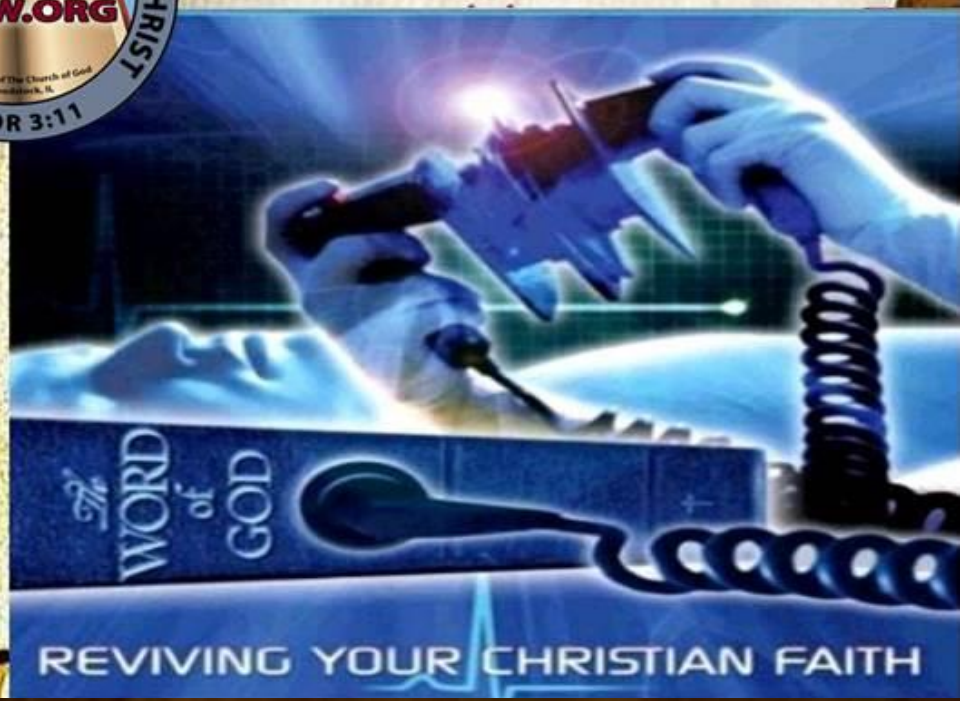
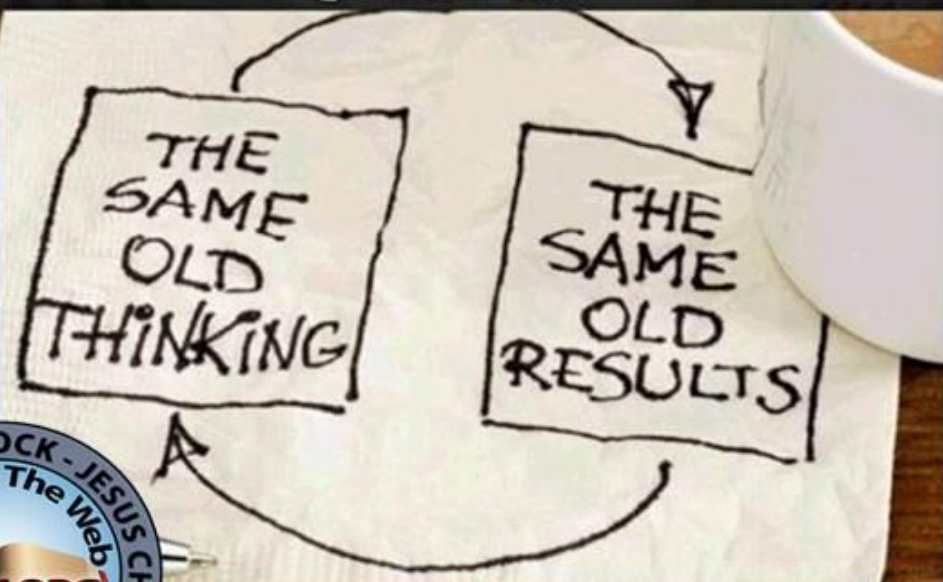

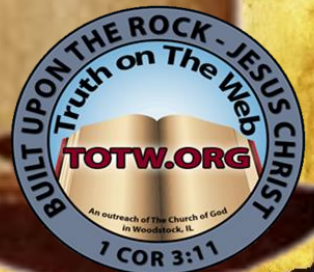

Part 3

Luke 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, He expounded unto them in **all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.**

Luke 24:44 And He said unto them, These *are* the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that **all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the Law of Moses, and in the Prophets, and in the Psalms, concerning Me.**

John 5:39 Search the Scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and **they are they which testify of Me.**

John 5:46 For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed Me: for **he wrote of Me.**

Hebrews 10:7 Then said I, Lo, I come (**in the volume of the Book it is written of Me,**) to do Thy will, O God.

