

And another also said, Lord, I will follow thee; but let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house. 

#### **CONTROL YOUR THOUGHTS**

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 For though we walk in the flesh, we don't wage war according to the flesh; for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but mighty before God to the throwing down of strongholds, throwing down imaginations and every high thing that is exalted against the knowledge of God, and bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ;

### **CONTROL YOUR THOUGHTS**

Matthew 5:29, "And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell."

#### **GIVE GOD CONTROL**

- 1. Self-control is measured by our ability to conform ourselves, through the power of the Spirit, with complete devotion to the will of Christ, (Col 3:17).
- 2. To be able to do "what we must do" (Col 3:13) as well as abstain from what we must not do (1 Pet 2:11).
  - 1 Timothy 6:12 (KJV) Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.
