2 Timothy 2:15–16

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. But **shun profane and vain babblings**: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.

2 Timothy 2:19

Deuteronomy 6:4

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is **one LORD**:

Zechariah 14:9

And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be **one LORD**, and **his name one**.



Leviticus 24:16

And he that **blasphemeth the name of the LORD**, he shall surely be put to death, and all the congregation shall certainly **stone him**: as well the stranger, as he that is born in the land, when **he blasphemeth the name of the LORD**, **shall be put to death**.

Exodus 20:2–3

I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

"They were in the habit of meeting on a certain fixed day before it was light, when they sang in alternate verses **a hymn to Christ, as to a god**, and bound themselves by a solemn oath, not to any wicked deeds, but never to commit any fraud, theft or adultery, never to falsify their word, nor deny a trust when they should be called upon to deliver it up..."


Pliny the Younger in his letter to Emperor Trajan, 112 AD



"...there was an old decree that no god should be consecrated by the emperor till first approved by the senate. ...Tiberius accordingly, in whose days the Christian name made its entry into the world, having himself received intelligence from Palestine of events which had clearly shown the truth of Christ's divinity, brought the matter before the senate, with his own decision in favour of Christ. The senate, because it had not given the approval itself, rejected his proposal. Cæsar held to his opinion, threatening wrath against all accusers of the Christians. Consult your histories; you will there find that Nero was the first who assailed with the imperial sword the Christian sect, making progress then especially at Rome."

Tertullian, Apology chapter 5

"Great stress is to be placed on the fact that Tertullian was probably a jurisconsult, familiar with the Roman archives, and influenced by them in his own acceptance of Divine Truth. It is not supposable that such a man would have hazarded his bold appeal to the records, in remonstrating with the Senate and in the very faces of the Emperor and his colleagues, had he not known that the evidence was irrefragable."

Now may the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the eternal high priest himself, the **Son of God Jesus Christ**, build you up in faith and truth...and to us with you, and to all those under heaven who will yet **believe in our Lord and God Jesus Christ** and in his Father who raised him from the dead.

Polycarp (AD 69-155), Philippians, 12:2

Permit me first to recount the prophecies, which I wish to do in order to prove that <mark>Christ</mark> is called both God and Lord of hosts.

Philippians 2:9–11

Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That **at the name of Jesus <u>every knee</u> should bow**, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that **every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord**, to the glory of God the Father.

I and my Father are <u>one</u>. Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him. Jesus answered them, Many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me? The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God.



Mark 2:5-7

When **Jesus** saw their faith, he **said** unto the sick of the palsy, Son, **thy sins be forgiven thee**. But there were certain of the scribes sitting there, and reasoning in their hearts, Why doth this man thus speak <u>blasphemies</u>? who can forgive sins but God only?



John 8:58–59

Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am. Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

Exodus 3:14

And God said unto Moses, **I AM** THAT **I AM**: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, **I AM** hath sent me unto you.



John 10:7–9

Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep. All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them. I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

John 14:6

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

John 14:9

Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?

1 John 2:23

Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.



THE SON OF GOD



Daniel 3:25

He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the **Son of God**.

Daniel 3:28a

Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his **angel**



Luke 3:38

Which was *the son* of Enos, which was *the son* of Seth, which was *the son* of <u>Adam, which was</u> <u>the son</u> of <u>God</u>.

Luke 1:35

And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also **that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God**.



John 10:36–39

Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, **Thou blasphemest**; because I said, I am the Son of God? If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not. But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him. Therefore they sought again to take him: but he escaped out of their hand,

Matthew 4:3

And when the <u>tempter</u> came to him, he said, **If thou be the Son of God**, command that these stones be made bread.

Matthew 4:6a

And saith unto him, **If thou be the** Son of God, cast thyself down:

Luke 4:41

And <u>devils</u> also came out of many, crying out, and saying, **Thou art Christ the Son of God**. And he rebuking them suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.

Mark 15:37–39

And Jesus cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost. And the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom. And when the centurion, which stood over against him, saw that he so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this man was the Son of God.

[John the Baptist - John 1:6-7,29,34]



John 1:49

Nathanael answered and saith unto him, Rabbi, thou art the <mark>Son of God</mark>; thou art the King of Israel.

Matthew 14:27, 32-33

But straightway **Jesus spake unto them**, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.

14:32–33 And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased. Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the **Son of God**.

John 11:25–27

Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this? She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.



Luke 22:67-71

Art thou the Christ? tell us. And he said unto them, If I tell you, ye will not believe: And if I also ask you, ye will not answer me, nor let me go. Hereafter shall the Son of man sit on the right hand of the power of God. Then said they all, Art thou then the Son of God? And he said unto them, **Ye say that I am**. And they said, What need we any further witness? for we ourselves have heard of his own mouth.

[Matthew 26:63-66]



John 9:35–38

Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the **Son of God**? He answered and said, Who is he, Lord, that I might believe on him? And Jesus said unto him, Thou hast both seen him, and it is he that talketh with thee. And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.

Do all aspects of the human father/son relationship apply to the relationship between The Father and Jesus?

Examples – aspects that do NOT apply

- A human father is always older than the son.
- A human son waits for the death of his father to receive his inheritance.

Examples – aspects that apply

- A close, loving, deep bond.
- Son's reverence, obedience to The Father.

Romans 8:14

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, **they** are the sons of God.

1 John 3:2

Beloved, **now are we the sons of God**, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

Other places – 'sons of God'

John 1:12, Romans 8:19, Philippians 2:15, 1 John 3:1

John 3:18

He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not **believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God**.

John 5:25

Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.
