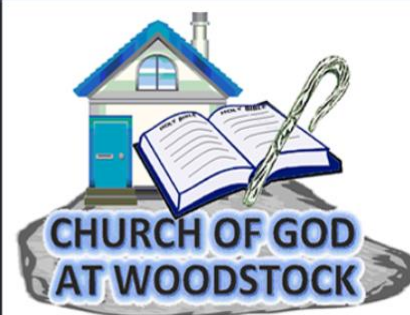

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

**Webster's 1828 Dictionary** Worshiping, participle present tense **Adoring; paying divine honors to; treating with supreme reverence; treating with extreme submission.** -- **Merriam Webster's Dictionary** reverence offered a divine being or supernatural power; also: an act of expressing such reverence, a form of religious practice with its creed and ritual extravagant respect or admiration for or devotion to an object of esteem

**Cambridge Dictionary** to love, respect, and admire someone or something very much, often without noticing the bad qualities of that person or thing, **the act of worshipping God or a god, often through praying or singing**

**Oxford Dictionary** The feeling or expression of reverence and adoration for a deity Religious rites or ceremonies, constituting a formal expression of reverence for a deity **Great admiration or devotion shown towards a person or principle**



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

**WORSHIP(PED) -- Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 7812. חָכָה's hachah *shaw-khaw'* a primitive root; to depress, i.e. prostrate (especially reflexive, in homage to royalty or God):—**bow (self)** down, crouch, fall down (flat), humbly beseech, do (make) obeisance, **do reverence**, make to stoop, **worship**.**

**Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 5457. שָׁגַד @gid (Aramaic) (Aramaic) *seg-eed'* (Aramaic) corresponding to 5456:—worship. See Hebrew 5456**

**Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 5456. שָׁגַד. *cagad saw-gad'* a primitive root; to prostrate oneself (in homage):—fall down.**

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

**Strong's Greek Dictionary 4352. προσκυνεω proskuneo *pros-koo-neh'-o*** from 4314 and a probable derivative of 2965 (**meaning to kiss, like a dog licking his master's hand); to fawn or crouch to, i.e. (literally or figuratively) prostrate oneself in homage (do reverence to, adore):—worship.** See Greek 4314 See Greek 2965

**Strong's Greek Dictionary 4576. σεβομαι sebomai *seb'-om-ahee*** middle voice of an apparently primary verb; to revere, i.e. adore:—**devout, religious, worship.** (APPEARS 10 TIMES IN NT)

**Strong's Greek Dictionary 4353. προσκυνητης proskunetes *pros-koo-nay-tace'*** from 4352; an adorer:—**worshipper.** See Greek 4352



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

**Strong's Greek Dictionary 2318. θεοσεβης theosebēs *theh-os-eb-ace*'** from 2316 and 4576; reverent of God, i.e. pious:—**worshipper of God.** See Greek 2316 See Greek 4576

**Strong's Greek Dictionary 3000. λατρεω latreuō *lat-ryoo*'-o** from latris (a hired menial); to minister (to God), i.e. render religious homage:—**serve, do the service, worship(-per).**

**Strong's Greek Dictionary 2151. ευσεβω eusebeō *yoo-seb-eh*'-o** from 2152; to be pious, i.e. (towards God) to worship, or (towards parents) to respect (support):—**show piety, worship.**

See Greek 2152

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

**Strong's Greek Dictionary 4573. σεβάζομαι sebazomai *seb-ad'-zom-ahee*** middle voice from a derivative of 4576; to venerate, i.e. adore:—worship. See Greek 4576

**Strong's Greek Dictionary 2356. θρησκεια threskeia *thrace-ki'-ah*** from a derivative of 2357; ceremonial observance:—religion, worshipping. See Greek 2357

**Strong's Greek Dictionary 4574. σεβασμα sebasma *seb'-as-mah*** from 4573; something adored, i.e. an object of worship (god, altar, etc):—devotion, that is worshipped. See Greek 4573



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## ACTS OF WORSHIP

### SACRIFICE

**Genesis 4:3-7** And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD. And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering: But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell. And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen? If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee *shall be* his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## SACRIFICE

**Genesis 22:5-6** And Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; and **I and the lad will go yonder and worship,** and come again to you. And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering, and laid *it* upon Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife; and they went both of them together.

**1 Chronicles 16:28-29** Give unto the **LORD**, ye kindreds of the people, **give unto the LORD** glory and strength. **Give unto the LORD** the glory *due* unto his name: **bring an offering,** and come before him: **worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.**



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## SINGING

**1 Chronicles 16:9** Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works.

**Psalm 101:1** A Psalm of David. I will sing of mercy and judgment: unto thee, O LORD, will I sing.

**Judges 5:1-3** Then sang Deborah and Barak the son of Abinoam on that day, saying, **Praise ye the LORD** for the avenging of Israel, when the people willingly offered themselves. Hear, O ye kings; give ear, O ye princes; I, *even I*, will sing unto the LORD; I will sing *praise* to the LORD God of Israel.

