that the use of the Hebrew names of the Father and Son are required for salvation
- 3rd Commandment is about hypocrisy, not phonics
- Blasphemy / profanation of His name is also not aural
- Titles can be substituted for names
- The English words “God,” “Lord,” and “Jesus” are not pagan/sinful
- Names ARE translatable between languages
- Original language confused / God made all new
- Pentecost languages miracle / gifts of tongues



...the Third Commandment tells us not to be negligent when it comes to calling on His true Name: "Thou shalt not take the name of Yahweh your Elohim in vain; for Yahweh will not hold him guiltless that takes His name in vain," Exodus 20:7. "Vain" is the Hebrew *shoaw* and means to make waste or ruin. **When we substitute His personal Name with titles we are bringing His Name to waste or ruin, and therefore are in violation of the Third Commandment.**

Hebrews 9:20 Saying, This *is* the blood of the testament which **God [Theos]** hath enjoined unto you.

Deuteronomy 4:24 For **the LORD [YHVH]** thy God *is* a consuming fire, *even* a jealous God.

"Dorcas" is Greek

Both mean "gazelle"

What saith the Scriptures?

What does the term "name" mean in Scripture?

a primitive word (perhaps rather from 7760 through the idea of definite and conspicuous position; compare 8064); an appellation, as a mark or memorial of individuality; by implication honor, authority, character:—+ base, (in-)fame(-ous), named(-d), renown, report.

from a presumed derivative of the base of 1097 (compare 3685); a "name" (literally or figuratively) (authority, character):—called, (+ sur-)name(-d).

The International Standard Bible Encyclopedia (“Name”) states, Besides designating persons, the name also stands for fame, renown, reputation, character gained or expressed, etc. (Gen_6:4; 2Sa_7:9, 2Sa_7:23, etc.); it might be an “evil name” (Deu_22:14, Deu_22:19; the “name” is also equivalent to a “people” or “nation” (which might be “blotted out,” i.e. destroyed (Deu_7:24, etc.)); to speak or write “in the name” signified authority (Exo_5:23; 1Ki_21:8, etc.); to “call one’s name” over a place or people indicated possession or ownership (2Sa_12:28; Amo_9:12, etc.); to act “in the name” was to represent (Deu_25:6; to be called or known “by name” indicated special individual notice (Exo_31:2; Isa_43:1; Isa_45:3-4. Gen_2:19-20 even displays a conception of identity between the name and the thing.

Does “Sacred name” or “Holy name”
= “Hebrew name”?

Leviticus 20:3 And I will set My face against that man, and will cut him off from among his people; because he hath given of his seed unto Molech, to defile My sanctuary, and to profane My **holy name**.

Leviticus 22:2 Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, that they separate themselves from the holy things of the children of Israel, and that they profane not My **holy name** *in those things* which they hallow unto Me: I *am* the LORD.

Leviticus 22:32 Neither shall ye profane My **holy name**; but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel: I *am* the LORD which hallow you

1 Chronicles 16:10 Glory ye in His **holy name**: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD.

1 Chronicles 16:35 And say ye, Save us, O God of our salvation, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to Thy **holy name**, *and* glory in Thy praise.

1 Chronicles 29:16 O LORD our God, all this store that we have prepared to build thee an house for Thine **holy name** *cometh* of Thine hand, and *is* all Thine own.

Psalms 33:21 For our heart shall rejoice in Him, because we have trusted in His **holy name**.

Psalms 99:3 Let them praise Thy great and terrible **name**; *for it is holy*.

Psalms 103:1 *A Psalm* of David. Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, *bless* His **holy name**.

Psalms 105:3 Glory ye in His **holy name**: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD.

Psalms 106:47 Save us, O LORD our God, and gather us from among the heathen, to give thanks unto Thy **holy name**, *and* to triumph in Thy praise.

Psalms 111:9 He sent redemption unto His people: He hath commanded His covenant for ever: **holy and reverend is his name**.

Psalms 145:21 My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD: and let all flesh bless His **holy name** for ever and ever.

Isaiah 57:15 For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, **whose name is Holy**; I dwell in the high and holy *place*, with Him also *that is* of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

Ezekiel 20:39 As for you, O house of Israel, thus saith the Lord GOD; Go ye, serve ye every one his idols, and hereafter *also*, if ye will not hearken unto Me: but pollute ye My **holy name** no more with your gifts, and with your idols.

Ezekiel 36:20-21 And when they entered unto the heathen, whither they went, they profaned My **holy name**, when they said to them, These *are* the people of the LORD, and are gone forth out of his land. But I had pity for Mine **holy name**, which the house of Israel had profaned among the heathen, whither they went.

Ezekiel 39:7 So will I make My **holy name** known in the midst of My people Israel; and I will not *let them* pollute My **holy name** any more: and the heathen shall know that I *am* the LORD, the Holy One in Israel.

