# Messiah

According To The Scriptures



**Matthew 5:17** Think not that I am come to destroy the Law, or the Prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

**1 Peter 1:10-12** Of which salvation the prophets have inquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace *that should come* unto you: Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow. Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Spirit sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

**Malachi 3:1** Behold, I will send My messenger, and he shall prepare the way before Me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.

**Isaiah 40:3** The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

**Mark 1:1-4** The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God; As it is written in the prophets, **Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee. The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.** John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.

**Malachi 3:1** Behold, I will send My messenger, and he shall prepare the way before Me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.

**Luke 7:26-28** But what went ye out for to see? A prophet? Yea, I say unto you, and much more than a prophet. **This is he, of whom it is written, Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee.** For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he.

**Malachi 3:1** Behold, I will send My messenger, and he shall prepare the way before Me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.

**Isaiah 40:3** The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

**Matthew 3:1-3** In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea, And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. **For this is he that was spoken of by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.**

**Matthew 11:10** For this is he, of whom it is written, **Behold, I send My messenger before Thy face, which shall prepare Thy way before Thee.**

**Deuteronomy 18:15** The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto Him ye shall hearken;

**Deuteronomy 18:18-19** I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put My words in His mouth; and He shall speak unto them all that I shall command Him. And it shall come to pass, *that* whosoever will not hearken unto My words which He shall speak in My name, I will require *it* of him.



**John 6:14** Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, **This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.**

**John 7:40** Many of the people therefore, when they heard this saying, said, **Of a truth this is the Prophet.**

**Acts 3:20-24** And He shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began. For Moses truly said unto the fathers, **A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; Him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever He shall say unto you. And it shall come to pass, *that* every soul, which will not hear that Prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people.** Yea, and all the prophets from Samuel and those that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days.

**Micah 5:2** But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, *though* thou be little among the thousands of Judah, *yet* out of thee shall he come forth unto Me *that is* to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth *have been* from of old, from everlasting.

**Matthew 2:1-6** Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him. When Herod the king had heard *these things*, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he demanded of them where Christ should be born. And they said unto him, In Bethlehem of Judaea: for thus it is written by the prophet, **And thou Bethlehem, in the land of Juda, art not the least among the princes of Juda: for out of thee shall come a Governor, that shall rule my people Israel.**

**Luke 2:4-11** And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:) To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child. And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn. And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.



**Isaiah 7:14** Therefore the Lord Himself shall give you a sign;  
Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his  
name Immanuel.

**Matthew 1:18-23** Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise:  
When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they  
came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit. Then  
Joseph her husband, being a just *man*, and not willing to make her  
a publick example, was minded to put her away privily. But while  
he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared  
unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to  
take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is  
of the Holy Spirit. And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt  
call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.  
Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken  
of the Lord by the prophet, saying, **Behold, a virgin shall be with  
child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name  
Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.**

**Hosea 11:1** When Israel *was* a child, then I loved him, and called My son out of Egypt.

**Matthew 2:13-15** And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and His mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy Him. When he arose, he took the young child and His mother by night, and departed into Egypt: And was there until the death of Herod: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, **Out of Egypt have I called My Son.**

**Isaiah 9:1-2** Nevertheless the dimness *shall* not *be* such as *was* in her vexation, when at the first He lightly afflicted the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, and afterward did more grievously afflict *her by* the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, in Galilee of the nations. The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined.

**Matthew 4:12-15** Now when Jesus had heard that John was cast into prison, He departed into Galilee; And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is upon the sea coast, in the borders of Zabulon and Nephthalim: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, **The land of Zabulon, and the land of Nephthalim, by the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles;**

**Isaiah 42:1-4** Behold My servant, whom I uphold; Mine elect, *in whom* My soul delighteth; I have put My spirit upon Him: He shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles. He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause His voice to be heard in the street. A bruised reed shall He not break, and the smoking flax shall He not quench: He shall bring forth judgment unto truth. He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till He have set judgment in the earth: and the isles shall wait for His law.

**Matthew 12:15-21** But when Jesus knew *it*, He withdrew Himself from thence: and great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all; And charged them that they should not make Him known: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, **Behold My servant, whom I have chosen; My beloved, in whom My soul is well pleased: I will put My spirit upon Him, and He shall shew judgment to the Gentiles. He shall not strive, nor cry; neither shall any man hear His voice in the streets. A bruised reed shall He not break, and smoking flax shall He not quench, till He send forth judgment unto victory. And in His name shall the Gentiles trust.**



**Psalms 132:11** The LORD hath sworn *in* truth unto David; He will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.