Job



He Wrote of Me

Part 3

Job was a type of Christ in that:

he was a righteous sufferer - Job 1-42

he loved righteousness and eschewed evil – Job 1:1

he was patient above all – Job 1-42; James 5:11

he underwent a humiliation and exaltation - Job 1-42

he was tested by God when he was tempted by the devil – Job 1-2

Joseph



He Wrote of Me Part 3

Genesis 50:20 But as for you, ye thought evil against me; *but* God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as *it is* this day, to save much people alive.

Acts 2:23 Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain:

Acts 4:27-28 For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom Thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together, For to do whatsoever Thy hand and Thy counsel determined before to be done.

Part 3

Joseph was a type of Christ in that:

his birth was miraculous - Genesis 30:22

he was greatly loved and highly favored by his Father - Genesis 37:3

he was a prophet - Genesis 37:5-10

he foretold his own exaltation - Genesis 37:5-10

his brothers did not believe his prophecies and hated him - Genesis 37:4-5

his brothers rejected his right to rule - Genesis 37:8

he was sent by his father to seek out his brothers - Genesis 37:13-17

his brothers conspired against him to slay him - Genesis 37:18

he was stripped of his garments - Genesis 37:23

he was sold for silver by Judah - Genesis 37:26-28

he was handed over to the gentiles - Genesis 37:27-28

all things were placed into his trust - Genesis 39:4-8

he was tempted and did not sin - Genesis 39:7-12

he was imprisoned based on false charges - Genesis 39:17-20

he was bound - Genesis 39:30

he was condemned with two criminals - Genesis 40:2-3 [One criminal was given life and the other was condemned - Genesis 40:21-22]

he suffered patiently - Genesis 39:41

he was trustworthy and wise - Genesis 41:39

he was exalted to the right hand of the king - Genesis 41:42-44

he married a foreign bride who shared his glory - Genesis 41:45

his brethren did not recognize him - Genesis 42:7-8

he revealed himself to his brethren and forgave them - Genesis 45:1-5

God planned his suffering in advance to save many - Genesis 50:21

Aaron

Part 3

Exodus 4:14-16 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Moses, and he said, *Is not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he cometh forth to meet thee: and when he seeth thee, he will be glad in his heart. And thou shalt speak unto him, and put words in his mouth: and I will be with thy mouth, and with his mouth, and will teach you what ye shall do. And he shall be thy spokesman unto the people: and he shall be, even he shall be to thee instead of a mouth, and thou shalt be to him instead of God.*

Exodus 7:1-2 And the LORD said unto Moses, See, I have made thee a god to Pharaoh: and Aaron thy brother shall be thy prophet. Thou shalt speak all that I command thee: and Aaron thy brother shall speak unto Pharaoh, that he send the children of Israel out of his land.

Part 3

Hebrews 5:1-6 For every high priest taken from among men is ordained for men in things *pertaining* to God, that he may offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins: Who can have compassion on the ignorant, and on them that are out of the way; for that he himself also is compassed with infirmity. And by reason hereof he ought, as for the people, so also for himself, to offer for sins. And no man taketh this honour unto himself, but he that is called of God, as *was* Aaron. So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, to day have I begotten thee. As he saith also in another *place*, Thou *art* a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

Hebrews 9:6-8 Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service *of God*. But into the second *went* the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and *for* the errors of the people: The Holy Ghost this signifying, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing:

Hebrews 9:23-24 *It was* therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these. For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, *which are* the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:

Numbers 35:25 And the congregation shall deliver the slayer out of the hand of the revenger of blood, and the congregation shall restore him to the city of his refuge, whither he was fled: and he shall abide in it unto the death of the high priest, which was anointed with the holy oil.

