



Revelation 3:14

Revelation 3:15-16

I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.



Revelation 2:4-5

Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast **left thy first love**. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and **will remove thy candlestick out of his place**, except thou repent.



Revelation 3:2-3

 - (Mt 10:32, Mark 10:28-30, Lk 9:62, Heb 3:14)