**Jeremiah 23:5** Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

**Matthew 1:1** The book of the generation of **Jesus Christ, the son of David**, the son of Abraham.

**Psalms 110:1** The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit Thou at My right hand, until I make Thine enemies Thy footstool.

**Matthew 22:42-45** Saying, What think ye of Christ? whose son is He? They say unto Him, *The Son of David*. He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call Him Lord, saying, **The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit Thou on My right hand, till I make Thine enemies Thy footstool? If David then call Him Lord, how is He his son?**

**Mark 12:35-37** And Jesus answered and said, while He taught in the temple, How say the scribes that Christ is the Son of David? For David himself said by the Holy Spirit, **The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on My right hand, till I make Thine enemies Thy footstool.** David therefore himself calleth Him Lord; and whence is He *then* his son? And the common people heard Him gladly.

**Luke 20:41-44** And He said unto them, How say they that Christ is David's son? And David himself saith in the book of Psalms, **The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit Thou on My right hand, Till I make Thine enemies Thy footstool.** David therefore calleth Him Lord, how is He then his son?

**Psalms 110:4** The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou *art* a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.

**Hebrews 5:6** As He saith also in another *place*, **Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.**

**Hebrews 5:10** Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec.

**Hebrews 7:1-3** For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him; To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace; Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the Son of God; abideth a priest continually.

**Psalms 2:7-8** I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto Me, Thou *art* My Son; this day have I begotten thee. Ask of Me, and I shall give *Thee* the heathen *for* Thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth *for* Thy possession.

**Acts 13:33** God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that He hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also written in the second Psalm, **Thou art My Son, this day have I begotten Thee.**

**Hebrews 1:5** For unto which of the angels said He at any time, **Thou art My Son, this day have I begotten Thee?** And again, I will be to Him a Father, and He shall be to me a Son?



**Isaiah 61:1-2** The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

**Luke 4:17-21** And there was delivered unto Him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written, **The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He hath anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He hath sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.** And He closed the book, and He gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on Him. And He began to say unto them, **This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.**

**Isaiah 53:4-5** Surely He hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But He *was* wounded for our transgressions, *He was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed.

**Matthew 8:16-17** When the even was come, they brought unto Him many that were possessed with devils: and He cast out the spirits with *His* word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, **Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.**

**1 Peter 2:24** Who His own self bare our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: **by whose stripes ye were healed.**

**Psalms 118:22-23** The stone *which* the builders refused is become the head *stone* of the corner. This is the LORD'S doing; it *is* marvellous in our eyes.

**Matthew 21:42** Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the Scriptures, **The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?**

**Mark 12:10-11** And have ye not read this Scripture; **The stone which the builders rejected is become the head of the corner: This was the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?**

**Luke 20:17-18** And He beheld them, and said, What is this then that is written, **The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner?** Whosoever shall fall upon that stone shall be broken; but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.

**Acts 4:11** This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner.

**Isaiah 8:14** And He shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of stumbling and for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

**1 Peter 2:4-8** To whom coming, *as unto* a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, *and* precious, Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. Wherefore also it is contained in the Scripture, **Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on Him shall not be confounded. Unto you therefore which believe *he is* precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, *even to them which stumble at the word***, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.

**Isaiah 53:1** Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

**John 12:37-38** But though He had done so many miracles before them, yet they believed not on Him: That the saying of Esaias the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spake, **Lord, who hath believed our report? and to whom hath the arm of the Lord been revealed?**

**Romans 10:16-17** But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, **Lord, who hath believed our report?** So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

**Psalms 78:2** I will open My mouth in a parable: I will utter dark sayings of old:

**Matthew 13:34-35** All these things spake Jesus unto the multitude in parables; and without a parable spake He not unto them: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying, **I will open My mouth in parables; I will utter things which have been kept secret from the foundation of the world.**



**Isaiah 6:9-10** And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.

**Matthew 13:13-15** Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand. And in them is fulfilled the prophecy of Esaias, which saith, **By hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and shall not perceive: For this people's heart is waxed gross, and *their* ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with *their* eyes, and hear with *their* ears, and should understand with *their* heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.**

**Mark 4:11-12** And He said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all *these* things are done in parables: That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and *their* sins should be forgiven them.

**Luke 8:10** And He said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God: but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand.

**John 12:39-41** Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again, **He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with *their* eyes, nor understand with *their* heart, and be converted, and I should heal them.** These things said Esaias, when he saw His glory, and spake of Him.

**Romans 11:7-8** What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded (According as it is written, **God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;**) unto this day.

