

Happy Man

PSALMS = Strong's Greek Dictionary 5568.

ψαλμος **psalmos** *psal-mos*' from 5567; a set piece of music, i.e. a sacred ode (accompanied with the voice, harp or other instrument; a "psalm"); collectively, the book of the Psalms:—psalm.

THIS COMPILATION OF PSALMS IN THE HEBREW IS CALLED "TEHILLAH" **Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 8416.** תְּהִלָּה *t@hillah teh-hil-law*' from 1984; **laudation; specifically (concretely) a hymn:—praise.**

Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 4210. מִזְמוֹר *mizmowr*

miz-more' from 2167; properly, instrumental music; by implication, a poem set to notes:—psalm. Every one of these is from the introductions such as "A Psalm of David"

Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 2172. זִמְרָה *zimrah zim-raw*' from 2167; a musical piece or song to be accompanied by an instrument:—melody, psalm.

Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 2167. זָמַר *zamar zaw-mar*' a primitive root (perhaps ident. with 2168 through the idea of striking with the fingers); properly, to touch the strings or parts of a musical instrument, i.e. play upon it; to make music, accompanied by the voice; hence to celebrate in song and music:—give praise, sing forth praises, psalms.

Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 2158. זָמִיר *zamiyr zaw-meer*' or *zamir* (*zaw-meer*); and (feminine) *zmirah* (*zem-ee-raw*); from 2167; a song to be accompanied with instrumental music:—psalm(-ist), singing, song.

Strong's Greek Dictionary 5568. ψαλμος *psalmos psal-mos*' from 5567; a set piece of music, i.e. a sacred ode (accompanied with the voice, harp or other instrument; a "psalm"); collectively, the book of the Psalms:—psalm.

Strong's Greek Dictionary 5567. ψαλλω *psallo psal'-lo* probably strengthened from *psao* (to rub or touch the surface; compare 5597); to twitch or twang, i.e. to play on a stringed instrument (celebrate the divine worship with music and accompanying odes):—make melody, sing (psalms).

Psalms 1:4-6 The ungodly *are* not so: but *are* like the chaff which the wind driveth away. Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Psalm 1:1 **Blessed is the man** that walketh

BLESSED/HAPPY = Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 835. ' **אֵשֶׁר** *esher eh'-sher* from 833; **happiness**; only in masculine plural construction **as interjection, how happy!:**—blessed, happy.

Happy Man

Psalm 1:1-2 Blessed *is* the man **that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.** But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

- **Walketh** – to go along; to walk with
- **Counsel** – advice; purpose
- **Ungodly** – guilty of sin (against God or man)

COUNSEL = Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 6098. **עֵצָה** `etsah *ay-tsaw*' from 3289; advice; by implication, plan; also prudence:—advice, advisement, counsel(l-(or)), purpose.

UNGODLY = Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 7563. **רָשָׁע** rasha *raw-shaw*' from 7561; morally wrong; concretely, an (actively) bad person:—+ condemned, guilty, ungodly, wicked (man), that did wrong.



Happy Man

Psalm 64:2 Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity:

Psalm 64:5 They encourage themselves *in* an evil matter: they commune of laying snares privily; they say, Who shall see them?

Psalm 33:10 The LORD bringeth the counsel of the heathen to nought: he maketh the devices of the people of none effect.



Happy Man

Psalm 1:2b ... nor standeth in the way of sinners,

Job 21:14-16 Therefore they say unto God,
Depart from us; for we desire not the
knowledge of thy ways. What *is* the
Almighty, that we should serve him? and
what profit should we have, if we pray unto
him? Lo, their good *is* not in their hand: the
counsel of the wicked is far from me.



Happy Man

Psalms 1:2b ... nor standeth in the way of sinners,

Proverbs 1:15 My son, walk not thou in the way with them [*sinner*s]; refrain thy foot from their path:

Proverbs 4:14 Enter not into the path of the wicked, and go not in the way of evil *men*.

Proverbs 13:20 He that walketh with wise *men* shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.



Happy Man

Psalms 1:2b ... nor standeth in the way of sinners,

1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners .

- **COMMUNICATIONS** = Strong's Greek Dictionary 3656. **ομιλεω homileo** *hom-il-eh'-o* from 3658; **to be in company with**, i.e. (by implication) to converse:—commune, talk.
- **MANNERS** = Strong's Greek Dictionary 2239. **ηθος ethos** *ay'-thos* a strengthened form of 1485; usage, i.e. (plural) **moral habits**:—manners.