How God's name is profaned: — Men sanctify Jehovah when they recognise that which He is, or ascribe to Him His true nature. On the other hand, when the iniquities of His people constrain Him to act in such a way as to disguise any of His great attributes, such as His power, in the eyes of the nations, so that they misinterpret His being, His holy name is "profaned," as, on the contrary, He is "sanctified" in the eyes of the nations by the restoration of His people, and their defence when restored and righteous. (A. B. Davidson, D. D.)

Ezekiel 39:25 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have mercy upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for My **holy name**;

Ezekiel 43:7-8 And He said unto me, Son of man, the place of My throne, and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel for ever, and My **holy name**, shall the house of Israel no more defile, *neither* they, nor their kings, by their whoredom, nor by the carcasses of their kings in their high places. In their setting of their threshold by My thresholds, and their post by My posts, and the wall between Me and them, they have even defiled **My holy name** by their abominations that they have committed: wherefore I have consumed them in Mine anger.

Amos 2:7 That pant after the dust of the earth on the head of the poor, and turn aside the way of the meek: and a man and his father will go in unto the *same* maid, to profane My **holy name**:

Luke 1:49 For He that is mighty hath done to me great things; and **holy is His name.**

Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, **Hallowed be Thy name.**

Luke 11:2 And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, **Hallowed be Thy name.** Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.

Ten things we are told to do about His Name !
(And there is many more)

- 1. We are to know His Name. (Proverbs 30:4 Psalm 91:14-15)**
- 2. We are to bless His Name. (Psalm 103:1, 96:2, 72:17)**
- 3. We are to sing to His Name. (Psalm 92:1 Isaiah 42:10)**
- 4. We are to praise His Name. (Isaiah 25:1, Psalm 113:1-3, 99:3)**
- 5. We are to call upon His Name. (Isaiah 12:4, Joel 2:32, Psalm 116:17)**
- 6. We are to give thanks in His Name. (Hebrews 13:15, Psalm 105:1, 92:1)**
- 7. We are to love His Name. (Isaiah 56:6, Psalm 69:36, 5:11, 119: 132)**
- 8. We are to declare His Name. (Isaiah 26:13, 12:4, Psalm 102:21, 105:2)**
- 9. We are to trust in His Name. (Psalm 112:7, Isaiah 26:4, 50:10, Jeremiah 17:7)**
- 10. We are to offer Incense (worship) to His Name. (Malachi 1:11)**

1. We are to know His Name. (Proverbs 30:4 Psalm 91:14-15)

Proverbs 30:4 Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what *is* his name, and what *is* his son's name, if thou canst tell?

Psalms 91:14-15 Because he hath set his love upon Me, therefore will I deliver him: **I will set him on high, because he hath known My name.** He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him: *I will be* with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

2. We are to bless His Name. (Psalm 103:1, 96:2, 72:17)

Psalms 103:1 *A Psalm* of David. Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, **bless His holy name.**

Psalms 96:2 Sing unto the LORD, **bless His name;** shew forth his salvation from day to day.

Psalms 72:17 His name shall endure for ever: His name shall be continued as long as the sun: and *men* shall be blessed in Him: all nations shall call Him blessed.

3. We are to sing to His Name. (Psalm 92:1 Isaiah 42:10)

Psalms 92:1 *It is a good thing* to give thanks unto the LORD, and to **sing praises unto Thy name**, O most High:

Isaiah 42:10 Sing unto the LORD a new song, *and* His praise from the end of the earth, ye that go down to the sea, and all that is therein; the isles, and the inhabitants thereof.

4. We are to praise His Name. (Isaiah 25:1, Psalm 113:1-3, 99:3)

Isaiah 25:1 O LORD, thou *art* my God; I will exalt thee, **I will praise Thy name**; for Thou hast done wonderful *things*; Thy counsels of old *are* faithfulness *and* truth.

Psalms 113:1-3 Praise ye the LORD. Praise, O ye servants of the LORD, **praise the name of the LORD. Blessed be the name of the LORD** from this time forth and for evermore. From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same **the LORD'S name is to be praised.**

Psalms 99:3 Let them praise Thy great and terrible name; *for it is holy.*

5. We are to call upon His Name. (Isaiah 12:4, Joel 2:32, Psalm 116:17)

Isaiah 12:4 And in that day shall ye say, Praise the LORD, **call upon His name**, declare His doings among the people, make mention that His name is exalted.

Joel 2:32 And it shall come to pass, *that* **whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered**: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.

Psalms 116:17 I will offer to Thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will **call upon the name of the LORD**.

6. We are to give thanks in His Name. (Hebrews 13:15, Psalm 105:1, 92:1)

Hebrews 13:15 By Him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of *our* lips **giving thanks to His name**.

Psalms 105:1 O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon His name: make known His deeds among the people.