Part 3

Aaron was a type of Christ in that:

he was a prophet – Exodus 7:1

he was the Word of God – Exodus 4:14-16; 7:1-2

he was high priest – Leviticus 8:1-9; 16:1-28

he offered atonement for all - Leviticus 16:17, 30

his death would “set the captives free” - Numbers 35:25

Moses

Part 3

Deuteronomy 18:15-19 The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken; According to all that thou desiredst of the LORD thy God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not. And the LORD said unto me, They have well *spoken that* which they have spoken. I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put My words in His mouth; and He shall speak unto them all that I shall command Him. And it shall come to pass, *that* whosoever will not hearken unto My words which He shall speak in My name, I will require *it* of him.

Acts 3:19-24 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; And He shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began. For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. And it shall come to pass, *that* every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people. Yea, and all the prophets from Samuel and those that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days.

Moses was a type of Christ in that:

he was delivered from a death decree in his infancy - Exodus 1-2

he was meek - Numbers 12:3

he rejected rulership in this world - Hebrew 11:24

he was a shepherd - Exodus 3:1

he was a prophet - Deuteronomy 18:15; Acts 7:36

he performed miracles - Exodus 14:21; Acts 7:36

he had power over the sea - Exodus 14:21

he was rejected by his people - Exodus 2:11-14; 32:1; Acts 7:35

he was accepted by gentiles - Exodus 2:14-22

he fasted 40 days in the wilderness - Exodus 34:28

he was transfigured - Exodus 34:29-35

he revealed God's will from the Mount - Exodus 19-24

he was the mediator of the covenant - Exodus 19-24

he offered to die on behalf of the people - Exodus 30:30-32

he instituted the memorial of the Passover - Exodus 12

he appointed 12 & 70 - Numbers 11:16-17

Joshua



He Wrote of Me

Part 3

Joshua 1:1-6 Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying, Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, *even* to the children of Israel. Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses. From the wilderness and this Lebanon even unto the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and unto the great sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your coast. There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee. Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I swear unto their fathers to give them.

Joshua 11:23 So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the LORD said unto Moses; and Joshua gave it for an inheritance unto Israel according to their divisions by their tribes. And the land rested from war.

Hebrews 4:8-10 For if Joshua had given them rest, He would not have spoken afterward of another day. There remains therefore a Sabbath rest for the people of God. For he who has entered into His rest has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His.



He Wrote of Me

Part 3

Joshua was a type of Christ in that:

he was also named “Yeshua” – Numbers 13:16; Joshua 1:1

he was the son of Nun (“perpetuity”) – Joshua 1:1

he was filled with the Spirit of wisdom – Deuteronomy 34:9

no one could stand against him in victory – Joshua 1:5

he led God’s people into their inheritance – Joshua 11:23

the land rested from war under his rule – Joshua 11:23

Boaz



He Wrote of Me

Part 3

Boaz was a type of Christ in that:

- he was of the tribe of Judah – Ruth 2:1
- he was from Bethlehem – Ruth 2:4
- he acted as a kinsman redeemer – Ruth 2:20; 4:10
- he bought a bride of the nations – Ruth 4:10
- he was the root of David – Ruth 4:17, 21-22

Samson



He Wrote of Me

Part 3

Samson was a type of Christ in that:

he was “sunlight” / Samson (Hebrew “Shimshon”) – Judges 13:24

his birth was foretold by an angel – Judges 13:2-4

his birth was miraculous – Judges 13:3

he was betrayed for silver – Judges 16:5

he was delivered to his enemies, tortured, and mocked openly – Judges 16:21-25

he gave his life to defeat the enemy of God’s people – Judges 16:27-30

David



He Wrote of Me

Part 3

David was a type of Christ in that:

he was a shepherd – 1 Samuel 16:11

he was a prophet – Acts 2

he was from Bethlehem - 1 Kings 17:12

he was the offspring of Jesse – 1 Samuel 17:12

he was chosen by God to be the King of Israel – 2 Samuel 5:1,2,12

he was a man after God's own heart – Acts 13:22

he defeated the enemy of his people – 1 Samuel 17:50-51

he had a betrayer who hung himself – 2 Samuel 15:12-17:23

he loved Jonathan above all others – 1 Samuel 18:1,3; 2 Samuel 1:26

his throne is established forever – Psalm 89:36-37

he foretold Christ's sufferings, resurrection, and exaltation in the first person – Psalm 22; Psalm 69; Psalm 16; Psalm 110

the Redeemer is called "David" in the Prophets - Ezekiel 34:23-24; 37:24-25; Jeremiah 30:9; Hosea 3:5

Solomon



He Wrote of Me

Part 3

1 Chronicles 22:9-10 Behold, a son shall be born to thee, who shall be a man of rest; and I will give him rest from all his enemies round about: for his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quietness unto Israel in his days. He shall build an house for my name; and he shall be my son, and I *will be* his father; and I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel for ever.

