



DAVID: A PORTRAIT OF CHRIST

"The New Testament is in the Old concealed; the Old Testament is in the New revealed."

BIRTH ANNOUNCEMENT

- **1 Samuel 1:5** But unto **Hannah** he gave a worthy portion; for he (Elkanah) loved Hannah: **but the LORD** had shut up her womb.
- **1** Samuel 1:27-28 For this child I (Hannah) prayed; and the LORD hath given me my petition which I asked of him: Therefore also I have lent him to the LORD; as long as he liveth he shall be lent to the LORD. And he worshipped the LORD there.
- **1 Samuel 16:13** Then **Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him** in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.
- **Luke 1:7** And they (Zacharias & Elisabeth) had no child, because that **Elisabeth was barren**, and they both were *now* well stricken in years. **Luke 1:13** But the angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John.
- Mark 1:7-9 And preached, saying, There cometh one mightier than I after me, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose. I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost. And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan.

HOMETOWN BOYS

1 Samuel 17:15 But **David** went and returned from Saul to feed his father's sheep at **Bethlehem.**

1 Samuel 16:1 And the LORD said unto Samuel, How long wilt thou mourn for Saul, seeing I have rejected him from reigning over Israel? fill thine horn with oil, and go, I will send thee to **Jesse the Bethlehemite**: for I have provided me a king among his sons.

Luke 2:4 And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:)

Matthew 2:1 Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem,

SHEPHERDS

1 Samuel 16:11 And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all *thy* children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, **he keepeth the sheep**. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither.

John 10:11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

1 Peter 5:4 And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

THIRTY YEARS OLD

- 2 Samuel 5:4 David was thirty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years.
- Luke 3:23 And Jesus himself began to be about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) the son of Joseph, which was *the son* of Heli,
- **Numbers 4:3 From thirty years old and upw**ard even until fifty years old, all that enter into the host, to do the work in the tabernacle of the congregation.

ANOINTED

- **1 Samuel 16:13a** Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and **anointed him in the midst of his brethren: ...**
- **2 Samuel 23:1-2** Now these *be* the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man *who was* raised up on high, **the anointed of the God of Jacob**, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said, The Spirit of the LORD spake by me, and his word *was* in my tongue.
- Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.
- Hebrews 1:9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

ANOINTED

Luke 4:18-21 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord. And he closed the book, and he gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him. And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

INDWELLING SPIRIT

1 Samuel 16:13 Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: **and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward.** So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

Luke 3:22 And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

MANY ENEMIES

- **Psalm 3:1** A Psalm of David, when he fled from Absalom his son. LORD, how are they increased that trouble me! many are they that rise up against me.
- **Psalm 22:12 Many bulls have compassed me:** strong *bulls* of Bashan have beset me round.
- John 19:1-6 Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged him. And the **soldiers** platted a crown of thorns, and put *it* on his head, and they put on him a purple robe, And said, Hail, King of the Jews! and they smote him with their hands. Pilate therefore went forth again, and saith unto them, Behold, I bring him forth to you, that ye may know that I find no fault in him. Then came Jesus forth, wearing the crown of thorns, and the purple robe. And *Pilate* saith unto them, Behold the man! When **the chief priests** therefore and officers saw him, they cried out, saying, Crucify him, crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Take ye him, and crucify him: for I find no fault in him

CONQUERERS

- **Psalm 18:37-40** I have pursued mine enemies, and overtaken them: neither did I turn again till they were consumed. I have wounded them that they were not able to rise: they are fallen under my feet. For thou hast girded me with strength unto the battle: thou hast subdued under me those that rose up against me. Thou hast also given me the necks of mine enemies; that I might destroy them that hate me.
- **1 Corinthians 15:24-26** Then *cometh* the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy *that* shall be destroyed *is* death.

BETRAYED BY A FRIEND

- Psalm 41:9 Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, hath lifted up *his* heel against me.
- **2 Samuel 15:31** And *one* told David, saying, **Ahithophel** *is* **among the conspirators with Absalom**. And David said, O LORD, I pray thee, turn the counsel of Ahithophel into foolishness.
- John 13:18 | speak not of you all: | know whom | have chosen: but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me.
- John 13:21 When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me.

BETRAYERS HUNG THEMSELVES

- **2 Samuel 17:23** And when **Ahithophel** saw that his counsel was not followed, he saddled *his* ass, and arose, and gat him home to his house, to his city, and put his household in order, **and hanged himself, and died**, and was buried in the sepulchre of his father.
- Matthew 27:3-5 Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What *is that* to us? see thou *to that*. And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, **and went and hanged himself.**

BELOVED

- Hitchcock's Bible Names Dictionary -- David -- well-beloved, dear Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 1732. דָוָד David -- rarely (fully); Daviyd (daw-veed'); from the same as 1730; loving; David, the youngest son of Jesse:—David. See Hebrew 1730
- Psalm 17:8a Keep me as the apple of the eye ...
- **Psalm 89:20** I have found David my servant; with my holy oil have I anointed him: ... **Psalm 89:26-28** He shall cry unto me, **Thou** *art* **my father, my God**, and the rock of my salvation. **Also I will make him** *my* **firstborn, higher than the kings of the earth**. My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and my covenant shall stand fast with him.
- Matthew 3:17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

A MAN AFTER GOD'S HEART

1 Samuel 13:14 But now thy (Saul) kingdom shall not continue: **the LORD hath sought him a man after his own heart,** and the LORD hath commanded him *to be* captain over his people, **because thou hast not kept that which the LORD commanded thee.**

1 Kings 14:8 And rent the kingdom away from the house of David, and gave it thee (Jeroboam): and *yet* thou hast not been as my servant **David, who kept my commandments, and who followed me with all his heart, to do** *that* **only** *which was* **right in mine eyes;**

Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the *son* of Jesse, **a man after mine own heart, which shall** fulfil all my will.

