

In the Book: LEVITICUS 25

- <u>EX 12:24</u> And ye shall observe this thing for an ordinance to thee and to thy sons for ever. And it shall come to pass, when ye be come to the land which the LORD will give you, according as he hath promised, that ye shall keep this service. And it shall come to pass, when your children shall say unto you, What mean ye by this service? That ye shall say, It *is* the sacrifice of the LORD'S passover, who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt, when he smote the Egyptians, and delivered our houses. And the people bowed the head and worshipped.
- Unleavened Bread <u>Ex 12:17</u> And ye shall observe *the feast of* **unleavened** bread; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever. We observe as a means to remember.


• Feast of Weeks **Deut 16:10** "Then you shall keep the Feast of Weeks to the LORD your God with the tribute of a freewill offering from your hand, which you shall give as the LORD your God blesses you. "You shall rejoice before the LORD your God, you and your son and your daughter, your male servant and your female servant, the Levite who *is* within your gates, the stranger and the fatherless and the widow who *are* among you, at the place where the LORD your God chooses to make His name abide. "And you shall remember that you were a slave in Egypt, and you shall be careful to observe these statutes. Here we have the call to remember where we came from, because this will have us not forgetting the mercy we have been afforded.

- <u>Psalms 89:15</u> Blessed *is* the people that know the **joyful** sound: they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance


• Matt 5:4 Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.





 Psalms 73:12 Look at these wicked people enjoying a life of ease while their riches multiply. Did I keep my heart pure for nothing? Did I keep myself innocent for no reason? I get nothing but trouble all day long; every morning brings me pain. If I had really spoken this way to others, I would have been a traitor to your people.



• <u>Psalms 73: 16</u> So I tried to understand why the wicked prosper. But what a difficult task it is! Then I went into your sanctuary, O God, and I finally understood the destiny of the wicked. Truly, you put them on a slippery path and send them sliding over the cliff to destruction. In an instant they are destroyed, completely swept away by terrors. When you arise, O Lord, you will laugh at their silly ideas as a person laughs at dreams in the morning.



- <u>Psalms 73:21</u> Then I realized that my heart was bitter, and I was all torn up inside. I was so foolish and ignorant—I must have seemed like a senseless animal to you. Yet I still belong to you; you hold my right hand. You guide me with your counsel, leading me to a glorious destiny.
- Whom have I in heaven but you? I desire you more than anything on earth. My health may fail, and my spirit may grow weak, but God remains the strength of my heart; he is mine forever.
- <u>Psalms 73:27</u> Those who desert him will perish, for you destroy those who abandon you.


- Matt 5:5 Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth


- <u>Eph 4:2</u> Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love.

- <u>Luke 11:28</u> Jesus replied, "But even more blessed are all who hear the word of God and put it into practice."


• <u>Matt 5:6</u> Blessed *are* they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.




• Matt 5: 7 Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy



 <u>Luke 11:28</u> Jesus replied, "But even more blessed are all who hear the word of God and put it into practice."




 James 1:25 But if you look carefully into the perfect law that sets you free, and if you do what it says and don't forget what you heard, then God will bless you for doing it.


"Do not sorrow, for the joy of the Lord is your strength." Nehemiah 8:10c