2 Samuel 7:12-14 And when thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall proceed out of thy bowels, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom for ever. I will be his father, and he shall be my son...

Luke 1:31-33 And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

Solomon was a type of Christ in that:

he was the “son of David” – 1 Chronicles 22:9; 2 Samuel 12:24

he was the Prince of Peace - 1 Chronicles 22:9; 2 Samuel 12:24

he was filled with the spirit of discernment and wisdom - 1 Kings 3:5-12; 4:29-34

he fame was sounded out to the nations – 1 Kings 4:29-34; 10:1-5

he built and sanctified the Temple of God - 1 Chronicles 22:10; 2 Samuel 7:13;

Elisha

Elisha was a type of Christ in that:

he was a prophet – 1 Kings 19:16

he was directly preceded by Elijah – 1 Kings 19:19; 2 Kings 2:13

he had power over the waters – 2 Kings 2:14; 2 Kings 6:5-7

he turned a small amount into an abundance – 2 Kings 4:1-7

he raised the dead – 2 Kings 4:33-35

he fed a multitude with a small number of loaves – 2 Kings 4:42-44

he healed leprosy – 2 Kings 5:10-15

He opened the eyes of the blind – 2 Kings 6:20

In his death, he brought life – 2 Kings 13:20-21

2 Kings 2:13-14 He took up also the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and went back, and stood by the bank of Jordan; And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where *is* the LORD God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

2 Kings 2:19-22 And the men of the city said unto Elisha, Behold, I pray thee, the situation of this city *is* pleasant, as my lord seeth: but the water *is* naught, and the ground barren. And he said, Bring me a new cruse, and put salt therein. And they brought *it* to him. And he went forth unto the spring of the waters, and cast the salt in there, and said, Thus saith the LORD, I have healed these waters; there shall not be from thence any more death or barren *land*. So the waters were healed unto this day, according to the saying of Elisha which he spake.

2 Kings 6:5-6 But as one was felling a beam, the axe head fell into the water: and he cried, and said, Alas, master! for it was borrowed. And the man of God said, Where fell it? And he shewed him the place. And he cut down a stick, and cast *it* in thither; and the iron did swim.

Elisha was a type of Christ in that:

he was a prophet – 1 Kings 19:16

he was directly preceded by Elijah – 1 Kings 19:19; 2 Kings 2:13

he had power over the waters – 2 Kings 2:14; 2 Kings 6:5-7

he turned a small amount into an abundance – 2 Kings 4:1-7

he raised the dead – 2 Kings 4:33-35

he fed a multitude with a small number of loaves – 2 Kings 4:42-44

he healed leprosy – 2 Kings 5:10-15

He opened the eyes of the blind – 2 Kings 6:20

In his death, he brought life – 2 Kings 13:20-21

Jonah



He Wrote of Me

Part 3

Jonah 1:17 Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

Matthew 12:39-41 But He answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas: For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas *is* here.

Luke 11:29-30 And when the people were gathered thick together, He began to say, This is an evil generation: they seek a sign; and there shall no sign be given it, but the sign of Jonas the prophet. For as Jonas was a sign unto the Ninevites, so shall also the Son of Man be to this generation.

Jonah was a type of Christ in that:

he was sent to Israel and sent to the gentiles – 2 Kings 14:25

he slept in the boat in the midst of the storm – Jonah 1:5

he willingly gave his life to save the others – Jonah 1:12-15

he was in the belly of the fish for 3 days – Jonah 1:17

Jeremiah



He Wrote of Me

Part 3

Jeremiah was a type of Christ in that:

he was a prophet of sorrow and acquainted with grief

he underwent a death and resurrection when he was thrown into a pit and brought out

Eliakim



He Wrote of Me

Part 1

Isaiah 22:20-22 And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will call my servant Eliakim the son of Hilkiah: And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah. And the key of the house of David will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open.