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## MUSIC - ACCOMPANIMENT

**1 Chronicles 15:16** And David spake to the chief of the Levites to appoint their brethren *to be* the singers **with instruments of musick, psalteries and harps and cymbals**, sounding, by lifting up the voice **with joy**.

**Psalms 149:5-6** Let the saints be **joyful** in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds. *Let* the high *praises* of God *be* in their mouth, and a twoedged sword in their hand;

**Psalms 150:3-6** Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp. Praise him with the timbrel and dance: praise him with stringed instruments and organs. Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals. Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD.



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## DANCING

**2 Samuel 6:14** And David danced before the LORD with all *his* might; and David *was* girded with a linen ephod.

**2 Samuel 6:16** And as the ark of the LORD came into the city of David, Michal Saul's daughter looked through a window, and saw king David **leaping and dancing before the LORD**; and she despised him in her heart.

**Psalms 149:3** Let them praise his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp.

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## SHOUTING

**Psalm 98:4** Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise.

**Ezra 3:11-13** And they sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because *he is good*, for his mercy *endureth* for ever toward Israel. And all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid. But many of the priests and Levites and chief of the fathers, *who were* ancient men, that had seen the first house, when the foundation of this house was laid before their eyes, **wept with a loud voice; and many shouted aloud for joy**: So that the people could not discern the noise of the shout of joy from the noise of the weeping of the people: for the people shouted with a loud shout, and the noise was heard afar off.

**Psalm 32:11** Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, ye righteous: and shout for joy, all ye that *are upright in heart.*



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## LIFTING HANDS

**Psalm 134:2** Lift up your hands *in* the sanctuary, and bless the LORD.

**Psalm 119:48** My hands also will I lift up unto thy commandments, which I have loved; and I will meditate in thy statutes.

**Psalm 28:2** Hear the voice of my supplications, when I cry unto thee, when I lift up my hands toward thy holy oracle.

**Lamentations 3:40-41** Let us search and try our ways, and turn again to the LORD. Let us lift up our heart with *our* hands unto God in the heavens.

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## BOWING

**Genesis 24:48** And I bowed down my head, and worshipped the LORD, and blessed the LORD God of my master Abraham, which had led me in the right way to take my master's brother's daughter unto his son.

**Genesis 24:52** And it came to pass, that, when Abraham's servant heard their words, he worshipped the LORD, ***bowing himself to the earth.***

**Exodus 4:31** And the people believed: and when they heard that the LORD had visited the children of Israel, and that he had looked upon their affliction, then they **bowed their heads** and worshipped.



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## BOWING

**Exodus 12:27** That ye shall say, It *is* the sacrifice of the LORD'S passover, who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt, when he smote the Egyptians, and delivered our houses. And the **people bowed the head** and worshipped.

**Exodus 34:8** And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped.

**1 Chronicles 29:20** And David said to all the congregation, Now bless the LORD your God. And all the congregation blessed the LORD God of their fathers, and **bowed down their heads**, and worshipped the LORD, and the king.

**2 Chronicles 7:3** And when all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the LORD upon the house, **they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground** upon the pavement, and worshipped, and praised the LORD, *saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever.*

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## KNEELING

**Psalm 95:6** O come, let us worship and bow down: **let us kneel before the LORD our maker.**

**1 Kings 8:54** And it was so, that when Solomon had made an end of praying all this prayer and supplication unto the LORD, he arose from before the altar of the LORD, **from kneeling on his knees with his hands spread up to heaven.**

“When all the Israelites saw the fire coming down and the glory of the Lord above the temple, **they knelt on the pavement with their faces to the ground, and they worshiped and gave thanks to the Lord,** saying, “He is good; his love endures forever.”” (2 Chronicles 7:3)

**Daniel 6:10** Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, **he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God,** as he did aforetime.



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## STANDING

**1 Chronicles 23:30** And to stand every morning to thank and praise the LORD, and likewise at even;

**2 Chronicles 20:19** And the Levites, of the children of the Kohathites, and of the children of the Korhites, stood up to praise the LORD God of Israel with a loud voice on high.

**Nehemiah 9:5** Then the Levites, Jeshua, and Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabniah, Sherebiah, Hodijah, Shebaniah, *and* Pethahiah, said, Stand up *and* bless the LORD your God for ever and ever: and blessed be thy glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise.

