Revelation 12:11-12 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall **bruise Satan under your feet shortly.** The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

**James 4:7 Submit yourselves
therefore to God. Resist the
devil, and he will flee from you**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

1 Peter 5:8-9 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: **Whom resist stedfast in the faith,** knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

**1 John 4:4 Ye are of God,
little children, and have
overcome them: because
greater is he that is in you,
than he that is in the world.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Isaiah 41:10 Fear thou not; for I *am* with thee: be not dismayed; for I *am* thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

**2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath
not given us the spirit of fear;
but of power, and of love, and
of a sound mind.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

2 Corinthians 12:9-10 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. **Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Philippians 4:13 I can do
all things through Christ
which strengtheneth me.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

1 Corinthians 10:13-14 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God *is* faithful, **who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.** Wherefore, my dearly beloved, **flee from idolatry.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Romans 8:31 What shall we then say to these things? If God *be* for us, who *can be* against us?

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

John 3:16-17 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten **Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.** For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; **but that the world through him might be saved.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Colossians 1:13-14 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins:

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Psalm 103:10-12 He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him. As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Romans 10:9-10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, **thou shalt be saved.** For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Romans 5:8-11 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, **we shall be saved from wrath through him**. For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, **much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life**. And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by **whom we have now** received the atonement.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but **Christ liveth in me:** and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Matthew 7:21-23 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; **but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.** Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not **prophesied** in thy name? and in thy name have **cast out devils?** and in thy name done many **wonderful works?** And then will I profess unto them, **I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

James 1:22-25 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. But whoso looketh into **the perfect law of liberty**, and continueth *therein*, he being not a forgetful hearer, **but a doer of the work**, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Acts 5:32 And we are his witnesses of these things; and ***so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.***

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Romans 8:1-4 *There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.* For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: **That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

1 John 3:7-9 Little children, let no man deceive you: he that **doeth righteousness is righteous**, even as he is righteous. **He that committeth sin is of the devil**; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might **destroy the works of the devil**. Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Galatians 6:7-8 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: **for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.** For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; **but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

James 1:13-15 Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: **But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Matthew 16:26-27 For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul? For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then **he shall reward every man according to his works.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

**Micah 7:8 Rejoice not against me,
O mine enemy: **when I fall, I shall
arise; when I sit in darkness, the
LORD *shall be* a light unto me.****

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

**Philippians 1:6 Being
confident of this very thing,
that he which hath begun a
good work in you will perform
it until the day of Jesus Christ:**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Revelation 20:2-3 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and **bound him a thousand years**, And cast him into the bottomless pit, and **shut him up, and set a seal upon him**, that he should deceive the nations no more, **till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Revelation 20:10 **And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone**, where the beast and the false prophet *are*, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

2 Corinthians 11:13-15 For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. Therefore *it is* no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; **whose end shall be according to their works.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Matthew 25:41-46 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, **Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:** For I was an hungred, and ye gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me no drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not. Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee? Then shall he answer them, saying, **Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did *it* not to one of the least of these, ye did *it* not to me. And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

John 8:44 Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because **there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

James 2:19 Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

James 2:20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Ephesians 6:10-13 Finally, my brethren, **be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.** For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*. **Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.**

THE DEVIL TREMBLES

Ephesians 6:14-18 **Stand** therefore, having your loins girt about with **truth**, and having on the breastplate of **righteousness**; And your feet shod with the preparation of **the gospel of peace**; Above all, taking the shield of **faith**, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of **salvation**, and the sword of **the Spirit**, **which is the word of God**: **Praying always** with all prayer and **supplication in the Spirit**, and **watching** thereunto **with all perseverance and supplication for all saints**;
