JOHN 6:66 FROM THAT TIME MANY OF HIS DISCIPLES WENT BACK, AND WALKED NO MORE WITH HIM.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

1 John 2:18-19 Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time. **They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would *no doubt* have continued with us: but *they went out*, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

John 6:60-62 Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard *this*, said, **This is an hard saying; who can hear it?** When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, **Doth this offend you? What** and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before?

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

John 6:63-65 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, *they* are spirit, and *they* are life. **But there are some of you that believe not.** For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that **believed not**, and who should betray him. And he said, **Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.**

**JOHN 6:66-67 FROM THAT TIME MANY OF HIS

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.**

Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, **All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide *is* the gate, and broad *is* the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: **Matthew 7:14** Because strait *is* the gate, and narrow *is* the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

2 Thessalonians 2:10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not **the love of the truth**, that they might be saved.

Revelation 21:8 But the fearful, and **unbelieving**, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, **Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**

Luke 5:32 **I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.**

**Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and
come short of the glory of God**

**Luke 13:3 I tell you, Nay: but, except ye
repent, ye shall all likewise perish.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

John 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

1 Peter 2:8-9 And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, *even to them* which stumble at the word, being disobedient:

whereunto also they were appointed. But ye *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

1 Corinthians 1:23-24 But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 26:31-33 Then saith Jesus unto them, **All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad. But after I am risen again, I will go before you into Galilee.** Peter answered and said unto him, Though all *men* shall be offended because of thee, yet will I never be offended. **Matthew 26:56** But all this was done, that the scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled. **Then all the disciples forsook him, and fled.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 26:69-71 Now Peter sat without in the palace: and a damsel came unto him, saying, Thou also wast with Jesus of Galilee. **But he denied before *them* all, saying, I know not what thou sayest.** And when he was gone out into the porch, another *maid* saw him, and said unto them that were there, This *fellow* was also with Jesus of Nazareth. **Matthew 26:72-75** And **again he denied with an oath, I do not know the man.** And after a while came unto *him* they that stood by, and said to Peter, Surely thou also art *one* of them; for thy speech bewrayeth thee. Then began **he to curse and to swear, saying, I know not the man.** And immediately the cock crew. And Peter remembered the word of Jesus, which said unto him, Before the cock crow, **thou shalt deny me thrice. And he went out, and wept bitterly.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 10:28 And **fear not** them which kill the body, but are **not** able to kill the soul: **but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.**

Matthew 10:31 Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 10:34-36 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. **And a man's foes *shall be* they of his own household.**

Matthew 10:37-39 He that loveth father or mother **more than me is not worthy of me:** and he that loveth son or daughter **more than me is not worthy of me.** And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

OTHER FEARS & PHOBIAS

- FEAR OF CHANGE AND THE UNKNOWN
- FEAR OF SURRENDER AND CONTROL
- FEAR OF REJECTION AND ISOLATION
- FEAR OF CONDEMNATION AND GUILT

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 6:24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Revelation 13:16-17 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Revelation 2:10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast *some* of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Hebrews 10:32-36 But call to remembrance the former days, in which, after ye were illuminated, ye endured a great fight of afflictions; Partly, whilst ye were made a gazingstock both by reproaches and afflictions; and partly, whilst ye became companions of them that were so used. For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance. Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

1 John 4:18-19 There is no fear in love; **but perfect love casteth out fear:** because fear hath torment.

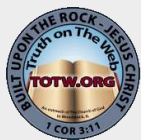
He that feareth is not made perfect in love. **We love him, because he first loved us.**

Isaiah 41:10 Fear thou not; for I *am* with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

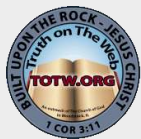
2 Timothy 4:10 For Demas hath **forsaken me**, having **loved this present world**, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia.

Romans 12:1-2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, *which is* your reasonable service. And **be not conformed to this world**: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

1 John 2:15-17 Love not the world, neither the things *that are* in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. **And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof:** but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Mark 4:18-19 And these are they which are sown

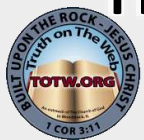
among thorns; such as hear the word, And **the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things** entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.

2 Thessalonians 2:11-12 And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: That they all might **be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.**



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Romans 13:11-14 And that, knowing the time, that now *it* is high time to awake out of sleep: for now *is* our salvation nearer than when we believed. The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying. But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to *fulfil* the lusts *thereof*.



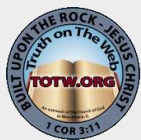
WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Colossians 3:1-2 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are **above**, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. **Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.**

Mark 8:36 **For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Acts 28:23-25 And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into *his* lodging; to whom he expounded and testified the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses, and *out of* the prophets, from morning till evening. And some believed the things which were spoken, and some believed not. And when they agreed not among themselves, they departed, after that Paul had spoken one word, Well spake the Holy Ghost by Esaias the prophet unto our fathers,



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Acts 28:26-29 Saying, Go unto this people, and say, Hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and not perceive: For the heart of this people is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes have they closed; lest they should see with *their* eyes, and hear with *their* ears, and understand with *their* heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them. Be it known therefore unto you, that the salvation of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and *that* they will hear it. And when he had said these words, the Jews departed, and had great reasoning among themselves.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Hebrews 3:7-8 Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice, **Harden not your hearts**, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness:

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Acts 28:24 And some believed the things which were spoken, and some believed not.