Happy Man

Psalms 1:2c ... **nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.**

SCORNFUL = Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 3887. לִּוְטַס *luwts loots* a primitive root; properly, **to make mouths at**, i.e. **to scoff**; hence (from the effort to pronounce a foreign language) **to interpret, or (generally) intercede**:—ambassador, **have in derision**, interpreter, **make a mock, mocker, scorn**(-er, -ful), teache

Jeremiah 15:17 I sat not in the assembly of the mockers,
nor rejoiced; I sat alone because of thy hand: for thou
hast filled me with indignation.

Proverbs 14:9 Fools make a mock at sin: but among the
righteous *there is* favour.

Proverbs 15:12 A scorner loveth not one that reproveth
him: neither will he go unto the wise.



Happy Man

Psalm 1:2 But his **delight *is* in the law of the LORD;
and in his law doth he meditate day and night.**

DELIGHT = Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 2656. **כֶּפֶת chephets *khay'-fets* from 2654; **pleasure**; hence (abstractly) **desire; concretely, a valuable thing**; hence (by extension) a matter (as something in mind):—**acceptable, delight(-some), desire, things desired, matter, pleasant(-ure), purpose, willingly.****

Psalm 119:24 Thy testimonies also *are* my
delight *and* my counsellors.



Happy Man

Psalm 119:16 I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget thy word.

Psalm 119:35 Make me to go in the path of thy commandments; **for therein do I delight.**

Psalm 40:8 I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law *is* within my heart.

Psalm 119:47 And I will delight myself in thy commandments, which I have loved.



Happy Man

Psalm 119:70 Their heart is as fat as grease; *but* I delight in thy law.

Psalm 119:77 Let thy tender mercies come unto me, that I may live: **for thy law *is* my delight.**

Psalm 119:92 Unless thy law *had been* my delights, I should then have perished in mine affliction.

Psalm 119:143 Trouble and anguish have taken hold on me: *yet* thy commandments *are* my delights.



Happy Man

Psalms 119:174 I have longed for thy salvation, O LORD; and **thy law *is* my delight.**

Romans 7:22 For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

Jeremiah 15:16 Thy words were found, and I did eat them; **and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart:** for I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts.

Psalm 1:2 But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD;
and in his law doth he meditate day and night

Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 1897. הָגָה *hagah*
daw-gaw' a primitive root (compare 1901); to
murmur (in pleasure or anger); by implication, to
ponder:—imagine, meditate, mourn, mutter, roar, X
sore, speak, study, talk, utter



Happy Man

Psalms 1:2b ... **and in his law doth he meditate day and night**

Joshua 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but **thou shalt meditate therein day and night**, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: **for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.**

Psalms 119:147-148 I prevented the dawning of the morning, and cried: I hoped in thy word. Mine eyes prevent the *night* watches, that I might meditate in thy word.



Happy Man

Psalm 1:3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Psalm 92:12-14 The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God. They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing;



Happy Man

Psalm 1:4 The ungodly *are* not so: but *are* like the chaff which the wind driveth away.

Job 21:17-18 How oft is the candle of the wicked put out! and *how oft* cometh their destruction upon them! *God* distributeth sorrows in his anger. They are as stubble before the wind, and as chaff that the storm carrieth away.

Matthew 3:12 Whose fan *is* in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will **burn up the chaff** with unquenchable fire.



Happy Man

Psalm 1:5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

Romans 14:10-12 But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? **for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.** For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God. **So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.**



Happy Man

- **Psalms 73:27** For, lo, they that are far from thee shall **perish**: thou hast **destroyed** all them that go a whoring from thee
- **Matthew 7:13** Enter ye in at the strait gate: **for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction**, and many there be which go in thereat: **14** Because strait *is* the gate, and narrow *is* the way, which leadeth unto life, **and few there be that find it.**
- **Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin *is* death; but the gift of God *is* eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.



Happy Man

2 Thessalonians 1:8-9 In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with **everlasting destruction** from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;

- **John 3:36** He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.
- **1 John 5:12** He that hath the Son hath life; *and* he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. **John 5:29** And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and **they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.**

Psalm 1:6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

**Proverbs 12:7 The wicked are
overthrown, and *are* not: but the
house of the righteous shall stand**



Happy Man

Psalm 1:6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Revelation 20:12-15 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and **they were judged every man according to their works.** And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. **This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.**
