Now you command the Israelites to keep the years in this number—364 days. Then the year will be complete and it will not disturb its time from its days or from its festivals because everything will happen in harmony with their testimony. They will neither omit a day nor disturb a festival.

Jubilees 6:32

**Enoch 74.13** In three years, there are one thousand and ninetytwo days, and in five years one thousand eight hundred and twenty days, so that in eight years there are two thousand nine hundred and twelve days.


**Jubilees 6:29-31** And they placed them on the heavenly tablets, each had thirteen weeks; from one to another (passed) their memorial, from the first to the second, and from the second to the third, and from the third to the fourth. 30 And all the days of the commandment will be two and fifty weeks of days, and (these will make) the entire year complete. Thus it is engraven and ordained on the heavenly tablets. **31** And there is no neglecting (this commandment) for a single year or from year to year.

# Days Calculator: Days Between Two Dates

How many days, months, and years are there between two dates?

From and including: Wednesday, March 20, 2024 To, but not including Wednesday, March 26, 2025

### Result: 371 days

It is 371 days from the start date to the end date, but not including the end date.

Did God accept the priesthood at the Temple?

Luke 1:5-11 There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judaea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the course of Abia: and his wife was of the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elisabeth. And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless. And they had no child, because that Elisabeth was barren, and they both were now well stricken in years. And it came to pass, that while he executed the priest's office before God in the order of his course, According to the custom of the priest's office, his lot was to burn incense when he went into the temple of the Lord. And the whole multitude of the people were praying without at the time of incense. And there appeared unto him an angel of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense.

Luke 2:36-39 And there was one Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Aser: she was of a great age, and had lived with an husband seven years from her virginity; And she was a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but served *God* with fastings and prayers night and day. And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of Him to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem. And when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own city Nazareth.

### Wasn't Jesus raised keeping the Temple timing?

Luke 2:41-43 Now <u>His parents went to Jerusalem every year</u> at the Feast of the Passover. And when He was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the Feast. And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and His mother knew not of it. Did not Jesus and the apostles keep the same calendar as the rest of normative Judaism in the 1st century?

John 2:23 Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, in the Feast day, many believed in His name, when they saw the miracles which He did.

John 4:45 Then when He was come into Galilee, the Galilaeans received Him, having seen all the things that He did at Jerusalem at the Feast: for they also went unto the Feast.

John 5:1 After this there was a feast of the Jews; and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

**John 10:22-23** And it was at Jerusalem the feast of the dedication, and it was winter. And Jesus walked in the temple in Solomon's porch.

John 11:55-56 And the Jews' Passover was nigh at hand: and many went out of the country up to Jerusalem before the Passover, to purify themselves. Then sought they for Jesus, and spake among themselves, as they stood in the temple, What think ye, that He will not come to the Feast?

John 12:12 On the next day much people that were come to the Feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,

Acts 2:1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

Acts 18:21 But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this Feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

**IF** they did not keep the Temple calendar, how is it then that they all observed the same Pentecost?

Acts 2:1-5 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

Acts 2:9-11 Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia, Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes, Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.



**Joshua 5:10-12** The children of Israel encamped in Gilgal; and they kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month at even in the plains of Jericho. They ate of the produce of the land on the next day after the Passover, unleavened cakes and parched grain, in the same day. The manna ceased on the next day, after they had eaten of the produce of the land; neither had the children of Israel manna any more; but they ate of the fruit of the land of Canaan that year.

# Morrow After the Passover

Joshua 5:10-11 And the children of Israel encamped in Gilgal, and <u>kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of</u> <u>the month</u> at even in the plains of Jericho. And they did eat of the *old* corn of the land on <u>the morrow after the</u> <u>Passover</u>, unleavened cakes, and parched corn in the selfsame day.

# Wave Sheaf / Omer Offering

**Leviticus 23:10-14** Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest: And he shall wave the sheaf before YHVH, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.

And <u>ye shall eat neither bread, nor parched corn, nor green</u> <u>ears, until the selfsame day</u> that ye have brought an offering unto your Elohim.

**Ezekiel 1:1-2** Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth *month*, in the fifth *day* of the month, as I was among the captives by the river of Chebar, *that* the heavens were opened, and I saw visions of God. In the fifth *day* of the month, which was the fifth year of king Jehoiachin's captivity,

**Ezekiel 3:15** Then I came to them of the captivity at Telabib, that dwelt by the river of Chebar, and I sat where they sat, and remained there astonished among them **seven days**.

5<sup>th</sup> day, 4<sup>th</sup> month, 5<sup>th</sup> year + (at least) 7 days **Ezekiel 4:4-6** Lie thou also upon thy left side, and lay the iniquity of the house of Israel upon it: *according* to the number of the days that thou shalt lie upon it thou shalt bear their iniquity. For I have laid upon thee the years of their iniquity, according to the number of the days, three hundred and **ninety days**: so shalt thou bear the iniquity of the house of Israel. And when thou hast accomplished them, lie again on thy right side, and thou shalt bear the iniquity of the house of Judah forty days: I have appointed thee each day for a year.

Ezekiel 8:1 And it came to pass in the sixth year, in the sixth *month*, in the fifth *day* of the month, *as* I sat in mine house, and the elders of Judah sat before me, that the hand of the Lord GOD fell there upon me.

# **Examining Enoch/Zadok Calendar**

365 days inclusive from Month 4 Day 5 of Year 5 to Month 4 Day 5 of Year 6

plus 60 days to reach month 6 day 5 of year 6

= 425 days total

Lunar

14 months of alternating 29 and 30 day months = 413 days 15 months of alternating 29 and 30 day months = 442 days

In order for Ezekiel to have lain on his side for 430 days, the 5th year of Jehoiachin's captivity must have had a 13th month