Hebrews 3:12-13 Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Acts 13:44-46 And the next sabbath day came almost the whole city together **to hear the word of God.** But when the Jews saw the multitudes, **they were filled with envy, and spake against those things which were spoken by Paul, contradicting and blaspheming.** Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: **but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles.**



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

1 Timothy 4:1-2 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times **some shall depart from the faith**, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

1 Thessalonians 5:1-3 But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you. For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night. For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.

2 Peter 3:9 **The Lord is not slack concerning his promise**, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Hebrews 3:19 So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and **upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart,** because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Ephesians 4:18-19 Having **the understanding darkened**, being **alienated** from the life of God through **the ignorance** that is in them, because of **the blindness of their heart: Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness**, to work all uncleanness with greediness.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Acts 16:14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard *us*: **whose heart the Lord opened,** that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.

Ezekiel 36:26-27 **A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you:** and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. **And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do *them*.**



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Proverbs 28:14 Happy *is* the man that feareth
always: but he that hardeneth his heart shall
fall into mischief.

Proverbs 4:23 Keep thy heart with all
diligence; for out of it *are* the issues of life.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Peter 2:1-2 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of.

2 Timothy 4:3-4 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away *their* ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Colossians 2:8-10 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. **And ye are complete in him,** which is the head of all principality and power:

1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Jude 3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort *you* that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

2 Timothy 4:7-8 I have fought a good fight, I have finished *my course*, I have kept the faith: Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 16:24-25 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, **If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.** For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 19:16-19 And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, **what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?** And he said unto him, **Why callest thou me good? *there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.*** He saith unto him, **Which?** Jesus said, **Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and *thy* mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 19:20-22 The young man saith unto him, All these things have I kept from my youth up: what lack I yet? **Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go *and* sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come *and* follow me.** But when the young man heard that saying, **he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions.**

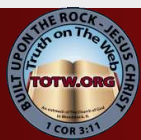
WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Matthew 19:23-26 Then said Jesus unto his disciples,

Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven. And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.

When his disciples heard *it*, they were exceedingly amazed, saying, Who then can be saved? **But Jesus**

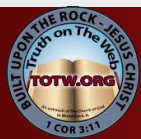
beheld *them*, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Luke 14:25-27 And there went great multitudes with him: and he turned, and said unto them, **If any *man* come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple. And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.**

Luke 9:23 And he said to *them* all, **If any *man* will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.**



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

1 Timothy 6:17-19 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they **be not highminded, nor trust in**

uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy; That they do good, that they

be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate; Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, **that they may lay hold on eternal life.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Luke 9:57-59 And it came to pass, that, as they went in the way, a certain *man* said unto him, **Lord, I will follow thee whithersoever thou goest.** And Jesus said unto him, **Foxes have holes, and birds of the air *have* nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay *his* head.** And he said unto another, **Follow me.** But he said, **Lord, suffer me first to go and bury my father.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Luke 9:60-62 Jesus said unto him, **Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God.** And another also said, **Lord, I will follow thee; but let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house.** And Jesus said unto him, **No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Mark 8:34-35 And when he had called the people *unto him* with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.

Galatians 2:20 **I am crucified with Christ:** nevertheless I live; yet not I, **but Christ liveth in me:** and the life which I now live in the flesh I live **by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Galatians 6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

2 Thessalonians 3:13 But ye, brethren, be not weary in well doing.

1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Hebrews 12:3 For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, **lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.**

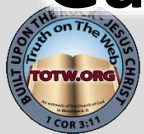
Revelation 2:3 **And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted.**

1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, **be ye steadfast, unmoveable**, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as **ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.**

WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

2 Peter 2:20-22 For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning. For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, **than, after they have known *it*, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.** But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog *is* turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.

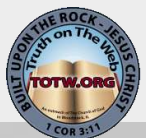
Galatians 6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Psalm 13:1-2 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. **How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me? How long shall I take counsel in my soul, *having* sorrow in my heart daily? how long shall mine enemy be exalted over me?**

2 Corinthians 12:9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: **for my strength is made perfect in weakness.** Most gladly **therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities**, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Hebrews 12:3-4 For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, **lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.**

Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin.

Matthew 11:28-30 **Come unto me**, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and **I will give you rest.** Take my yoke upon you, and **learn of me;** for I am meek and lowly in heart: and **ye shall find rest** unto your souls. **For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.**

Isaiah 40:31 But they that **wait upon the LORD** shall **renew their strength;** they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, **and not be weary;** *and* they shall walk, **and not faint.**



WILL YOU ALSO GO AWAY?

Hebrews 10:35-37. Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry.

Hebrews 10:38-39 Now the just shall live by faith: but if *any man* draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.