Psalms 92:1 *It is a good thing* to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto Thy name, O most High:

7. We are to love His Name. (Isaiah 56:6, Psalm 69:36, 5:11, 119: 132)

Isaiah 56:6 Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to the LORD, to serve Him, and to **love the name of the LORD**, to be His servants, every one that keepeth the Sabbath from polluting it, and taketh hold of My covenant;

Psalms 69:36 The seed also of His servants shall inherit it: and they that **love His name** shall dwell therein.

Psalms 5:11 But let all those that put their trust in Thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because Thou defendest them: let them also that **love Thy name** be joyful in thee.

8. We are to declare His Name. (Isaiah 26:13, 12:4, Psalm 102:21, 105:2)

Isaiah 26:13 O LORD our God, *other* lords beside Thee have had dominion over us: *but* by Thee only will we **make mention of Thy name.**

Isaiah 12:4 And in that day shall ye say, Praise the LORD, call upon His name, declare His doings among the people, **make mention that His name is exalted.**

Psalms 102:21 To **declare the name of the LORD** in Zion, and His praise in Jerusalem

Psalms 105:2 Sing unto Him, sing psalms unto him: **talk ye of all His wondrous works.**

9. We are to trust in His Name. (Psalm 112:7, Isaiah 26:4, 50:10, Jeremiah 17:7

Psalms 112:7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD.

Isaiah 26:4 Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH *is* everlasting strength:

Isaiah 50:10 Who *is* among you that feareth the LORD, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh *in* darkness, and hath no light? **let him trust in the name of the LORD**, and stay upon his God.

Jeremiah 17:7 Blessed *is* the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.

10: We are to offer Incense (worship) to His Name. (Malachi 1:11)

Malachi 1:11 For from the rising of the sun even unto the going down of the same My name *shall be* great among the Gentiles; and **in every place incense shall be offered unto My name, and a pure offering:** for My name *shall be* great among the heathen, saith the LORD of hosts.

We are commanded to use and revere
Yahweh's Name, Exodus 20:7; Leviticus
22:2; Deuteronomy 28:58; Psalm 105:1;
Isaiah 52:6; Matthew 6:9; John 17:26

Exodus 20:7 Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh His name in vain.

Leviticus 22:2 Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, that they separate themselves from the holy things of the children of Israel, and that they profane not My holy name *in those things* which they hallow unto Me: I *am* the LORD.

Deuteronomy 28:58 If thou wilt not observe to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that thou mayest fear this glorious and fearful name, THE LORD THY GOD; [YHVH elohim]

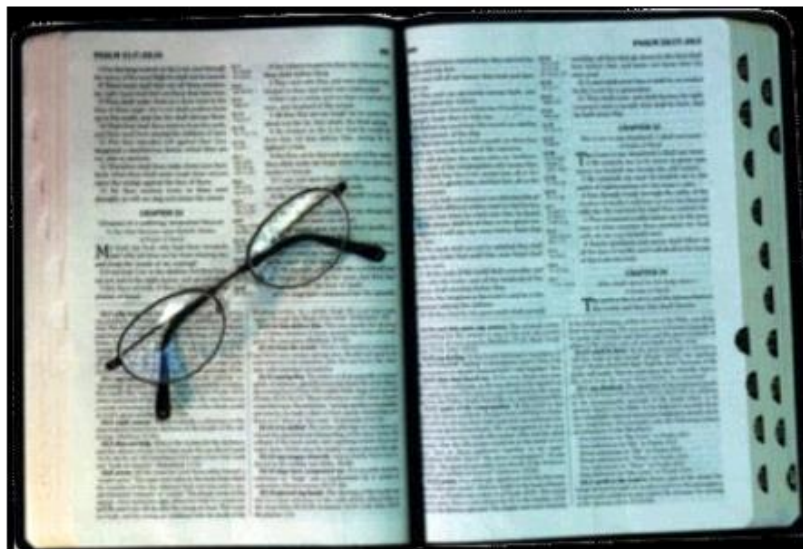
Psalms 105:1 O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon His name: make known His deeds among the people.

Isaiah 52:6 Therefore My people shall know My name: therefore *they shall know* in that day that I *am* He that doth speak: behold, *it is I*.

Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name.

John 17:26 And I have declared unto them Thy name, and will declare *it*: that the love wherewith Thou hast loved Me may be in them, and I in them.

- The “Sacred Name” movement is a recent creation
- “Sacred Namism” is the teaching that the use of the Hebrew names of the Father and Son are required for salvation
- 3rd Commandment is about hypocrisy, not phonics
- Blasphemy / profanation of His name is also not aural
- Titles can be substituted for names
- The English words “God,” “Lord,” and “Jesus” are not pagan/sinful
- Names ARE translatable between languages
- Original language confused / God made all new
- Pentecost languages miracle / gifts of tongues
- “Name” is not so narrowly defined in Scripture
- “Holy Name” does not equate to “Hebrew name”
