The <u>feeling</u> that what is wanted <u>can be had</u> or that events will turn out for the best:

A person or thing in which expectations are centered: The medicine was <u>her last hope</u>.

Hope (Websters 1828)

Confidence in a future event; the highest degree of well-founded **expectation of good**; as a hope founded on God's gracious promises;



Unfailing hope is found in God alone.

Psalm 28:7–8

The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise him. The LORD is their strength, and he is the saving strength of his anointed.

Psalm 33:20-22

Faithful perseverance strengthens hope.

Romans 5:3-5

Titus 3:4–7

But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the **hope of eternal life**.



The offer of Hope isn't just for the lost
