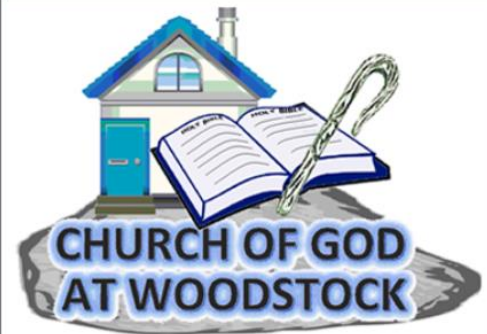

FORGIVENESS

Acts 5:30–33
