

DEFINITION "temptation"

1: the wish to do or have something that you know you should not do or have: something that makes you want to do or have something that you know you should not: i.e. He knew it was wrong to steal, but the money just lying there was too great a temptation.

2: the act of tempting; enticement or allurement.

3: something that tempts, entices, or allures.

First recorded in 1175–1225; Middle English temptacion, from Latin temptātiōn- (stem of temptātiō) "a testing"; see tempt, -ation

A temptation, then, in general is anything that, for any reason, exerts a force or influence to seduce and draw the mind and heart of a person from the obedience which God requires of them to any kind of sin.



Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation (peirasmos): the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

TEMPTATION (some versions say 'trials') Strong's Greek Dictionary 3986. πειρασμος peirasmos *pi-rasmos'* from 3985; a putting to proof (by experiment (of good), experience (of evil), solicitation, discipline or provocation); by implication, adversity:—temptation, X try.



TRIAL/TRYING = Strong's Greek Dictionary 1383. δοκιμιον dokimion dok-im'-ee-on; a testing; by implication, trustworthiness:—trial, trying.

James 1:2-3 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations (peirasmos); Knowing this, that the trying (dokimion) of your faith worketh patience.





1 Peter 1:6-7 Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations (peirasmos): That the trial (dokimion) of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:





Hebrews 4:14-16 Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.



Finding Strength in God's Promises

James 1:12 Blessed *is* the man that **endureth temptation**: for **when he is tried**, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.

Philippians 4:6-7 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Psalm 23:4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.





Consider the Promise

1 Corinthians 10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear (endure) it.

 - 1) No uncommon temptations.
 - 2) No temptation beyond your ability in Christ.
 - 3) Always a way to escape or endure.





NO UNCOMMON TEMPTATION

Genesis 3:1-3 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.



Matthew 4:3-4 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. But he answered and s, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. 13



EVE: God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.

JESUS: "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God." It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God."

"Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve."

1 John 2:15-17 Love not the world, neither the things *that are* in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.





Ezekiel 18:20-22 The soul that sinneth, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him. But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die. All his transgressions that he hath committed, they shall not be mentioned unto him: in his righteousness that he hath done he shall live.

The Lord replied, "The times when you have seen only one set of footprints, is when I carried you."







Proverbs 16:9 A man's heart deviseth his way: but the LORD directeth his steps.


Luke 1:79 To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.
