

What prevents you from sharing your faith?

- Jesus Film Project's® Multigenerational Survey on Evangelism 2020 – 1600 Christians



A Lifeway Research survey titled "Evangelism Explosion Study of American Christians' Openness to Talking about Faith" is based on survey responses from 1,011 American Christians who were interviewed between April 12–23, 2020.

- The survey found that 54% of participants said they are either "willing" or "eager" when asked what they think about "telling others about Jesus Christ."
- However, 52% of Americans who identify as Christian believe that encouraging someone to change their religious beliefs is "offensive and disrespectful," and 66% of Christians are not familiar with any "methods for telling others about Jesus."
- Sixty-eight percent of respondents believe that "it is the responsibility of the pastor to equip the congregation to share the Gospel" and 69% agree that it's "the responsibility of Christians to encourage non-Christians to trust Christ as their savior."
- However, the survey revealed that 70% of Christians have not shared with a stranger how to become a Christian in the past six months.
- While 93% say they are "at least somewhat open to having a conversation about faith with a friend," only 52% "shared a story in the last six months about what God has done in their life with a friend or family member who was not a Christian."
- And 62% say they have not "shared with a friend or family member how to become a Christian in the past six months."

It is not ...


- Judaism (or any other ism).
- Cultural transformation.
- traditions of men and standards of outward appearance.
- a moral revolution or a resolution to do better.
- Knowing and quoting scripture verses.
- Going to assembly/church weekly.
- preaching against Sunday and for the sabbath day.
- preaching about the Holydays
- Praying and singing hymns.

It is not ...

- Preaching against the pagan origins of the trappings of Christmas or Easter.
- if the good you did in your life outweighs the bad you did.
- nice-sounding stories, or personal experiences (although your personal salvation experience may add an angle of view to the True Gospel preached prior).
- therapy for a human malady
- not the universal removal of judgment.

Use Correspondence Courses...(online or paper)

- Eliminates most challenges of evangelism non-confrontive.
- Those that sign on can teach themselves.
- Questions can be answered at your leisure (e-mailbag).
- People given opportunity to make a decision in their own time.

Use Direct Mail...

- You can target a specific audience.
- Everyone glances at their mail.
- Non-intrusive, non-confrontational.




















PARTING REMINDER
