

YEAR AFTER YEAR

Exodus 30:1

And thou shalt make an **altar** to burn incense upon: of shittim wood shalt thou make it.

Exodus 30:10

And Aaron shall make an **atonement upon the horns** of it **once in a year with the blood of the sin offering of atonements**: once in the year shall he make atonement upon it throughout your generations: it is most holy unto the LORD.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Leviticus 16:2

And the LORD said unto Moses, Speak unto Aaron thy brother, that he come not at all times into the holy place within the vail before the mercy seat, which is upon the ark; that he die not: **for I will appear in the cloud upon the mercy seat.**

Leviticus 16:18–19

And he shall go out unto **the altar** that is before the LORD, and make an atonement for it; and shall take of the blood of the bullock, and of the blood of the goat, and put it upon the horns of the altar round about. And he shall sprinkle of the blood upon it with his finger seven times, and **cleanse it**, and **hallow it** from the uncleanness of the children of Israel.

YEAR AFTER YEAR

Leviticus 23:26–32

And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Also on the tenth day of this seventh month there shall be **a day of atonement**: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD. And ye shall do no work in that same day: for **it is a day of atonement, to make an atonement for you before the LORD your God**. For whatsoever soul it be that shall not be afflicted in that same day, **he shall be cut off from among his people**. And whatsoever soul it be that doeth any work in that same day, the same soul will I **destroy from among his people**. Ye shall do no manner of work: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings. It shall be unto you a sabbath of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth day of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath.

YEAR AFTER YEAR

Leviticus 16:30

For **on that day** shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, that **ye may be clean from all your sins before the LORD.**

Leviticus 16:34

And this shall be an everlasting statute unto you, to make an **atonement for the children of Israel for all their sins once a year.** And he did as the LORD commanded Moses.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

2 Chronicles 29:24

And the priests killed them [*animals*], and they made **reconciliation with their blood** upon the altar, to make **an atonement for all Israel**: for the king commanded that the burnt offering and the sin offering should be made for all Israel.

Hebrews 10:4

For it is **not possible** that the blood of bulls and of **goats** should **take away sins**.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Genesis 4:4

And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his **offering**:

Job 1:5


And it was so, when the days of their feasting were gone about, that Job sent and sanctified them, and rose up early in the morning, **and offered burnt offerings** according to the number of them all: for Job said, It **may be that my sons have sinned**, and cursed God in their hearts.

Thus did Job continually.

YEAR AFTER YEAR

There are five main 'types' of Levitical sacrifices

- *The burnt offering*
 - (Leviticus 1; 6:8–13; 8:18-21; 16:24)
- *The grain offering*
 - (Leviticus 2; 6:14–23)
- *The peace offering*
 - (Leviticus 3; 7:11–34)
- *The sin offering*
 - (Leviticus 4; 5:1–13; 6:24–30; 8:14–17; 16:3–22)
- *The trespass offering*
 - (Leviticus 5:14–19; 6:1–7; 7:1–6)



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Leviticus 12:6 And when the **days of her purifying** are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring a lamb of the first year for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a turtledove, **for a sin offering**, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, unto the priest:

Numbers 19:11–12 He that **toucheth the dead body of any man** shall be unclean seven days. He shall purify himself with it on the third day, and on the seventh day **he shall be clean**: but if he purify not himself the third day, then the seventh day he shall not be clean.

YEAR AFTER YEAR

Leviticus 1:2–5

Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, If any man of you bring an offering unto the LORD, ... And **he shall** put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him. And **he shall kill the bullock before the LORD:** and the priests, Aaron's sons, shall bring the blood, and sprinkle the blood round about upon the altar that is by the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

2 Chronicles 7:4...7

Then the **king and all the people offered sacrifices before the LORD**. And king Solomon offered a sacrifice of **twenty and two thousand oxen**, and an hundred and **twenty thousand sheep**: so the king and all the people dedicated the house of God ... Moreover Solomon hallowed the middle of the court that was before the house of the LORD: for there he offered burnt offerings, and the fat of the peace offerings, because the brasen altar which Solomon had made **was not able to receive** the burnt offerings, and the meat offerings, and the fat.

YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 9:13

For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, **sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:**

1 Corinthians 15:50

Now this I say, brethren, that **flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God**; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

1 Peter 3:21

The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (**not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,**) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

Hebrews 9:14

How much more shall **the blood of Christ**, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, **purge your conscience** from dead works to **serve the living God?**

YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 8:1–2, 6

Now of the things which we have spoken **this is the sum**: We have such an high priest [*Jesus*], who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens; A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, **which the Lord pitched, and not man.**

6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, **by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.**

YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 10:1–4

For the law **having a shadow of good things to come**, and not the very image of the things, can **never with those sacrifices** which they offered **year by year continually** make the comers thereunto **perfect**. For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins. But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year. **For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.**



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Leviticus 16:12–13

And he shall take a censer full of burning coals of fire from off the altar before the LORD, and his hands full of sweet incense beaten small, and bring it **within the vail**: And he shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the testimony, **that he die not**:

Hebrews 4:16

Let us therefore **come boldly unto the throne of grace**, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 11:8–10

By faith **Abraham**, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: For **he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God.**



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 11:13–16

These **all** died in faith, **not having received the promises**, but **having seen them afar off**, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. For they that say such things **declare plainly** that they seek a country. And truly, if they had been mindful of that country from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned. But now **they desire a better country**, that is, **an heavenly**: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: **for he hath prepared for them a city**.

YEAR AFTER YEAR

John 10:27–28

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them **eternal life**; and they shall **never perish**, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

1 John 2:25

And this is the **promise** that he hath promised us, even **eternal life**.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

God made covenants with Abraham

People & Land (*if* the people obey)

Gen 15, 17, 22, Deut 28, 29, Joshua 23, 24


Very clear that this promise is conditional based on their obedience to the covenant, given at Sinai.

Disobedience of the people would cancel the agreement.

Eternal Life for 'whomsoever will' through Jesus Christ (no matter what, because he faithfully obeyed)

Genesis 22:18 And in thy seed [*Messiah*] shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

Nothing done afterward could cause it to be cancelled.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 9:1...9

Then verily the **first covenant** had also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary ... the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of God. But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people ... Which **was a figure for the time then present** ... that **could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience.**



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 9:10

Which stood only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed on them until the **time of reformation.**



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Galatians 3:21–22

Is the law then **against the promises of God**?
God forbid: for **if there had been a law given
which could have given life**, verily righteousness
should have been by the law. But the scripture
hath concluded **all under sin**, that **the promise
by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them
that believe.**



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hosea 6:6

For I desired **mercy**, and **not sacrifice**; and the **knowledge of God more than burnt offerings.**

1 Samuel 15:22

And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, **to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.**



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Psalm 51:16–19

For thou desirest **not** sacrifice; else would I give it: thou delightest **not** in burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise. Do good in thy good pleasure unto Zion: build thou the walls of Jerusalem. **Then shalt thou be pleased** with the sacrifices of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering: then shall they offer bullocks upon thine altar.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 10:19–22

Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, By **a new and living way**, which **he hath consecrated for us**, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; And having an high priest over the house of God; Let us **draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith**, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 10:23–26

Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (**for he is faithful that promised;**) And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Leviticus 7:26–27

Moreover ye shall eat no manner of blood, whether it be of fowl or of beast, in any of your dwellings. Whatsoever soul it be that eateth any manner of blood, even **that soul shall be cut off from his people.**

Numbers 15:30

But the soul that doeth ought presumptuously, whether he be born in the land, or a stranger, the same reproacheth the LORD; and **that soul shall be cut off from among his people.**

YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 10:28–31

He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: Of **how much sorer punishment**, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath **counted the blood of the covenant**, wherewith **he was sanctified**, an **unholy thing**, and hath done **despite unto the Spirit of grace**? For we know him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, **I will recompense**, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people. **It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.**

YEAR AFTER YEAR

Luke 12:4–5

And I say unto you **my friends**, Be not afraid of them that **kill the body**, and after that have no more that they can do. But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to **cast into hell**; yea, I say unto you, **Fear him**.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 10:35–39

Cast not away therefore **your confidence**, which hath **great recompence of reward**. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry. Now **the just shall live by faith**: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. **But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.**



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 13:8–15 [8-11]

Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. **Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines.** For it is a good thing that the **heart be established with grace**; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein. **We have an altar, whereof they have no right to eat which serve the tabernacle.** For the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Hebrews 13:8–15 [12-15]

Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate. **Let us go forth therefore unto him without the camp, bearing his reproach.** For here have we no continuing city, but we seek one to come. By him therefore let us **offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually**, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

John 6:39–40

And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have **everlasting life**: and I will raise him up at the last day.



YEAR AFTER YEAR

1 Corinthians 15:51–58 [51-54]

Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be **raised incorruptible**, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on **incorruption**, and this mortal must put on **immortality**. So when this corruptible shall have put on **incorruption**, and this mortal shall have put on **immortality**, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, **Death is swallowed up in victory.**

YEAR AFTER YEAR

1 Corinthians 15:51–58 [55-58]

O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. But **thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.** Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that **your labour is not in vain in the Lord.**



YEAR AFTER YEAR

Romans 5:8–11

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, **being reconciled**, we shall be saved by his life. And not only so, but we also **joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ**, by whom we have now **received the atonement**.


