

### THE PEACEMAKER When the

'power of love' overcomes the 'love of power' the world will know peace.

Matthew 5:9, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called the children of God."

THE PEACEMAKER Isaiah 59:2 But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. Psalm 39:8 Deliver me from all my transgressions: make me not the reproach of the foolish.

#### THE PEACEMAKER Proverbs 28:13 He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy. 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

#### THE PEACEMAKER **Matthew 3:8 Bring** forth therefore fruits meet for repentance: Psalm 34:14 Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it.

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

2 Corinthians 5:19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

1 Peter 3:11 Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it.

Romans 12:18 If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.

Matthew 18:21-22 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times? Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.

#### THE PEACEMAKER Hebrews 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

THE PEACEMAKER Philippians 2:3-4 Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

Philippians 4:4-7 Rejoice in the Lord alway: and again I say, Rejoice. Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand. Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Colossians 3:12-13 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.

#### THE PEACEMAKER NLT-1 Corinthians 13:4-8

KJV - 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.

<sup>4</sup> Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud <sup>5</sup> or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged. <sup>6</sup> It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. <sup>7</sup> Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.

Matthew 18:15-17 Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother. But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established. And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell it unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican.

Romans 14:19 Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another.



#### Proverbs 3:5 -**Trust in the LORD** with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

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Jeremiah 17: <sup>5</sup> Thus saith the LORD; Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD. ... <sup>7</sup> Blessed *is* the man **that** trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.



Isaiah 41:10 Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

#### Peacekeeper

#### Peacemaker

Peacekeepers operate under the authority and power of the law. (In contrast, see Jesus' approach in Ephesians 2:15.)

Peacekeepers react strongly to the threat of emerging conflict.

Peacekeepers try to keep society from getting worse.

Peacekeepers fear the consequences of a failure to maintain balance.

Peacekeepers sacrifice righteousness for the sake of peace.

Peacekeepers view compromise as one of the greatest virtues.

Peacemakers operate in the authority of wisdom and in the power of love. (James 3:17, James 2:16)

> Peacemakers have high hopes. (Romans:15:13)

Peacemakers walk in humility. (1 Peter 3:8)

Peacemakers understand that repentance is necessary for true peace to be created. (Hebrews 12:14, 1 Peter 3:11)

Peacemakers are creative and sacrificial in their process. (Ephesians 2:14-16)

Peacemakers celebrate small victories. (2 Corinthians 13:11, Luke 15:7)

**OVE 1 Peter 4:8** And above all things have fervent **charity (love)** among yourselves: for **charity (love)** shall cover the multitude of sins.

**PEACE** Isaiah 26:3 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.



Proverbs 12:20 Deceit *is* in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counsellers of peace *is* joy<sub>\*</sub>

James 3:13-15 Who *is* a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom. But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This wisdom descendeth not from above, but *is* earthly, sensual, devilish.

James 3:16-17 For where envying and strife *is*, there *is* confusion and every evil work. But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, *and* easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. James 3:18 And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.

## **1.Pray help and wisdom from above**

Matthew 7:3-5 And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Or how wilt thou say to thy brother, Let me pull out the mote out of thine eye; and, behold, a beam *is* in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

Psalm 139:23-24 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: And see if *there be any* wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Colossians 1:9 For this cause we also, since the day we heard *it*, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; 27

THE PEACEMAKER 2. Slow down and lower your voice Proverbs 15:1 A soft answer turneth away wrath: but LY AND TRUT grievous words stir up anger.

Proverbs 29:11 A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise man keepeth it in till afterwards.

THE PEACEMAKER 3. Listen more than you talk James 1:19-20 Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath: For the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God. Proverbs 13:10 Only by pride cometh contention: but with Ynii'i i stiim II TY SRINCS HARMON the well advised is wisdom.

#### 4. Choose your words wisely



Colossians 4:6 Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.

Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

Proverbs 12:18 There is that speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but the tongue of the wise is health.

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1. Take the Initiative



Matthew 5:23-24 Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee; Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.

**2 Timothy 1:7** For **God hath not given us the spirit of fear;** but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

# 2. Meet Face-to-Face

Exodus 33:11 And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend. And he turned again into the camp: but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.

Matthew 18:15 Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother.

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3. Take Responsibility

Matthew 7:5 Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt It starts with You thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

1 Timothy 1:15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

 3. Minister Reconciliation in Love
 Philippians 2:4-5 Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others. Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

**Ephesians 4:15** But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, *even* Christ:

**1 John 3:18** My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth<sup>3</sup>.

1 John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of
God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we
shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.
3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

Revelation 21:7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.
