








1 Corinthians 13:13

KJV: For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.






1 Peter 1:21


1 Thessalonians 4:9






Matthew 22:36–38


Romans 5:8

My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; **but in deed and in truth**.






John 14:23–24



Be not deceived; **God is not mocked**: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.






1 John 5:2–3

By this we know **that we love the children of God, when we love God**, and keep his commandments. For this is **the love of God**, **that we keep his commandments**: and his commandments are not grievous.









A new commandment I give unto you, That ye **love one another; as I have loved you**, that ye also love one another.


Ephesians 4:31–32


Romans 13:1–7 [1-3]


Romans 13:1–7 [4-7]

For he is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil. Wherefore ye must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake. For for this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing. Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.



1 Peter 2:13–19

Submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme; Or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers, and for the praise of them that do well. For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God. Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king. Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward. For this is thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully.





Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, **We ought to obey God rather than** men.








Matthew 5:23–24


Romans 12:17–18

Recompense to no man **evil for evil**. Provide things honest in the sight of all men. If it be possible, **as much as lieth in you**, live peaceably with all men.




Romans 13:8–14 [8-10]

Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law. For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.



Romans 13:8–14 [11-14]

And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed. The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying. But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof.




Romans 14:4

1 John 4:20


If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, **he is a liar**: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, **how can he love God** whom he hath not seen?



Matthew 5:43-48






Ephesians 5:25