**Acts 28:23-28** And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into *his* lodging; to whom he expounded and testified the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses, and *out of* the Prophets, from morning till evening. And some believed the things which were spoken, and some believed not. And when they agreed not among themselves, they departed, after that Paul had spoken one word, Well spake the Holy Spirit by Esaias the prophet unto our fathers, Saying, **Go unto this people, and say, Hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and not perceive: For the heart of this people is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes have they closed; lest they should see with *their* eyes, and hear with *their* ears, and understand with *their* heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.** Be it known therefore unto you, that the salvation of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and *that* they will hear it.

**Zechariah 9:9** Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: He *is* just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

**Matthew 21:1-5** And when they drew nigh unto Jerusalem, and were come to Bethphage, unto the mount of Olives, then sent Jesus two disciples, Saying unto them, Go into the village over against you, and straightway ye shall find an ass tied, and a colt with her: loose *them*, and bring *them* unto Me. And if any *man* say ought unto you, ye shall say, The Lord hath need of them; and straightway he will send them. All this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying, **Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.**

**John 12:14-16** And Jesus, when He had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written, **Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.** These things understood not His disciples at the first: but when Jesus was glorified, then remembered they that these things were written of Him, and *that* they had done these things unto Him.

**Psalms 41:9** Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of My bread, hath lifted up *his* heel against Me.

**Luke 22:21** But, behold, the hand of him that betrayeth Me *is* with Me on the table.

**John 13:18-19** I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen: but that the Scripture may be fulfilled, **He that eateth bread with Me hath lifted up his heel against Me.** Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I am *He*.

**Zechariah 13:7** Awake, O sword, against My shepherd, and against the man *that is* My fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn Mine hand upon the little ones.

**Matthew 26:31-32** Then saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of Me this night: for it is written, **I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad.** But after I am risen again, I will go before you into Galilee.



**Psalms 35:19** Let not them that are mine enemies wrongfully rejoice over me: *neither* let them wink with the eye that hate me without a cause.

**Psalms 69:4** They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head: they that would destroy me, *being* mine enemies wrongfully, are mighty: then I restored *that* which I took not away.

**John 15:24-25** If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father. But *this cometh to pass*, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, **They hated me without a cause.**

**Psalms 22:18** They part My garments among them, and cast lots upon My vesture.

**Matthew 27:35** And they crucified Him, and parted His garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, **They parted My garments among them, and upon My vesture did they cast lots.**

**Mark 15:24** And when they had crucified Him, they parted His garments, casting lots upon them, what every man should take.

**Luke 23:34** Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.

**John 19:23-24** Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also *His* coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout. They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the Scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, **They parted My raiment among them, and for My vesture they did cast lots.** These things therefore the soldiers did.

**Zechariah 12:10** And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon Me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for Him, as one mourneth for *his* only son, and shall be in bitterness for Him, as one that is in bitterness for *his* firstborn.

**John 19:37** And again another Scripture saith, **They shall look on Him whom they pierced.**

**Isaiah 53:12** Therefore will I divide Him *a portion* with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong; because He hath poured out His soul unto death: and He was numbered with the transgressors; and He bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

**Mark 15:27-28** And with Him they crucify two thieves; the one on His right hand, and the other on His left. And the Scripture was fulfilled, which saith, **And He was numbered with the transgressors.**

**Luke 22:37** For I say unto you, that this that is written must yet be accomplished in Me, **And He was reckoned among the transgressors:** for the things concerning Me have an end.

**John 19:18** Where they crucified Him, and two other with Him, on either side one, and Jesus in the midst.

**Psalms 16:8-11** I have set the LORD always before Me: because *He is* at My right hand, I shall not be moved. Therefore My heart is glad, and My glory rejoiceth: My flesh also shall rest in hope. For Thou wilt not leave My soul in hell; neither wilt Thou suffer Thine Holy One to see corruption. Thou wilt shew Me the path of life: in Thy presence *is* fulness of joy; at Thy right hand *there are* pleasures for evermore.

**Acts 2:22-32** Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by Him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain: Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that He should be holden of it. For David speaketh concerning Him, **I foresaw the Lord always before My face, for He is on my right hand, that I should not be moved: Therefore did My heart rejoice, and My tongue was glad; moreover also My flesh shall rest in hope: Because Thou wilt not leave My soul in hell, neither wilt Thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. Thou hast made known to Me the ways of life; Thou shalt make Me full of joy with Thy countenance.** Men *and* brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day. Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, He would raise up Christ to sit on his throne; He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that His soul was not left in hell, neither His flesh did see corruption. This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.



Messiah would have a forerunner preparing His way (Malachi 3:1/Isaiah 40:3)

Messiah would be a prophet like Moses (Deuteronomy 18:15,18-19)

Messiah would be born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2)

Messiah pre-exists His carnation, being from eternity (Micah 5:2)

Messiah would be born of a virgin (Isaiah 7:14)