OBEDIENT

- Psalm 119:11 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. ... Psalm 119:112 I have inclined mine heart to perform thy statutes alway, *even unto* the end.
- John 14:10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.
- **Psalm** 40:8-9 I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law *is* within my heart. I have preached righteousness in the great congregation: lo, I have not refrained my lips, O LORD, thou knowest.
- Hebrews 10:7 Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God.
- John 17:4 I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.

PURSUED BY LEADERS

- **1 Samuel 19:10-12** And Saul sought to smite David even to the wall with the javelin; but he slipped away out of Saul's presence, and he smote the javelin into the wall: and David fled, and escaped that night. Saul also sent messengers unto David's house, to watch him, and to slay him in the morning: and Michal David's wife told him, saying, If thou save not thy life to night, to morrow thou shalt be slain. So Michal let David down through a window: and he went, and fled, and escaped.
- **Mark 3:6** And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.

CONSECRATED BREAD

1 Samuel 21:5-6 And David answered the priest, and said unto him, Of a truth women *have been* kept from us about these three days, since I came out, and the vessels of the young men are holy, and *the bread is* in a manner common, yea, though it were sanctified this day in the vessel. So the priest gave him hallowed *bread*: for there was no bread there but the shewbread, that was taken from before the LORD, to put hot bread in the day when it was taken away.

Luke 22:19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake *it*, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

1 Corinthians 11:27-29 Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink *this* cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of *that* bread, and drink of *that* cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

OUSTED DEMON(S)

1 Samuel 16:23 And it came to pass, when the *evil* spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.

Matthew 8:3 And Jesus put forth *his* hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Matthew 8:16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with *his* word, and healed all that were sick:

DELIVERED FROM TOP ENEMY

1 Samuel 17:48-50 And it came to pass, when the Philistine arose, and came and drew nigh to meet David, **that David hasted, and ran toward the army to meet the Philistine.** And David put his hand in his bag, and took thence a stone, and slang *it*, and smote the Philistine in his forehead, that the stone sunk into his forehead; and he fell upon his face to the earth. **So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and with a stone,** and smote the Philistine, and slew him; but *there was* no sword in the hand of David.

Colossians 2:15 And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Revelation 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet *are,* and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

PROPHET

2 Samuel 23:2 The Spirit of the LORD spake by me, and his word *was* in my tongue.

Acts 2:29-31 Men *and* brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the **patriarch David**, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day. **Therefore being a prophet**, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne; He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.

Psalm 22:17-18 I may tell all my bones: they look *and* stare upon me. They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.

PROPHET

- Mark 14:8 She hath done what she could: she is come aforehand to anoint my body to the burying.
- John 2:18-21 Then answered the Jews and said unto him, What sign shewest thou unto us, seeing that thou doest these things? Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up. Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days? But he spake of the temple of his body.
- John 4:16-19 Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither. The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, Thou hast well said, I have no husband: For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly. The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet.

PRIEST

Psalm 110:4 The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou *art* a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.

2 Samuel 6:12-14 And it was told king David, saying, The LORD hath blessed the house of Obededom, and all that *pertaineth* unto him, because of the ark of God. So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obededom into the city of David with gladness. And it was *so*, that when they that bare the ark of the LORD had gone six paces, he sacrificed oxen and fatlings. And David danced before the LORD with all *his* might; and David *was* girded with a linen ephod.

Hebrews 2:17 Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto *his* brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things *pertaining* to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

Hebrews 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *our* profession.

ROYAL OF JUDAH

2 Samuel 2:4 And the men of Judah came, and there they anointed David king over the house of Judah. And they told David, saying, *That* the men of Jabeshgilead were they that buried Saul.

Revelation 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

Matthew 15:24 But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

KINGS

2 Samuel 5:3 So all the elders of Israel came to the king to Hebron; and king David made a league with them in Hebron before the LORD: and they anointed David king over Israel. John 18:37 Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.

Revelation 19:16 And he hath on *his* vesture and on his thigh a name written, **KING OF KINGS**, AND LORD OF LORDS.

KINGS

Acts 13:47-48 For so hath the Lord commanded us, *saying*, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth. And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed.

John 17:20 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;

Philippians 2:10-11 That at the name of Jesus **every knee should bow,** of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth; And *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

THRONE FOREVER

- 2 Samuel 7:16 And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever.
- **Revelation 21:22-24** And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it. And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb *is* the light thereof. And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.
- **Revelation 22:1-3** And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, *was there* the tree of life, which bare twelve *manner of* fruits, *and* yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree *were* for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him:

COMPASSION

1 Samuel 22:1-2 David therefore departed thence, and escaped to the cave Adullam: and when his brethren and all his father's house heard it, they went down thither to him. And every one *that was* in distress, and every one that was in debt, and every one that was discontented, gathered themselves unto him; and he became a captain over them: and there were with him about four hundred men.

John 6:37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.
