A survey of Titus 2:11-14





...we are to make a twofold use of the Word of God: as both bread and weapon; for feeding and for resisting; in peace and in war. With one hand we must build, improve, teach and feed all Christendom; with the other, oppose the devil, the heretics, the world. For where the pasture is not defended, the devil will soon destroy it; he is bitterly opposed to God's Word. Let us then, God granting us his grace, so handle the Gospel that not only shall the souls of men be fed, but men shall learn to put on that Gospel as armor and fight their enemies. Thus shall it furnish both pasture and weapons.

Titus 2:11

For the **grace** [G5485] **of God** that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

G5485 - χάρις cháris, khar'-ece;

Graciousness (as gratifying), of manner or act: — acceptable, benefit, favour, gift, grace(- ious), joy, liberality, pleasure, thank(-s, -worthy).



Genesis 6:8

But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.

Teaching^[G3811] us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world.

G3811 - παιδεύω paideúō, pahee-dyoo'-o;
To train up a child, i.e. educate, or (by implication), discipline (by punishment):—chasten(-ise), instruct, learn, teach.



Hebrews 8:11

And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: **for all shall know me**, from the least to the greatest.

1 John 2:27

But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

Titus 2:12

Teaching us that, **denying** [G720] ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world.

G720 - ἀρνέομαι arnéomai, ar-neh'-o-mai; to contradict, i.e. disavow, reject, abnegate:—deny, refuse.



Genesis 39:12

And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.

Matthew 2:13

And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and **flee into Egypt**, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him.

And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, Being forty days tempted of the devil. G4993; moderate:—be in right mind, be sober (minded), soberly.

G4996; with sound mind, i.e. moderately:—soberly.

G4998; safe (sound) in mind, i.e. self-controlled (moderate as to opinion or passion):—discreet, sober, temperate.

G49825 & G5424; understanding, to heal or have



Ecclesiastes 5:6