Revelation 3:7 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith He that is holy, He that is true, He that hath the key of David, He that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

Eliakim was a type of Christ in that:

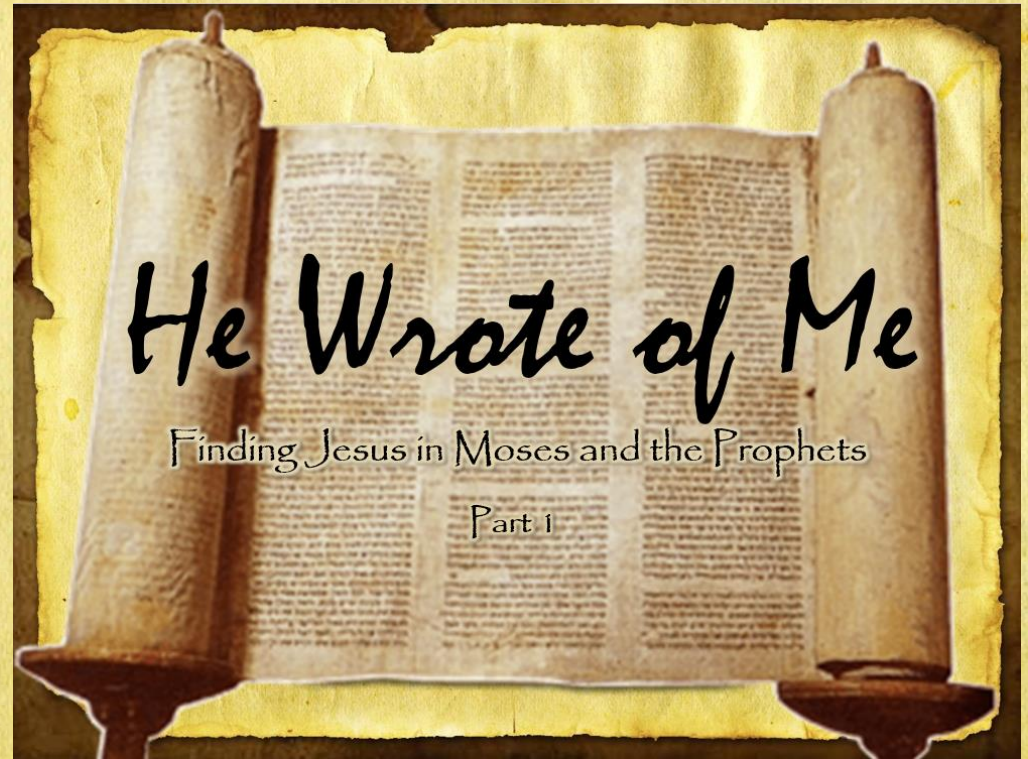
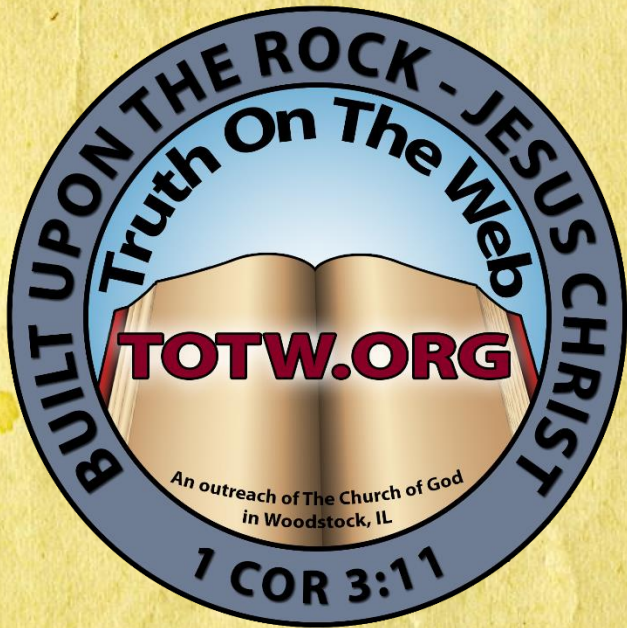
Eliakim = “resurrection of God”
