#### **SABBATH GREETINGS** FROM GOD THE FATHER AND OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST & YOUR FRIENDS AT

Exodus 12:5-8 (KJV) Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats: And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening. And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it. And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; and with bitter herbs they shall eat it.

Matthew 27:46 (KJV) And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? Matthew 27:50-54 (KJV) Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, **yielded up the ghost**. And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent; And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose, And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many. Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

#### CHRIST OUR PASSOVER BEHOLD, THE LAMB

Hebrews 11:28 (KJV) Through faith he (Moses) kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them.

Hebrews 12:24 (KJV) And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.

Romans 5:8-10 (KJV) But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.
For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

### CHRIST OUR PASSOVER BEHOLD, THE LAMB

Exodus 12:46 (KJV) In one house shall it be eaten; thou shalt not carry forth ought of the flesh abroad out of the house; neither shall ye break a bone thereof.

John 19:33-37 (KJV) But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs: But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water. And he that saw it bare record, and his record is true: and he knoweth that he saith true, that ye might believe. For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken. And again another scripture saith, They shall look on him whom they pierced. 6

Exodus 12:11-13 (KJV) And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the LORD'S passover. For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD. And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt. 7

#### BEHOLD, THE LAMB POSSIBLE PLAGUE TARGETS

1. Water to Blood (Exodus 7:17-21) Judgment against Hapi, the god of the Nile. 2.Frogs (Exodus 8:2-6) Judgment against Heget, the frog-headed goddess of fertility. 3.Lice from the Dust (Exodus 8:16-17) Judgment against Geb, god of the earth. 4.Swarms of Flies (Exodus 8:21-24) Judgment against Khepri, the beetle-headed god of creation and rebirth. **5.Death of Livestock (Exodus 9:1-7)** 

Judgment against Apis and Hathor, bull and cow deities.

### BEHOLD, THE LAMB POSSIBLE PLAGUE TARGETS

- 6. Boils on Man and Beast (Exodus 9:8-12) Judgment against Imhotep, god of medicine and healing.
- 7. Hail and Fire (Exodus 9:18-26)
- Judgment against **Nut** (sky goddess), **Shu** (god of air), and **Isis** (goddess of agriculture).
- 8. Locusts (Exodus 10:12-15)

Judgment against **Seth**, god of storms and disorder, and again against **Isis** and **Serapis** for their supposed protection of crops.

9. Darkness (Exodus 10:21-23)

Judgment against Ra, the sun god, the most revered deity in Egypt.

10. Death of the Firstborn (Exodus 12:29-30)

Judgment against Pharaoh himself, who was worshiped as the son of

Ra, and against **Osiris**, the god of the dead.

1 Corinthians 5:7 (KJV) Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

1 Peter 1:19 (KJV) But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

Luke 23:4 (KJV) Then said Pilate to the chief priests and to the people, I find no fault in this man.

Hebrews 9:22 (KJV) And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission. 1 Corinthians 5:8 (KJV) Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Luke 22:19 (KJV) And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake *it*, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

Luke 22:20 (KJV) Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.

1 Corinthians 10:16-17 (KJV) The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? For we being many are one bread, and one body: for we are all partakers of that one bread.

1 Corinthians 11:28-29 (KJV) But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

# John 4:24 (KJV) God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth.

"Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven... but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."—1 Corinthians 5:8

#### 1 Corinthians 11:28 (KJV) But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of *that* bread, and drink of *that* cup.

1 Corinthians 11:31-32 (KJV) For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged. But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world.

**Mark 11:25-26 (KJV)** And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

#### B. Discern the Body (1 Corinthians 11:29)

1 Corinthians 11:29 (KJV) For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

#### C. Celebrate with Joy (Luke 10:20, 1 Thess 5:16-18)

Luke 10:20 (KJV) Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

**1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 (KJV) Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing.** In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

Revelation 19:7-9 (KJV) Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.