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## THE HEART (IN SPIRIT & TRUTH)

**Matthew 15:7-9** *Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying, This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with *their* lips; but their heart is far from me. But in vain they do worship me, teaching *for* doctrines the commandments of men.*



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## THE HEART (IN SPIRIT & TRUTH)

**Isaiah 1:13-17** Bring no more **vain** oblations; incense is an abomination unto me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; *it is* iniquity, even the solemn meeting. Your new moons and your appointed feasts **my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear *them*.** And when ye spread forth your hands, **I will hide mine eyes from you:** yea, when ye make many prayers, **I will not hear: your hands are full of blood. Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil; Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow.**

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

THE HEART (IN SPIRIT & TRUTH)

**Jeremiah 6:19-20** Hear, O earth: behold, I will bring evil upon this people, *even* the fruit of their thoughts, **because they have not hearkened unto my words, nor to my law, but rejected it.** To what purpose cometh there to me incense from Sheba, and **the sweet cane** from a far country? **your burnt offerings *are* not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet unto me.**

**Isaiah 66:2-3** For all those *things* hath mine hand made, and all those *things* have been, saith the LORD: **but to this *man* will I look, *even* to *him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.*** He that killeth an **ox *is as if*** he slew a man; he that **sacrificeth a lamb, *as if*** he cut off a dog's neck; he that **offereth an oblation, *as if*** he offered swine's blood; he that **burneth incense, *as if*** he blessed an idol. **Yea, they have chosen their own ways, and their soul delighteth in their abominations.**



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## NEW SACRIFICE

**KJV - Romans 12:1-2** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye **present your bodies a living sacrifice**, holy, acceptable unto God, *which is* your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

**NLT - Romans 12:1-2** And so, dear brothers and sisters,<sup>[a]</sup> I plead with you to **give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.**<sup>[b]</sup> <sup>2</sup> Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## NEW SACRIFICE

**1 John 3:16-18** Hereby perceive we the love *of God*, because **he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down *our* lives for the brethren.** But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels *of compassion* from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him? My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; **but in deed and in truth.**

**Ephesians 5:25** Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, **and gave himself for it;**

**Philippians 2:3-5** *Let nothing be done* through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind **let each esteem other better than themselves.** Look not every man on his own things, **but every man also on the things of others.**

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## SACRIFICE OF OUR LIPS

**Hebrews 13:15-16** By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of *our* lips giving thanks to his name. But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

**Acts 1:14** These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren.

**Acts 1:24** And they prayed, and said, Thou, Lord, which knowest the hearts of all *men*, shew whether of these two thou hast chosen,  
**Colossians 1:3** We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you,

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## SACRIFICE OF OUR LIPS

**Acts 16:25** And at midnight **Paul and Silas** prayed, and sang praises unto **God**: and the prisoners heard them.

**Matthew 26:30** And when **they** had sung an hymn, they went out into the mount of Olives.

**Hebrews 2:12** Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee.

**Romans 15:9** And that the Gentiles might glorify **God** for *his* mercy; as it is written, For this cause I will confess to thee among the Gentiles, and sing unto thy name.



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## SACRIFICE OF OUR LIPS

**Acts 12:5** Peter therefore was kept in prison: **but prayer was made without ceasing** of the church unto God for him.

**Acts 14:22-23** Confirming the souls of the disciples, *and* exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God. And when they had ordained them elders in every church, and had prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they believed.

**1 Peter 2:5** Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God **by Jesus Christ.**

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## SACRIFICE OF OUR LIPS

**Ephesians 5:19-20 Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;**

**Colossians 3:16-17 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.**



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

DOERS OF THE WORD NOT HEARERS ONLY

**Timothy 2:15** Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

**2 Timothy 3:15-17** And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. **All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.**

**Romans 10:17** So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

DOERS OF THE WORD NOT HEARERS ONLY

**1 John 5:2-4** By this we know that we love the children of God, **when we love God, and keep his commandments. For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.** For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, ***even our faith.***

**Luke 8:21** And he answered and said unto them, My mother and my brethren are **these which hear the word of God, and do it.**

**Luke 11:28** But he said, Yea rather, **blessed *are* they that hear the word of God, and keep it.**

**1 John 2:14** I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him *that is* from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, **and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one.**



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

DOERS OF THE WORD NOT HEARERS ONLY

**Psalm 51:6** Behold, thou desirest **truth in the inward parts:** and in the hidden *part* thou shalt make me to know wisdom.

**Psalm 119:11** Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.

**Psalm 37:31** The law of his God *is* in his heart; none of his steps shall slide.

**Psalm 40:8** I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law *is* within my heart.

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## DOERS OF THE WORD NOT HEARERS ONLY

**Jeremiah 31:33** But this *shall be* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, **saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.**

**Proverbs 3:5-6** Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. **In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.**

**Matthew 22:37-38** Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment.



# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

## SACRIFICE OF OUR LIPS

**John 17:17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.**

**John 4:23-24 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth.**

**John 16:13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, *that* shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.**

# THE HEART OF WORSHIP

**1 John 3:19-24** And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before him. For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things. Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, *then* have we confidence toward God. And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, **because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight. And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment. And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.**
