Mark 12:30

Mark 12:31

And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

Romans 13:8

Owe no man any thing, but to **love one another**: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.



John 13:34

A new **commandment** I give unto you, That ye **love one another**; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.

Luke 6:27–28

But I say unto you which hear, **Love your enemies**, **do good** to them which hate you, **Bless** them that curse you, and **pray** for them which despitefully use you.



1 Peter 1:22

Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth **through the Spirit** unto **unfeigned love** of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

1Timothy 1:5 [NLT]

The purpose of my instruction is that all believers would be **filled with love that comes from a pure heart**, a clear conscience, and genuine faith.



1 John 4:8

He that loveth not knoweth not God; for **God is** love.

1 John 3:18

My little children, let us not love **in word**, neither **in tongue**; but **in deed and in truth**.

Galatians 6:7

Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also

reap.

1 John 2:9

He that saith he is in the light, and **hateth** his brother, is in darkness even until now.

1 John 3:15

Acts 4:18–21

And they called them, and **commanded them** not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. 2 Corinthians 11:23–26

Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a fool) I am more; in **labours** more abundant, in **stripes** above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft. Of the Jews five times received I forty stripes save one. Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep; In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren;

Luke 14:16–20

Then said he unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many: And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready. And they all with one consent began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused. And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused. And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot

come.

Matthew 13:7



Colossians 3:2

Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.



Hebrews 6:8–12 [8-10]

But that which beareth thorns and briers is rejected, and is nigh unto cursing; whose end is to be burned. But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany salvation, though we thus speak. For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.



Hebrews 6:8-12 [11-12]

And we desire that every one of you do shew the **same diligence** to the full assurance of hope unto the end: That ye **be not slothful**, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.



John 16:1–3

These things have I spoken unto you, that ye should **not be offended**. They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever **killeth you will think that he doeth God service**. And these things will they do unto you, because they have **not known the Father, nor me.**



John 16:33

These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.



John 17:15–17

I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest **keep them from the evil**. They are **not of the world**, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them through thy truth: **thy word is truth**.

1 John 4:4

Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.



Romans 12:9-18 [9-13] [NLT]

Don't just pretend to love others. Really love them. Hate what is wrong. Hold tightly to what is good. Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honoring each other. Never be lazy, but work hard and serve the Lord enthusiastically. Rejoice in our confident hope. Be patient in trouble, and keep on praying. When God's people are in need, be ready to help them. Always be eager to practice hospitality.



Romans 12:9-18 [14-18] [NLT]

Bless those who persecute you. Don't curse them; pray that God will bless them. Be happy with those who are happy, and weep with those who weep. Live in harmony with each other. Don't be too proud to enjoy the company of ordinary people. And don't think you know it all! Never pay back evil with more evil. Do things in such a way that everyone can see you are honorable. Do all that you can to live in peace with everyone.

Ephesians 6:10–18 [10-13]

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be **able to stand** against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Ephesians 6:10–18 [14-18]

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the **gospel of peace**; Above all, taking the shield of **faith**, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the **Spirit**, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
